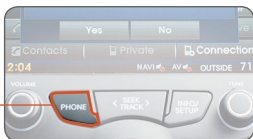
PHONE PAIRING

Connecting for the First Time

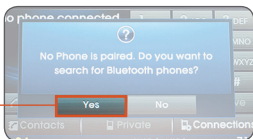
1. To begin, the vehicle's shifter must be in **PARK**



2. Press the **PHONE** button



3. Touch **YES**



4. Turn on phone's **BLUETOOTH®**
Select the device found on your phone

Bluetooth® settings can be found in SETTINGS app on most phones. Refer to your phone's owner's manual or visit hyundaiusa.com/bluetooth for more info



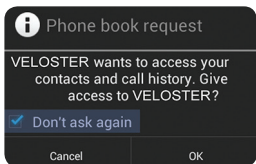

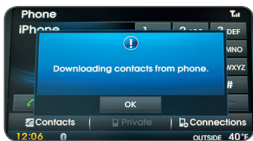
5. Your phone may require a **PASSKEY**. If prompted, enter the **PASSKEY** on your phone



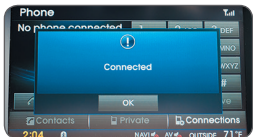
6. If your phone prompts a phonebook access request, it is advisable to select **ALWAYS ALLOW / DON'T ASK AGAIN**



7. Contacts will be transferred to your vehicle



8. The vehicle will confirm that your phone has been connected successfully



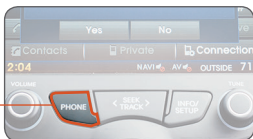

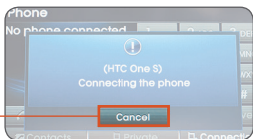
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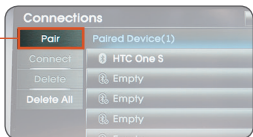
2. Press the **PHONE** button

Making a Call by a Contact Name

BEFORE YOU START

Make sure your phone is connected to your vehicle and your phone contacts have been downloaded to the vehicle. If this has not been done, please follow the instructions on the previous pages.

1. Press the **TALK** button on the steering wheel

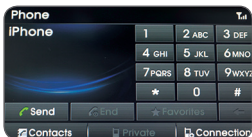

*Say the command after the beep



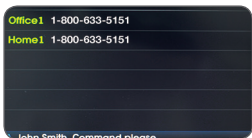
2. After the beep, say **"CALL"** and the name of the desired contact

Example:

"CALL JOHN SMITH"



3. For multiple numbers, choose the number you would like to call by saying **"HOME"**, **"MOBILE"**, **"OFFICE"**, etc.

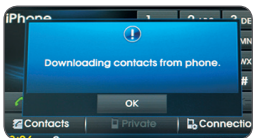
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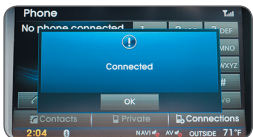
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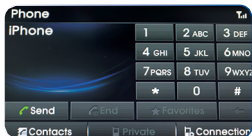
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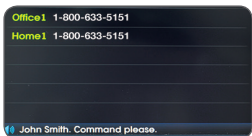
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POINTS OF INTEREST (POI) SEARCH

1. Push the **BLUELINK** button and when prompted say,

"NEW DESTINATION"



2. Say the name of the POI, category or street address. Example: say the name

"HYUNDAI"

3. Up to five nearby choices can be provided if the first match is not desired.

Say **"NEXT"** to hear multiple matches or proceed to Step 4

4. Say **"DOWNLOAD"**

if it is the POI you requested or say

"TRY AGAIN" if unable to find your POI

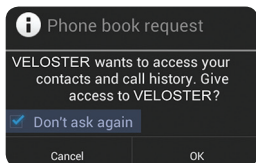
5. Vehicle with standard audio system will provide turn-by-turn directions. Vehicle with navigation system will display instructions on screen to proceed further with route guidance instructions

After pairing is completed, transfer of the contact list to the audio system will begin (if your phone is supported). The downloaded contact list may start with either first or last name depending on the phone make and model

Some phones may request approval to download contact list* to the audio system (If approval is not granted, the phone may frequently disconnect or not download contact list)

This process may take a few minutes depending on the phone make, model and number of entries in the contact list

If your phone prompts permission for the vehicle's audio system to access your contacts and call history, ensure the check box is marked to "Always allow" or "Don't ask again." This will allow the phone to automatically connect to your vehicle and Voice Recognition will have access to your contact list



COMMON VOICE COMMANDS

To start voice command, press the **TALK** button



HELP provides guidance on commands that can be used within the current function

Once the phone has been paired, you can use the following commands:

CALL calls a name saved in Contacts
Example: **"CALL JOHN SMITH"**

DIAL makes a call by dialing the spoken numbers
Example: **"DIAL 1-800-633-5151"**

PHONE provides guidance on phone-related commands

CALL HISTORY displays the Call History screen

CONTACTS displays the phone's Contacts screen
