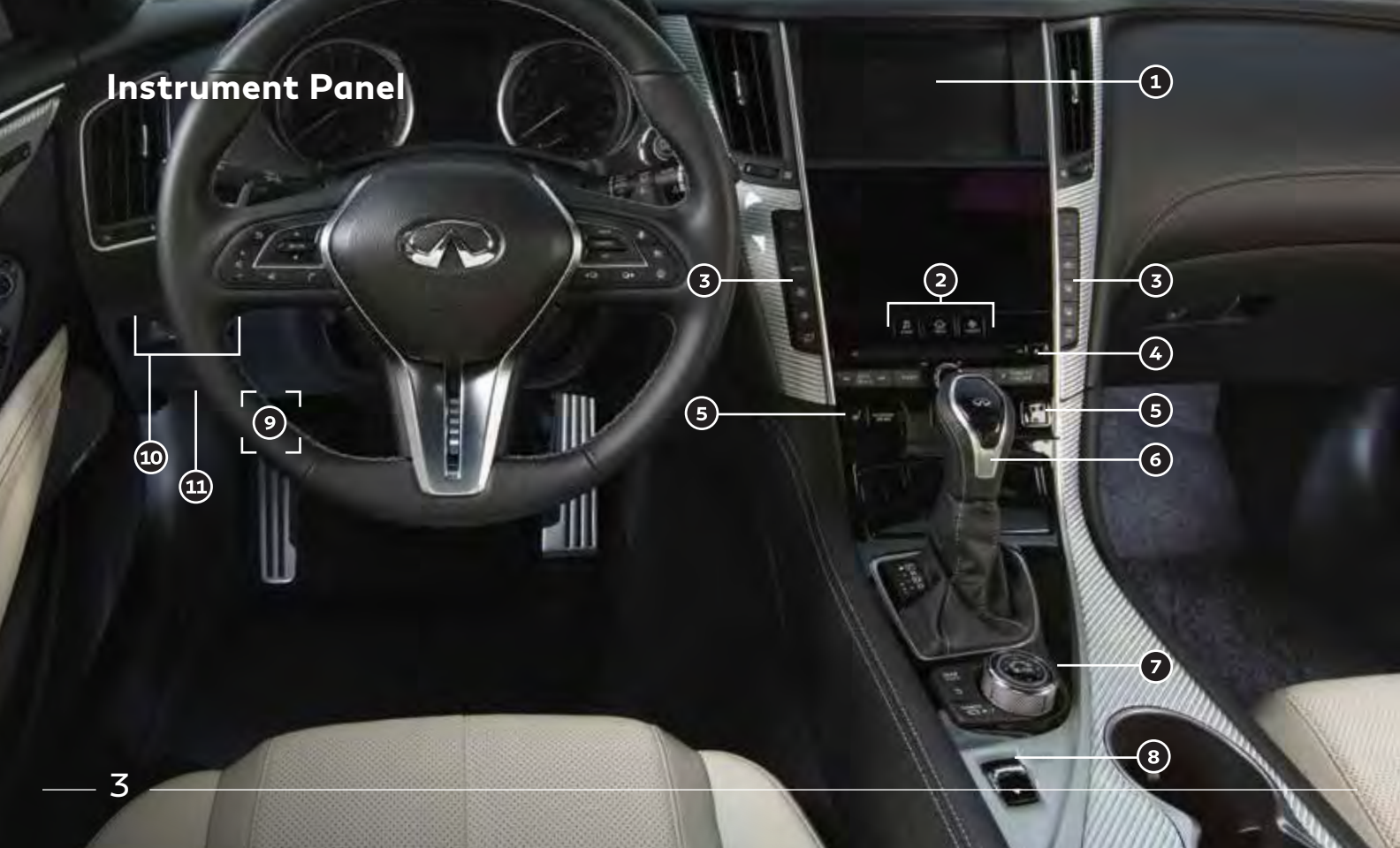

Infiniti Intelligent Key System

REMOTE ENGINE START (IF SO EQUIPPED)

The remote engine start system must be enabled in the vehicle settings within the lower display. To start your vehicle remotely:

1. Press the lock button (1) to lock the vehicle.
2. Press and hold the remote engine start button (2) within 5 seconds of pressing the lock button (1) and the engine will start.

To start driving, depress the brake pedal and push the ignition switch to the ON position.

State laws may apply, review local laws before using.

ROLL DOWN FEATURE (IF SO EQUIPPED)

The windows can be opened remotely using your INFINITI Intelligent Key.

- With the vehicle unlocked, press and hold the unlock button (3) to open the windows and moonroof (if so equipped) remotely.
- If the unlock button (3) is released, the windows will stop. To resume the roll down feature, press and hold the unlock button (3) again.

LOCKING AND UNLOCKING THE VEHICLE

To use the door handles to lock and unlock your vehicle, make sure the INFINITI Intelligent Key is with you (that is, in your pocket or purse).

- Touch the inside of the door handle (4) to unlock the corresponding front door.
- Pushing the request switch (5) while touching the inside of the door handle will unlock the rest of the doors.
- To lock the vehicle, push either door handle request switch (6) once.

Memory Seat (if so equipped)

Two positions for the driver's seat, steering column and outside mirrors can be stored in the memory seat system. To set a memory position:

1. Place the ignition switch in the ON position. (The vehicle should be stopped while setting the memory.)
2. Adjust the driver's seat, steering column and outside mirrors to the desired positions using the adjusting switches for each feature.
3. Push the **SET** switch ①, and within 5 seconds, push the memory switch (**1** or **2**) ②. The indicator light for the memory switch you select will illuminate for approximately 5 seconds and a chime will sound when the memory is stored.

The steering column will automatically move when the driver's side door is opened to allow the driver to get in and out of the driver's seat more easily. "Lift Steering upon Exit" and "Slide Driver Seat Back on Exit" can be adjusted in the lower touch-screen display under "Comfort & Convenience".

Power Folding Outside Mirrors (if so equipped)

ADJUSTING THE OUTSIDE MIRRORS:

- To adjust the outside mirrors, move the switch ① right or left to select the right or left mirror.
- Adjust the position of the mirror using the directional control switch ②.

FOLDING THE OUTSIDE MIRRORS:

- To fold the mirrors closed, push the  switch ③.
- To open the mirrors, push the  switch ④.

REVERSE TILT-DOWN FEATURE (IF SO EQUIPPED)

When backing up the vehicle, the outside mirrors will turn downward automatically to provide better rear visibility. To enable the reverse tilt-down feature, move the switch ① to either the left or right position.

If the switch ① is set in the center (neutral) position, the mirror will not tilt down when reversing.

Starting/Stopping the Engine

It is important to make sure the INFINITI Intelligent Key is with you (that is, in your pocket or purse).

1. Depress the brake pedal.
2. Push the ignition switch to the ON position.



TURNING THE ENGINE OFF

1. Move the shift lever to the **P (Park)** position and apply the parking brake.
2. Push the ignition switch to turn off the engine.

Automatic Anti-Glare Rearview Mirror with HomeLink® Universal Transceiver (if so equipped)

AUTOMATIC ANTI-GLARE REARVIEW MIRROR

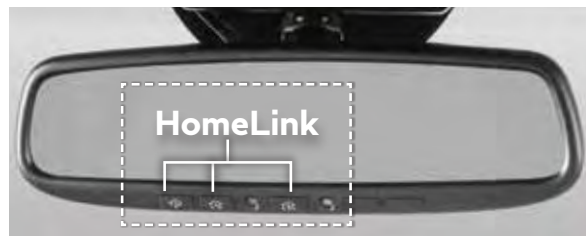
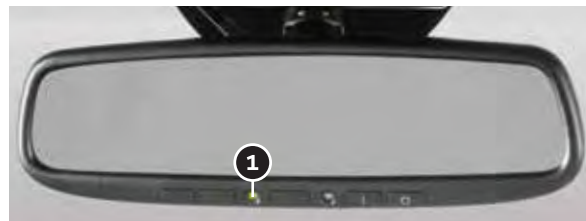
The inside mirror is designed so that it automatically dims during night-time conditions and according to the intensity of the headlights of the vehicle following you. The automatic anti-glare feature is activated when the ignition switch is in the ON position.

- The indicator light ① will illuminate when the automatic anti-glare feature is operating.
- To turn off the anti-glare feature, press the **O** button on the rearview mirror. The indicator light will turn off.
- To turn on the anti-glare feature, press the **|** button on the rearview mirror. The indicator light ① will turn on.

PROGRAMMING THE HOMELINK® UNIVERSAL TRANSCEIVER:

1. Position the handheld transceiver 1-3 in (2-8 cm) away from the HomeLink surface, keeping the HomeLink indicator light in view.
2. Press and hold the desired HomeLink button and the handheld transmitter button simultaneously until the HomeLink indicator light flashes slowly and then rapidly.
3. Both buttons may be released when the indicator light flashes rapidly.
4. Press and hold the programmed HomeLink button and observe the indicator light. A solid, continuous light indicates the programming is complete. If the indicator light rapidly blinks for two seconds and then turns to a solid, continuous light, continue with steps 5-6 for a rolling code device.
5. At the receiver located on the garage door opener motor, locate the "learn" or "smart" button. If there is difficulty locating the button, reference the garage door opener's manual. Once the button is pressed, you have approximately 30 seconds to initiate the next step.
6. Press and hold the programmed HomeLink button for two seconds and release. Repeat the sequence up to three times to complete the programming process. HomeLink should now activate your rolling code equipped device.

Heater and Air Conditioner (automatic)



The climate controls can be adjusted using the buttons on either side of the lower display or through the "Climate" screen (1) on the lower display.

- To access the "Climate" screen (1), press the **CLIMATE** button (2) below the lower display.

HEATED STEERING WHEEL (IF SO EQUIPPED)

- To turn the heated steering wheel on or off, touch the "Steering Heater" key (3) on the lower display.

HEATED SEATS (IF SO EQUIPPED)

The front seats can be warmed by built-in heaters. The heating system of the driver's seat and front passenger seat can be operated independently.

- Push the heated seat switches (4) on the instrument panel or to operate through the touch-screen, press the **CLIMATE** button (2) and touch the heated seat key(s) (5) on the lower display to select the seat heating mode.

Wiper and Washer Switch



Move the lever (1) up or down to one of the following positions to operate the windshield wipers:

- MIST** One sweep operation
- OFF** Wipers are OFF
- AUTO** Speed-sensing and rain-sensing automatic wipe
- LO** Continuous wipe, slow
- HI** Continuous wipe, fast

To adjust the wiper sensitivity for the **AUTO** setting, twist the control ring (2).

Pull the lever (1) toward you to operate the windshield washer.

To turn the rain sensor function on and off:

1. Press the **MENU** button below the lower display.
2. Touch the "Settings" key and then the "Comfort & Convenience" key (3) on the display.
3. To toggle the feature ON and OFF, touch the "Rain Sensor" key (4).

When the rain-sensing function is disabled, the **AUTO** position on the wiper stalk will work in conventional intermittent mode.

WIPER BLADE REPLACEMENT PROCEDURE

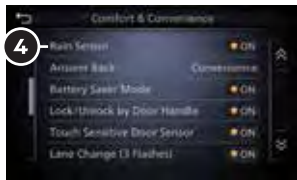
The windshield wipers must be in the service position in order to replace the wiper blades.

To move the wiper blades to the service position:

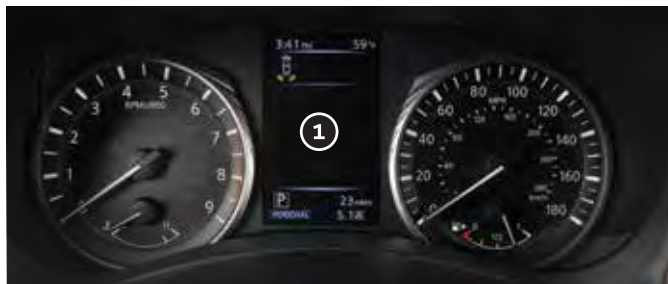
- When the ignition switch is in the ON position or within 60 seconds of placing the windshield wiper washer lever to the OFF position, lift the windshield wiper and washer lever upwards twice in less than 0.5 seconds. The windshield wipers will move to the service position automatically, and the wiper blades can now be replaced.

To move the wiper blades back to the original position:

- Place the wiper arm in the down position and lift the wiper and washer lever up for more than 1 second, or lower the lever down to operate at any wiper speed.



Vehicle Information Display



USING THE VEHICLE INFORMATION DISPLAY

To change the displayed item on the vehicle information display (1), press the ◀ ◻ or ◻ ▶ button (2) on the steering wheel.

The odometer and twin trip odometer are displayed in the vehicle information display when the ignition switch is in the ON position.

RESETTING THE TRIP ODOMETER

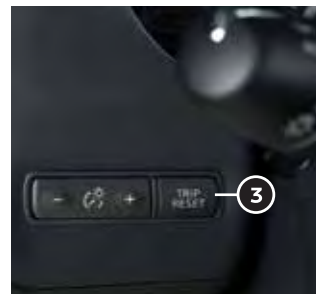
Pushing the **TRIP RESET** switch (3) under the combination meter panel changes display to TRIP A or TRIP B.

Pushing the **TRIP RESET** switch (3) for more than 1 second resets the trip odometer to zero.

Fuel-filler Door

To open the fuel-filler door, unlock the vehicle and gently push the upper left side of the fuel-filler door.

Passenger Rear Seat Entry/Exit

To access the rear seat:

1. Pull the lever ① upward to fold the seatback forward.
2. Press the button ② to slide the front seat forward and press the button ② again to stop the seat.

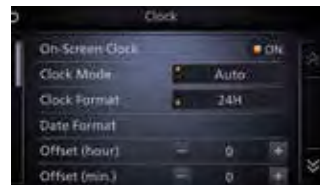


To return the front seat to its original position:

1. Pull the lever ① upward and push the seatback to the locked, upright position.
2. Press the button ② to slide the front seat backward.

Clock Set/Adjustment



To adjust the time and the appearance of the clock on the display:

1. Press the **MENU** button ① below the lower display. Then, touch the "Settings" key on the lower display.
2. Locate and touch the "Clock" key to adjust "On-Screen Clock", "Clock Mode (Daylight Savings Time)", "Clock Format (Time Zone)".

Connecting your Cellular Phone or Device via Bluetooth®*



Using Bluetooth® technology, you can connect (pair) your cellular phone with the in-vehicle system for hands-free use of your cellular phone.

1. Press the **MENU** button below the lower display.
2. Touch the "Settings" key on the lower display.
3. Touch the "Connections" key.
4. Touch the "Devices" key.
5. Touch the "Add New" key.
6. Follow the instructions on the screen. If a PIN appears on the screen, operate the Bluetooth® device to enter/confirm the PIN.

The paired cellular phone will be added to the list on the "Connections" screen.

FAVORITE HANDS-FREE CELLULAR PHONE

- You can register a favorite hands-free cellular phone. The device selected as a favorite will be marked with a star.

Bluetooth® Hands-free Phone System*

SYSTEM OPERATING TIPS

- The interior of the vehicle should be as quiet as possible.
- Speak naturally. Speaking too fast, too slow, too soft, or too loud makes voice recognition more difficult.
- Confirm that the correct voice commands are being used.
- To skip the voice prompt and give the command immediately, press the  button ① on the steering wheel to interrupt the system. Speak the next command after the tone sounds.
- To cancel the command, press and hold the  button ① on the steering wheel.

MAKING A CALL

1. Press the **MENU** button below the lower display and touch the Phone key on the lower display.
2. Select one of the available keys on the "Phone" screen; including "Quick Dial", "Phonebook", "Call History", or "Dial Number" to make a call.

RECEIVING A CALL

- To answer the call, press the  button ② on the steering wheel or touch the  Answer key on the lower display.
- To reject the call, press and hold the  button ② on the steering wheel or touch the  Decline key.
- To hold the call, touch the "Hold Call" key.

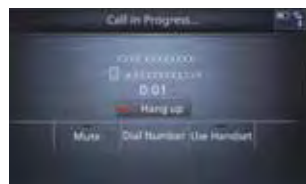
DURING A CALL

- To hang up the cellular phone, touch the  Hang up key on the lower display.
- To answer the call from the second person and place the first caller on hold, press the  button ② on the steering wheel or touch the  Answer key.
- To reject a call from the second person and continue the conversation with the first caller, touch the  Decline key.
- To hang up the cellular phone and return to the conversation with the first caller, touch the  Hang up key.
- To switch between two calls, touch the "Switch Call" key.

Bluetooth® Streaming Audio*



If you have a compatible Bluetooth® device with streaming audio (A2DP and AVRCP profiles), you can set up a wireless connection between your Bluetooth® device and the in-vehicle audio system, enabling you to listen to the audio from your device through the vehicle's audio system.

After connecting your Bluetooth® device, press the **DISC-AUX** button ① on the control panel to switch to Bluetooth® Streaming Audio.

FM/AM/SiriusXM® Radio (if so equipped)



- ① The **AUDIO** button displays the audio screen.
- ② The power button turns the system on or off. Turning the knob adjusts the volume.
- ③ Change stations with the **SEEK-TRACK** buttons. This applies to satellite and CDs.
- ④ Manually tune the radio through the **TUNE-CH-FOLDER** buttons.
- ⑤ The **RADIO** button changes the radio in the order of AM, FM and satellite radio.
- ⑥ The **DISC-AUX** button changes the audio source.
- ⑦ Touch and hold the desired station to store a preset. This applies to AM, FM, or satellite radio stations.

Apple CarPlay®

Apple CarPlay® lets you use your compatible iPhone® to make calls, listen to music, send and receive messages, get directions and use iPhone apps directly from your vehicle display. The display may be different based on iOS software version.

Connect your compatible iPhone to the USB connection port located under the control panel.

- Depending on the setting, the startup information screen will appear on the upper display.
- Touch "Yes" then "OK" to use Apple CarPlay.
- After the iPhone is connected, the Apple CarPlay home screen will appear, and the iPhone functions displayed on the screen can be operated by the in-vehicle system.

While connected to Apple CarPlay, Siri® operation can be accessed.

There are two ways to start a Siri session:

1. Press and hold the  button on the steering wheel.
2. Touch and hold the  key ① or  key ② on the lower left corner of the Apple CarPlay screen.

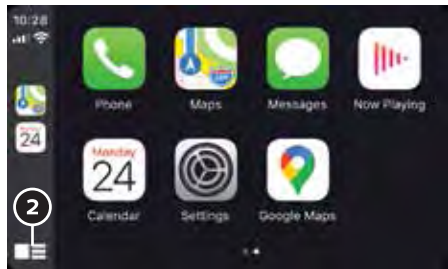
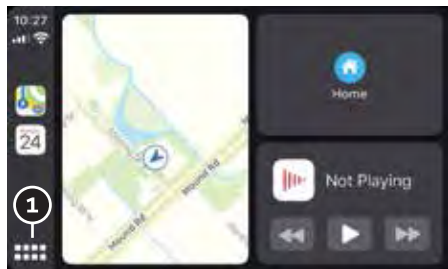
Press the  button on the steering wheel or touch the  key ① or  key ② on the lower left corner of the Apple CarPlay screen to end the Siri session.

Keep the interior of the vehicle as quiet as possible. Close the windows to eliminate the surrounding noises (traffic noises, vibration sounds, etc.) and point the heater and air conditioner vents away from the ceiling, which may prevent the system from recognizing the voice commands correctly.

When Siri finishes responding, the session will automatically end and return to the home screen.

Some Siri functions may not be available during driving. For functions that can be used with Siri, please refer to the Apple® website.

Android Auto™

Android Auto™ connects with your compatible Android® phone to control your phone, apps and navigation directly from your vehicle display.

INITIAL SETUP

- Download the Android Auto app from the Google Play™ store to your compatible Android phone.
- Launch the app from your Android phone and follow the directions for setting up the application. Several permissions will need to be given to the app for Android Auto to fully function on your in-vehicle system.

USING ANDROID AUTO

To connect your Android phone to the in-vehicle system, you must connect a USB cable to the USB connection port located under the control panel.

- Depending on the setting, the startup information screen will appear on the upper display.
- Touch "Yes" then "OK" to use Android Auto.
- After the cellular phone is connected, the Android Auto home screen will appear and can be operated by the in-vehicle system. When connected to Android Auto, Google Assistant™ can be accessed. There are three ways to start Google Assistant™:
 1. Press and hold the  button on the steering wheel until a beep is heard.
 2. Touch the  key ① on the Launch Bar.
 3. Say "OK Google" (requires appropriate permissions enabled via cellular phone).

To return to the Android Auto home screen after operation, touch the  key ② on the Launch Bar.

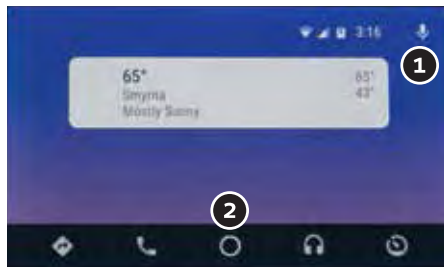
To exit the Android Auto screen, touch the  key ② on the Launch Bar and then touch the exit key.

To return to the Android Auto home screen from the main menu:

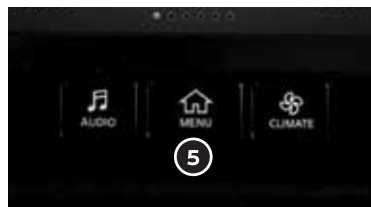
1. Press the **MENU** button and touch the  key ③, or
2. Touch the "Information" key ④, touch the "Apps" key, and then select the "Android Auto" key.

If you have difficulties with connection or performance, try a different USB cable.

Navigation System (if so equipped)



Use the Infiniti controller ① and **OK** button ② to navigate through the upper display screens.

- Press the **Back** button ③ to return to the previous screen.
- Press the **MAP/VOICE** button ④ to display the map.

SETTING A ROUTE

To set a route, first ensure that the correct region is selected on the upper display.

1. Press the **MENU** button ⑤ below the lower display.
2. Touch the "Destination" key ⑥ on the lower display.
3. Select the preferred destination setting method.
4. Enter the address number, street name, and city as prompted by the screen.

CANCELING A ROUTE

1. Press the **MENU** button ⑤ below the lower display.
2. Touch the "Cancel Route" key ⑦ on the lower display.

GUIDANCE VOLUME

- While guidance is being announced, the guidance volume can be adjusted by turning the audio system volume knob.
- The guidance volume can also be adjusted in the "Settings" menu.
 1. Press the **MENU** button ⑤ below the lower display.
 2. Touch the "Settings" key and then the "Volume & Beeps" key ⑧ on the display.
 3. Next, touch the "Guidance Volume" key. Use the "-" and "+" keys ⑨ to adjust the volume.

Upper Display (Shortcut Menu)

The upper touch-screen display (upper display) provides the information, the view monitor system or the navigation map (if so equipped).

To control the upper display, use the touch-screen, the Infiniti controller ① or the steering wheel switches ②.

WITHOUT NAVIGATION (IF SO EQUIPPED)

With no item selected, press the **OK** button ③ on the Infiniti controller ① or steering wheel switch ② to display the shortcut menu ④ on the upper display. The shortcut menu ④ will provide options such as:

- Audio Source
- Audio List
- Call History
- Phonebook
- Displayed Feature
- Customize This Menu

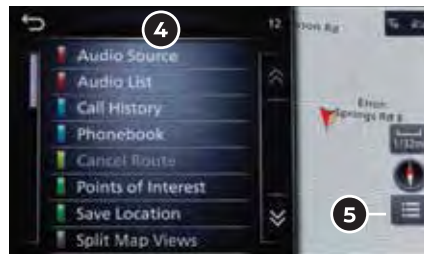
WITH NAVIGATION (IF SO EQUIPPED)

With the current vehicle location displayed on the map screen, press the **OK** button ③ on the Infiniti controller ① or steering wheel switch ② to display the shortcut menu ④ on the upper display.

Selecting the shortcut menu key ⑤ on the map screen will also display the shortcut menu ④. The shortcut menu ④ will provide options such as:

- Audio Source
- Audio List
- Call History
- Phonebook
- Cancel Route

Forward Driving Aid Sensors (if so equipped)

A camera and sensor support the forward driving aids for your vehicle. The camera sensor is located above the inside mirror ① and the radar sensor is located on the front of the vehicle ②. Forward Driving Aid systems (if so equipped) supported by these sensors include, but are not limited to:

- Forward Emergency Braking (FEB) with Pedestrian Detection
- Predicted Forward Collision Warning (PFCW)
- Intelligent Cruise Control (ICC)

The "Forward Driving Aids temporarily disabled Front Sensor blocked See Owner's Manual" ③ warning may illuminate if the front radar sensor is obstructed.

The warning light ④ may illuminate and blink if the front camera sensor ① is obstructed. Front sensor areas may become obstructed due to mud, dirt, ice, and inclement weather (rain, fog, snow, etc).

If the warning message appears, stop the vehicle in a safe place, place the shift lever in the **P (Park)** position, and turn off the engine. Clean the sensor areas and restart the engine. If the message and light continue to appear after cleaning sensor areas, it may mean that forward driving aids are not functioning properly. It is recommended that you have the systems checked by a Infiniti retailer.

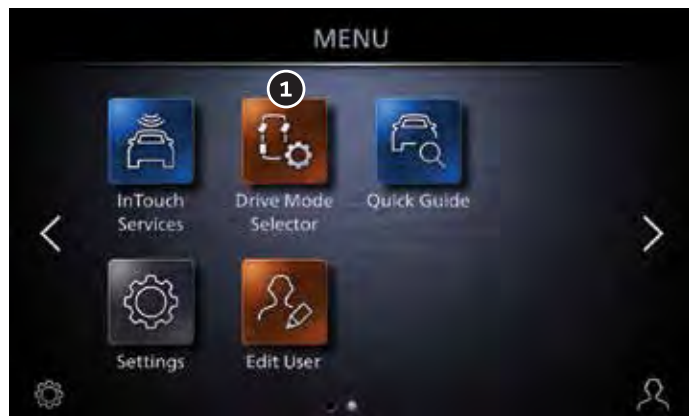

Direct Adaptive Steering



Direct Adaptive Steering is designed to control the steering force and steering angle according to the vehicle speed and amount of turning of the steering wheel.

CHANGING THE VEHICLE STEERING CHARACTERISTICS:

1. Press the **MENU** button on the lower display and select "Drive Mode Selector" ①.
2. Select "Steering" to begin customizing the vehicle's steering response using the "Steering" menu.

Cruise Control

SETTING A CRUISING SPEED

- Push the cruise control MAIN (ON-OFF) switch ① to turn on the system.
- With the vehicle at the desired speed, push down the control switch ② to **SET** — to enable cruise control.
- The cruising speed can be adjusted to a higher or lower speed by toggling the control switch ② up or down.

CANCELING THE PRESET SPEED

- Push the **CANCEL** switch ② or tap the brake pedal.

INTELLIGENT CRUISE CONTROL (ICC) (IF SO EQUIPPED)

The ICC system is designed to maintain a selected distance from the vehicle in front of you and reduce the speed to match a slower vehicle ahead.

- To turn on the vehicle to vehicle (ICC) cruise control mode, quickly push and release the MAIN (ON-OFF) switch ①.
- To increase the distance to the vehicle ahead to be maintained by the ICC system, push the distance switch ③ until the display shows the desired set distance, which is shown by the number of lines on the set distance indicator ④.
- When a vehicle is detected ahead, a vehicle ahead detection indicator ⑤ will illuminate and your vehicle will reduce the speed to match the slower vehicle.

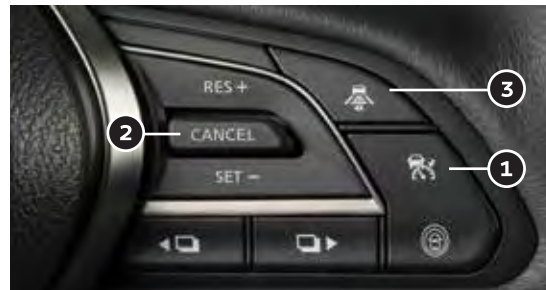

Blind Spot Warning (BSW) (if so equipped)

The Blind Spot Warning (BSW) can help alert the driver of other vehicles in the blind spot area when changing lanes.

TURNING BLIND SPOT WARNING ON OR OFF

- BSW can be turned on or off through the "Driver Assistance" section of the lower display.

Lane Departure Warning (LDW) (if so equipped)

Lane Departure Warning (LDW) warns you if the vehicle is beginning to leave the driving lane.

- LDW is activated at speeds of 45 mph (70 km/h) and above and the lane markings are clear.
- If a front wheel passes over a lane marking, LDW will warn you through a visual alert ① and an intermittent vibration in the steering wheel for up to 1.5 seconds.
- The Dynamic driver assistance switch ② is located on the steering wheel.



TURNING LANE DEPARTURE WARNING ON OR OFF

- LDW can be turned on or off through the "Driver Assistance" section of the lower display.
