INFINITI Intelligent Key System

LOCKING AND UNLOCKING THE VEHICLE

- The lock and unlock operating range of the Intelligent Key is within 31.5 in (80 cm) from each door handle lock or capacitive sensor.
- To lock the vehicle, push any door handle lock sensor ① once, press the  button ② on the Intelligent Key or enter **D (Drive)** and reach a low speed for the doors to lock automatically.
- To unlock the vehicle, perform one of the following procedures:
 - Wrap your hand around the door handle to activate the capacitive unlock sensor ⑤. When unlocking from the driver's door handle, the driver's door will unlock. Touch the lock sensor ① within 60 seconds to unlock all doors. When unlocking from the front passenger door, rear doors or liftgate, all vehicle doors will unlock. To allow driver and passenger doors to unlock at the same time from the driver's door handle, turn off the Selective Unlock feature in the vehicle settings menu.



- Press the  button ③ on the Intelligent Key to unlock the driver's side door. Press the  button ③ again within 60 seconds; all other doors and liftgate will unlock.

APPROACH UNLOCK FUNCTION

- When you approach the vehicle with the Intelligent Key, the vehicle will be unlocked automatically by the approach unlock function. This function is disabled by the default setting. You can enable this function by the vehicle information display.

WALK AWAY LOCK FUNCTION

- When you walk away from the vehicle with the Intelligent Key, the vehicle will be locked automatically by the walk-away lock function. This function is disabled by the default setting. You can enable this function by the vehicle information display.

REMOTE ENGINE START (if so equipped)

To start your vehicle remotely:

1. Aim the Intelligent Key at the vehicle.
2. Press the  button ② to lock the vehicle.
3. Press and hold the  button ④ within 5 seconds of pressing the  button ② and the engine will start.

To start driving, depress the brake pedal and push the ignition switch to the ON position.

State laws may apply, review local laws before using.

Shift Lever

TO PUT THE VEHICLE IN N (NEUTRAL):

The ignition switch must be in the ON position and the brake must be depressed.

From P (Park) to N (Neutral) and D (Drive) to N (Neutral):

Without pressing the shift lever button, push the shift lever forward from the home position and hold for 0.5 seconds.

From R (Reverse) to N (Neutral):

Without pressing the shift lever button, pull the shift lever backward from the home position (1 notch) and hold for 0.5 seconds.

After operating the shift lever, the shift lever returns to the home position by releasing your hand from the shift lever.

While in the **N (Neutral)** position, the **P (Park)** position is automatically engaged if the ignition is turned off or if the driver's seat belt is unfastened, the driver's side door is opened and the vehicle is stationary or driving at a very low speed.

TO PUT THE VEHICLE IN R (REVERSE):

Press the button ①, then push the shift lever forward past the point of resistance and release the shift lever.

TO PUT THE VEHICLE IN D (DRIVE):

Pull the shift lever back past the point of resistance and release the shift lever. Use this position for all normal forward driving.

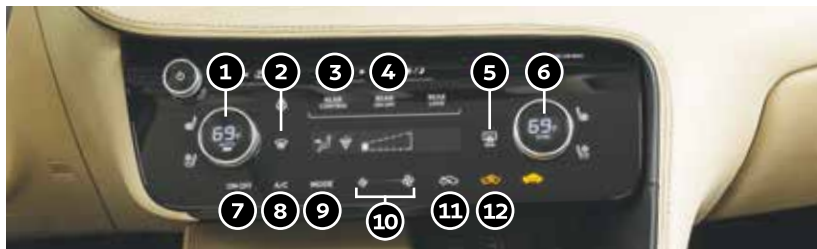
TO PUT THE VEHICLE IN P (PARK):

Make sure the vehicle is completely stopped and press the **P (Park)** button ②. If you switch the ignition off with the transmission in **D (Drive)**, **N (Neutral)** or **R (Reverse)**, the transmission automatically shifts into the **P (Park)** position. The **P (Park)** position is automatically engaged if the ignition is turned off or if the driver's seat belt is unfastened, the driver's side door is opened and the vehicle is stationary or driving at a very low speed.

Heater and Air Conditioner (automatic)



- 1** **AUTO** button/Driver's side temperature control dial: turns on automatic mode
- 2** Front defroster button
- 3** **REAR CONTROL** button: Enables and disables rear passenger climate controls
- 4** **REAR ON OFF** button: Turns the rear climate control system on and off
- 5** **REAR WINDOW AND OUTSIDE MIRROR DEFROSTER** button: Defrosts the rear window and outside mirrors. After 15 minutes, the defroster will turn off.
- 6** **SYNC** button/Passenger side temperature control dial: Turns on sync mode
- 7** **ON-OFF** button: Turn the system on and off
- 8** **A/C** button: Press to turn the air conditioner on or off
- 9** **MODE** button: Cycles through air flow modes
- 10** Fan speed control buttons
- 11** Fresh air intake button
- 12** Air recirculation button: Recirculates interior air inside of the vehicle.



REAR CLIMATE CONTROLS

- 13** Rear fan speed control buttons
- 14** Rear temperature control buttons
- 15** Rear **AUTO** button: turns on automatic mode
- 16** Air flow control buttons
- 17** **ON-OFF** button: turns on and off rear climate control system

Front Power Seat Adjustment



To slide the seat forward or backward, push the switch ① forward or backward.

To recline the seatback, push the recline switch ② forward or backward.

SEAT LIFTER

To raise or lower the front portion or height of the seat, push the front or back end of the switch ① up or down.

POWER LUMBAR SUPPORT

Move the switch up or down to adjust the height of the lumbar. Move the switch forward to increase the lumbar support or rearward to decrease the lumbar support ③.

MASSAGING FRONT SEATS (if so equipped)

To use the massaging front seats, with the vehicle on, push the massaging seat switch ④.

- If the front passenger's door is open, the passenger's seat massage switch will not operate.

2nd Row Seat Adjustment

Forward and backward adjustment:

- Pull the center of the bar ① up and hold it while you slide the seat forward or backward to the desired position until it latches.



Seat angle adjustment:

- Pull up on the lever ② and lean back until the seat latches. To bring the seatback forward, pull the lever up and lean your body forward until it latches.

CHILD SEAT ACCESS MODE

The 3rd row can be accessed without removing a child seat installed in the 2nd row.

- Press the seatback release button on the side of the 2nd row seats ③ or on the back of the 2nd row seats ④ and slide the entire seat forward.
- To return the seat to a locked position, push the upper seatback rearward until the seatback and track are locked.

Opening the Liftgate



To open the liftgate, perform one of the following procedures:

- Push and hold the power liftgate switch (1) on the instrument panel.
- Push the liftgate opener switch (2); the liftgate must be unlocked to open it and without the Intelligent Key in range of the liftgate.
- Press the  button (3) on the INFINITI Intelligent Key for longer than 1 second.

Motion-Activated Liftgate (if so equipped)



To operate the liftgate hands-free:

- Ensure you have the INFINITI Intelligent Key within 31.5 in (80 cm) of the liftgate.
- Use a quick kicking motion under the center of rear bumper (1). After 2 seconds, the vehicle will beep three times and the liftgate will open.
- Do not swing foot side to side or pause during kicking motion.

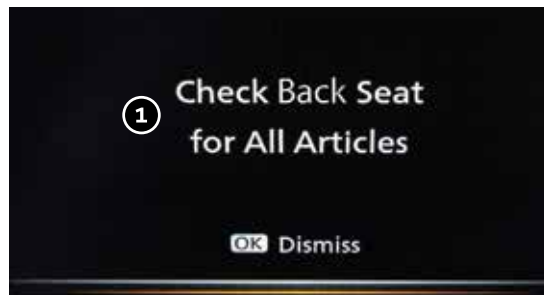

Rear Door Alert

The Rear Door Alert functions under certain conditions to indicate there may be an object or passenger in the rear seat(s). The system is activated when a rear door is opened and closed within 10 minutes of the vehicle being driven.

REAR DOOR ALERT (ACTIVE)

- When the system is active, an audible horn will sound and a **Check Back Seat for All Articles** warning ① will appear on the display when the driver exits the vehicle without opening and closing a rear door within a short period of time.
- To activate Rear Door Alert in your vehicle information display:
 - Press the ◀▶ buttons on the steering wheel until the "Settings" menu screen appears and press the scroll/OK button.
 - Using the scroll/OK button, on the steering wheel to select "Vehicle Settings", "Rear Door Alert" and press the scroll/OK button.
 - Choose from the following options: "Horn & Alert", "Alert Only", or "OFF", and then press the scroll/OK button.
 - To dismiss the warning, use the scroll/OK button on the steering wheel to select "Dismiss Message" ②. If no selection is made, this message will disappear after a period of time.
- To temporarily disable Rear Door Alert for the remainder of the current trip, use the scroll/OK button on the steering wheel to select "Disable Alert" ③ and press the scroll/OK button.

HomeLink® Universal Transceiver (if so equipped)

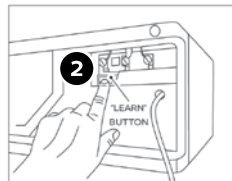
To complete HomeLink® programming, you can download the HomeLink app or read the instructions below.

Before you start programming HomeLink, park outside and within range of your garage. Then, clear the area around your garage door; your vehicle's engine should be turned off while programming Homelink. Locate the remote control transmitter, ensuring a fresh battery is installed. Please note, a ladder and another person may be needed.



To program HomeLink:

1. Press and release the desired HomeLink button ①. The indicator light will flash and "TRAINING" will be displayed on the mirror.
2. Position the hand-held transceiver 1-3 in (2-8 cm) away from the HomeLink surface, keeping the HomeLink indicator light in view.
3. While the indicator light is flashing, press and hold the hand-held transmitter button. DO NOT release until the HomeLink indicator light changes "TRAINED" is displayed on the mirror. When the indicator light illuminates, the hand-held transmitter button may be released.



If the garage door doesn't respond:

- Press the "learn" or "set" button ② on the garage opener until an indicator illuminates. Within 30 seconds, press the HomeLink button ① in your vehicle for 2 seconds up to 3 times. Do not press the HomeLink® button rapidly.

Smart Rear View Mirror (if so equipped)

You can switch between the conventional rearview mirror mode and Smart Rearview Mirror mode (camera view mode) by using the mode select lever ①.

- When the Smart Rearview Mirror mode is on, the settings menu can be selected by pressing the menu button ②.
- Press the adjustment buttons ③ to adjust the following settings:
 - Brightness
 - Indication
 - Dimming Mirror
 - Down/Up
 - Language
 - Left/Right
 - Rotation

Capless Fuel-Filler and Fuel-Filler Door

FUEL-FILLER DOOR

The fuel-filler door ① is located on the driver's side of the vehicle.

CAPLESS FUEL FILL

The fuel tank is not equipped with a fuel-filler cap. After opening the fuel-filler door, insert the fuel pump nozzle directly into the fuel-filler opening. When the fuel pump nozzle is pulled out, the fuel-filler opening will be sealed.



REFUELING FROM A PORTABLE FUEL CONTAINER

- If you need to refuel from a portable fuel container, use the funnel ② stored in the storage space under the luggage board.
- Be sure to insert the funnel into the fuel-filler opening slowly and fully. Insert the nozzle of the portable fuel container into the opening along the funnel and fill the fuel tank.

Wiper and Washer Switch

Move the lever ① up or down to one of the following positions to operate the windshield wipers:

- MIST** One sweep operation
OFF Wipers are off
AUTO Speed-sensing and rain-sensing automatic wipe
LO Continuous wipe, slow
HI Continuous wipe, fast

To adjust the wiper sensitivity for the **AUTO** setting, twist the lever ②. The rain-sensing function can be disabled in the vehicle information display under "Vehicle Settings". Pull the lever ① toward you operate the windshield washer.

REAR WIPER AND WASHER

Turn the rear wiper switch ③ to one of the following positions to operate the rear wiper:

- OFF** Wiper is OFF
INT Intermittent wiping
ON Continuous wipe, slow

Push the lever ① forward to operate the rear windshield washer.

USB Connection Port Interface

The USB connection ports ① (USB Type-C) are located below the climate controls.

- Compatible audio files stored on a USB memory device can be played over the vehicle's audio system when plugged into one of the USB ports.
- These ports will also charge compatible devices.

USB CHARGING PORTS

- There are USB ports located in the 2nd row on the back of the center console ② and a port in the 3rd row by the cup holders ③. These ports will charge compatible devices using Type C USB connections.

For best results, it is recommended to use the manufacturer cables, which are sold separately. A USB Type-A to USB Type-C adapter (or vice versa) can also be purchased separately; however, results may vary.

Connecting your Cellular Phone or Device via Bluetooth®*

Using Bluetooth® technology, you can connect (pair) your cellular phone with the in-vehicle system for hands-free use of your cellular phone.

1. Touch the settings key and touch the "Connections" key.
2. Touch "Devices" and then "Add Device". A message is displayed.
3. Operate as guided by the system. (Operations may differ depending on the device.)

The paired cellular phone will be added to the list on the "Connections" screen.

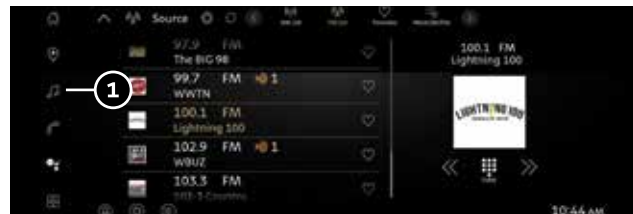

Bluetooth® Streaming Audio



If you have a compatible Bluetooth® device with streaming audio (A2DP and AVRCP profiles), you can set up a wireless connection between your Bluetooth® device and the in-vehicle audio system, enabling you to listen to the audio from your device through the vehicle's audio system.

After connecting your Bluetooth® device, press the audio button ① on the launch bar, then select the source to switch to Bluetooth® Streaming Audio.

When streaming audio and receiving a phone call, the music will continue on the speakers in the vehicle, but the call can be heard through speakers in your headrest to provide continuous music playback.

For any Bluetooth® connectivity issues, reboot your cellular phone or device.

FM/AM/SiriusXM® Radio

1 POWER BUTTON/VOLUME CONTROL KNOB

- To turn the system on or off, press the power  button.
- Turn the volume control dial to the right or left to increase or decrease the volume.

2 SEEK TRACK KEYS

- To tune and stop at the previous or next broadcast station, touch the  SEEK  TRACK  keys.

3 TUNE FOLDER KEYS

- To manually tune the radio, touch the  TUNE  FOLDER keys.

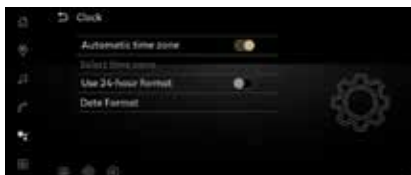
4 STATION PRESET KEYS

- Up to 18 stations/channels of AM/FM radio and/or SiriusXM® Audio can be registered in the preset list.
- To store a station in a preset, you must first select a radio band by pressing the **AUDIO** button (5) on the INFINITI controller, or touch the "Station Information" key (6) on the audio screen then tune to the desired AM, FM or satellite radio station.
- Next press and hold the desired station preset button (1-6) until the preset number is updated on the display and the sound is briefly muted. The channel indicator will then come on, and the sound will resume. Programming is now complete.
- To retrieve a previously set station, select the radio band where the preset was stored then press the corresponding station select button (1-6).

Clock Set/Adjustment



To adjust the time and the appearance of the clock on the display:

1. Touch the "Settings" key on the launch bar.
2. Touch the "General" key.
3. Touch the "Clock" key.

Touch the  key to return to the previous screen.

INFINITI Voice Recognition

This system offers Google Assistant as the Voice Recognition system. To select a Voice Recognition system use the center touch-screen and press "Settings", "Apps & Notifications" and finally select "Active Voice Assistance."

SYSTEM OPERATING TIPS

- The interior of the vehicle should be as quiet as possible.
- Speak naturally. Speaking too fast, too slow, too soft or too loud makes voice recognition more difficult.
- Confirm that the correct voice commands are being used.

USING THE VOICE RECOGNITION SYSTEM

- Press the  button ① on the steering wheel, the icon on the Launch Bar depending on the Voice Recognition selection, or using the voice prompts (voice permissions required).
- After the tone sounds, speak a command.
- To cancel the command, press and hold the  button ① on the steering wheel.

myQ Connected Garage

myQ Connected Garage allows for remote monitoring, opening and closing of myQ compatible garage doors. This can be accessed through the touch-screen display. Download the myQ app on your smartphone using the QR code displayed on the touchscreen display.

Google Built-in

Drivers can use Google built-in features on the built in-vehicle system.

- Google Assistant™:
 - You can voice control various functions such as playing music, setting destinations with Google Maps, etc.
- Google Maps:
 - Navigation functions such as getting driving directions, finding nearby facilities, etc. can be used.
- Google Play:
 - Various apps can be downloaded and used on the in-vehicle system.
- For some of the functions, an internet connection and/or signing into your Google account are required for full use.

Apple CarPlay®

Apple CarPlay® lets you use your compatible iPhone® to make calls, listen to music, send and receive messages, get directions and use iPhone apps directly from your vehicle display. The display may be different based on iOS software version.

Connect your compatible iPhone via Bluetooth® or to the USB connection port located under the control panel.

- Depending on the setting, the startup information screen will appear on the display.
- Touch "Yes" then "OK" to use Apple CarPlay.
- After the iPhone is connected, the Apple CarPlay home screen will appear, and the iPhone functions displayed on the screen can be operated by the in-vehicle system.

While connected to Apple CarPlay, Siri® operation can be accessed.

Press and hold the  button on the steering wheel to start a Siri session.

Press the  button on the steering wheel to end the Siri session.

Keep the interior of the vehicle as quiet as possible. Close the windows to eliminate the surrounding noises (traffic noises, vibration sounds, etc.) and point the heater and air conditioner vents away from the ceiling, which may prevent the system from recognizing the voice commands correctly.

When Siri finishes responding, the session will automatically end and return to the home screen.

Some Siri functions may not be available during driving. For functions that can be used with Siri, please refer to the Apple® website.

Android Auto™ connects with your compatible Android® phone to control your phone, apps and navigation directly from your vehicle display.

USING ANDROID AUTO

Connect your Android phone to the in-vehicle system via Bluetooth® or to the USB connection port located under the control panel.

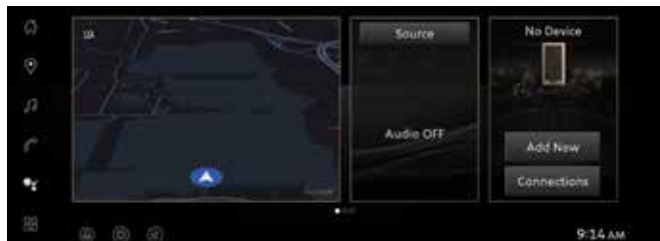
- Depending on the setting, the startup information screen will appear on the touch-screen display.
- Touch "Yes" then "OK" to use Android Auto.
- After the cellular phone is connected, the Android Auto home screen will appear and can be operated by the in-vehicle system. When connected to Android Auto, Google Assistant™ can be accessed. There are three ways to start Google Assistant™:
 1. Press and hold the  button on the steering wheel until a beep is heard to start a Google Assistant session.
 2. Touch the microphone key .
 3. Say "OK Google" (requires appropriate permissions enabled via cellular device).

To return to the Android Auto home screen after operation, touch the  key  on the Launch Bar.

To exit the Android Auto screen, touch any key on the Launch Bar.

If you have difficulties with connection or performance, try a different USB cable.

Wireless Charging

The wireless charger is located on the front of the center console, below the climate control system. If your vehicle is equipped with a non-magnetic wireless charger, ensure the smartphone is positioned vertically and fully seated on the center of the charging pad ①. Charging will start automatically.



If your vehicle is equipped with a magnetic wireless charger, place your phone on the center of the charging pad ①. To optimize the charging performance, use a Qi2 compatible phone or phone case equipped with a magnetic ring. This will help the phone properly attach and align on the magnetic charger. Charging will start automatically.

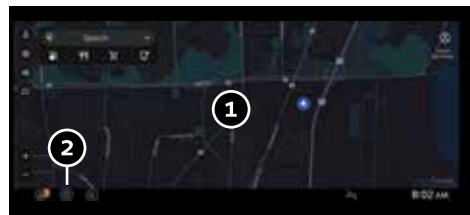
The smartphone will be charged continuously while the ignition switch is in the ON position. Some phone cases, including those not equipped with magnetic ring, may impact charging conditions.

- The  indicator ② will illuminate in orange when the charging process is started.
- When the charging is complete, the indicator illuminates in green.
- If a malfunction occurs or the charging process stops, the indicator will blink in orange for 8 seconds and then turn off.

Navigation System

- ① Touch-screen display
- ②  – Touch this key to access Map Settings.

Forward Emergency Braking (FEB) with Pedestrian Detection

- The Forward Emergency Braking (FEB) system can assist the driver when there is a risk of a forward collision with a vehicle ahead in the traveling lane, a pedestrian or a cyclist.
- The FEB operates at speeds greater than 3 mph (5 km/h).
- Intersection assist helps the driver when there is a risk of a forward collision when turning right or left.
- Intersection assist operates between 6-16 mph (10-25 km/h) when the turn signal is active.
- If there is a risk of a forward collision, an audible tone will sound and the vehicle ahead detection indicator light ① will illuminate. If the driver applies the brakes after the warning and the FEB with Pedestrian Detection detects that there is still the possibility of a forward collision, the system will automatically increase the braking force. If the driver does not take action, the FEB with Pedestrian Detection will issue a second flashing visual warning ②, an audible warning and also apply partial braking.



TURNING FORWARD EMERGENCY BRAKING WITH PEDESTRIAN DETECTION ON OR OFF

- The FEB with Pedestrian Detection system can be turned on or off through the "Driver Assistance" section of the vehicle information display.

Rear Automatic Braking (RAB)

- The RAB system can assist the driver when the vehicle is backing up and approaching objects directly behind the vehicle.
- The RAB system will function when the shift lever is in the **R (Reverse)** position and the vehicle speed is less than approximately 9 mph (15 km/h).
- If a risk of a collision with an obstacle is detected when your vehicle is backing up, the RAB system indicator ① will flash in the vehicle information display.
- A red frame will appear in the center display ② (for vehicles equipped with the Intelligent Around View® Monitor system). The system will chime three times and braking will be applied automatically. The driver must depress the brake pedal to maintain brake pressure.



TURNING THE RAB SYSTEM ON/OFF

- The RAB system can be turned on or off through the "Driver Assistance" menu in the vehicle information display.
- The RAB system can be temporarily turned on or off by touching the RAB temporary ON/OFF key on the touch screen display.
- When the RAB system is turned off, and the vehicle is in the **R (Reverse)** position, the RAB system warning light ① illuminate.
- When TOW mode (if so equipped) is selected, the RAB system cannot be turned on.

Blind Spot Warning (BSW) with Rear Cross Traffic Alert (RCTA)

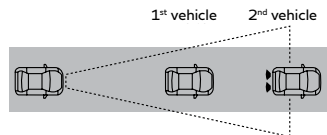
- The Blind Spot Warning (BSW) system helps to alert the driver of other vehicles in adjacent lanes when changing lanes.
- If the turn signal is turned on with a vehicle in the detection zone, the system will chime twice and the indicator light will flash.
- The indicator ① will temporarily illuminate after the ignition switch is placed in the ON position and the BSW system is enabled.
- The indicator light ① located on the outside mirrors will illuminate if the radar sensors detect a vehicle in the detection zone.
- The Rear Cross Traffic Alert (RCTA) system helps to alert the driver ② of an approaching vehicle when the driver is backing out of a parking space. The system operates when the shift lever is in the **R (Reverse)** position and the vehicle speed is less than approximately 5 mph (8 km/h).
- The BSW system can be enabled/disabled through the "Driver Assistance" menu in the vehicle information display.

Predictive Forward Collision Warning (PFCW)

- The Predictive Forward Collision Warning (PFCW) system can help alert the driver of sudden braking by the second vehicle traveling ahead of your vehicle in the same lane.
- The PFCW system operates at speeds above approximately 3 mph (5 km/h).
- If there is a potential risk of a forward collision, the PFCW system will warn the driver with the vehicle ahead detection indicator light ① and an audible warning tone will be heard.
- The PFCW system can be turned on or off through the "Driver Assistance" menu in the vehicle information display.

Lane Departure Warning (LDW) and Lane Departure Prevention (LDP) (if so equipped)

Lane Departure Warning (LDW) and Lane Departure Prevention (LDP) can help warn you if the vehicle is beginning to leave the traveling lane.

- LDW and LDP are activated at speeds of approximately 37 mph (60 km/h) and above and when the lane markings are clear.
- If a front wheel passes over a lane marking, LDW and LDP will warn you through a visual alert ① and an intermittent vibration in the steering wheel.
- LDP can help assist the driver to return the vehicle to the center of the traveling lane by applying the brakes to the left or right wheels individually (for a short period of time).

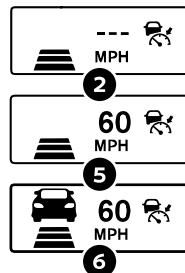

Intelligent Cruise Control (ICC) (for vehicles with ProPILOT Assist) (if so equipped)

VEHICLE-TO-VEHICLE DISTANCE CONTROL MODE

- To set Vehicle-To-Vehicle Distance Control mode, push the ProPILOT Assist switch (1) on the steering wheel for less than 1.5 seconds. The CRUISE ON/OFF indicator light (2) will illuminate.
- Accelerate to the desired speed.
- Push down on the **SET-** switch (3) on the steering wheel and release it. Intelligent Cruise Control will be set to the desired speed.
- Press the distance switch (4) on the steering wheel repeatedly to change the set distance between long, middle and short.
- When a vehicle is not detected ahead of you in the lane, the set distance and set vehicle speed indicator lights will illuminate (5) in set mode.
- When a vehicle is detected ahead of you in the lane, the vehicle ahead detection, set distance and set vehicle speed indicator lights will illuminate (6) in set mode.
- To reset at a faster cruising speed, push and hold the **RES+** switch (7) on the steering wheel. When the vehicle attains the desired speed, release the switch.
- To reset at a slower cruising speed, push and hold the **SET-** switch (3) on the steering wheel. Release the switch when the vehicle slows to the desired speed.
- To cancel the preset speed, push the **CANCEL** switch (8) on the steering wheel or tap the brake pedal. The set vehicle speed indicator (5) will extinguish.
- To turn off Intelligent Cruise Control, push the ProPILOT Assist switch (1) on the steering wheel. The CRUISE ON/OFF switch indicator light (2) in the instrument panel will extinguish.



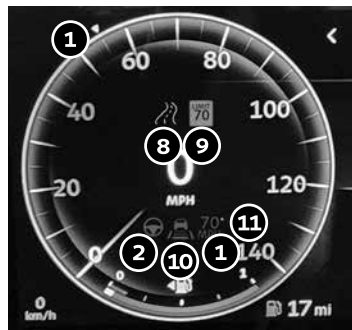
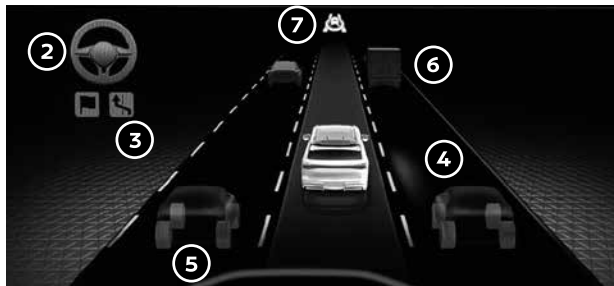

ProPILOT Assist (if so equipped)

The ProPILOT Assist system is intended to enhance the operation of the vehicle when following a vehicle traveling in the same lane and direction. ProPILOT Assist includes Intelligent Cruise Control (ICC) and Steering Assist. ProPILOT Assist 1.1 includes base features along with Speed Adjust by Route, Speed Limit Assist, and Extended Stop. ProPILOT Assist 2.1 (if so equipped and subscribed) includes all previously listed features along with hands-off capability with features like Lane Change Assist, Passing Assist and Steering Assist with HD map data.

PROPILOT ASSIST DISPLAY

- ❶ Set vehicle speed indicator: Displays the speed set by the driver.
- ❷ Steering Assist indicator: Shows whether steering assist is active or inactive (green-active, gray-standby, orange-malfunction).
- ❸ Lane Change Assist indicator (ProPILOT 2.1 if so equipped): Appears when Lane Change Assist feature is available.
- ❹ Side detection (ProPILOT 2.1 if so equipped): Indicates that a vehicle is detected in the side spot.
- ❺ Surrounding Vehicle Display (ProPILOT 2.1 if so equipped): Displays other detected vehicles.
- ❻ Vehicle ahead indicator: Appears on the display when a vehicle is detected ahead.
- ❼ ProPILOT Assist status indicator: Displays whether ProPILOT Assist is engaged or not.
- ❽ Road information indicator (if so equipped): Displays the detected road information.
- ❾ Detected road sign (speed limit) indicator (if so equipped): Displays the detected speed limit.
- ❿ Intelligent Cruise Control (ICC) Status Indicator: Displays the status of the speed control including the distance setting and detection of a lead vehicle.
- ⓫ Speed Limit Adjust indicator (if so equipped): Indicates the detected speed limit will be automatically applied to the vehicle set speed.



ProPILOT Assist (if so equipped)

PROPILOT INTELLIGENT CRUISE CONTROL

Press the ProPILOT Assist (14) switch to turn the system on.

To accelerate or decelerate your vehicle to the desired speed toggle up or down on the CANCEL switch (13) and release it.

When a vehicle is detected in the lane ahead, the Intelligent Cruise Control system controls the vehicle speed based on the distance set by the driver. Press the distance switch (12) to adjust the gap distance.

To cancel a set speed push CANCEL switch (13) on the steering wheel or tap the brake pedal.

To turn the system off, push the ProPILOT Assist switch (14).

CONVENTIONAL (FIXED SPEED) CRUISE CONTROL MODE

To turn on the conventional (fixed speed) cruise control mode, push and hold the ProPILOT switch (14) for longer than approximately 1.5 seconds.

STEERING ASSIST

When the lane markers are clear and consistent on both sides of the vehicle, the Steering Assist system assists the driver to keep the vehicle within the traveling lane.

To activate Steering Assist, press the Steering Assist (16) switch on the lower switch bank.

This feature operates when the vehicle speed is above 37 mph (60 km/h). Below 37 mph (60 km/h), ProPILOT Assist

must detect a vehicle ahead in order for steering assistance to activate.

To turn off the Steering Assist system, press the Steering Assist (16) switch on the lower switch bank or turn it off in the "Driver Assistance" settings in the vehicle information display.

HANDS-OFF DRIVING (ProPILOT 2.1 if so equipped)

ProPILOT Assist 2.1 allows you to take your hands off the steering wheel when certain conditions are met as indicated by blue indicators.

- ProPILOT Assist is active and the driver's hands are detected on the steering wheel.
- The vehicle is driving on a highway or limited access freeway as defined by the HD map data.
- Camera, radar and sensors are functioning and free from obstruction or damage.
- The driver monitor system detects the driver's attention is given to the road ahead.
- All driving, road, and traffic conditions allow.
- Lane markings are clearly visible and able to be detected by the system.
- The vehicle is traveling at a speed less than 85 mph (137 km/h).

While hands are off the steering wheel, the vehicle is monitoring driver's attention to the road ahead with a driver facing camera located on the steering column. For Hands-Off driving, the vehicle must be on a highway or limited access freeway as defined by the HD map as indicated by the Hands-Off steering assist indicator and blue display.

ProPILOT Assist (if so equipped)

LANE CHANGE ASSIST (ProPILOT 2.1 if so equipped)

When ProPILOT Assist 2.1 is active and the Lane Change Assist indicator is illuminated in blue, Lane Change Assist can help the driver with steering control during a lane change when the turn signal is activated and conditions are met.

The driver must place their hands on the steering wheel prior to the lane change maneuver and ensure safety throughout the lane change.

Lane Change Assist can be turned off in the Driver Assistance settings in the vehicle information display.

PASSING ASSIST (ProPILOT 2.1 if so equipped)

When ProPILOT Assist is active and the Lane Change Assist indicator is illuminated in blue, the Passing Assist feature can suggest a lane change to the left when a slower vehicle is detected ahead.

You can accept to pass the slower vehicle by pressing the lane change assist switch (15) on the steering wheel. You must place your hands on the steering wheel prior to the lane change maneuver and ensure safety throughout the lane change.

EXTENDED STOP

When the vehicle ahead decelerates to a stop on a highway, your vehicle decelerates to a standstill if the ProPILOT Assist is activated. Once the vehicle stops, the system will keep the vehicle stopped.

If the vehicle is stopped for less than 30 seconds, and the vehicle ahead begins to move, your vehicle will start moving again automatically.

If the vehicle is stopped for more than 30 seconds and the vehicle ahead begins to accelerate, push and release the CANCEL switch in either direction or press and release the accelerator. This will resume the last set cruising speed.

ProPILOT Assist does not provide approach warnings, automatic braking, or steering assist in the conventional (fixed speed) cruise control mode.

Idling Stop System

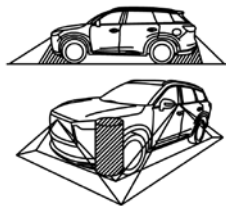
- The system is active while waiting at a stop light, etc. When the vehicle is stopped for long periods of time, turn off the engine.
- When the engine is stopped by the Idling Stop System, heating, cooling and dehumidifying functions will be deactivated. To avoid the air conditioning functions from being deactivated, turn off the Idling Stop System by pushing the Idling Stop OFF switch ①.
- The status of the Idling Stop System can be checked in the vehicle information display.
 - This indicator ② is displayed when the Idling Stop System is activated.
 - The indicator ② blinks when the Idling Stop System is malfunctioning.

3D Around View Monitor (if so equipped)

- With the ignition switch in the ON position, activate the 3D Around View® Monitor by pressing the **CAMERA** button ①, located below the front control panel or when the vehicle is in **R (Reverse)** position. The monitor displays various views of the position of the vehicle.
- Front view: A view of the front of the vehicle.
- Rear view: A view of the rear of the vehicle.
- Bird's-eye view: The surrounding view of the vehicle from above.
- Front-side view: The view around and ahead of the driver's side and the front passenger's side wheel.
- Front-wide view: A wider area view of the front view.
- Rear-wide view: A wider area view of the rear view.
- 3D view: A 360-degree view around the vehicle.
- Invisible hood view: A view of the front of the vehicle with a transparent engine hood.



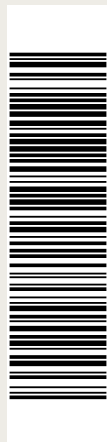
MOVING OBJECT DETECTION (MOD)

- The MOD system helps inform the driver of moving objects around the vehicle.
- The system will operate when the shift selector is in the **D (Drive)**, **N (Neutral)**, **R (Reverse)** or **P (Park)** position and the vehicle is driven at speeds of approximately 5 mph (8 km/h) or less.
- If the MOD system detects moving objects, a yellow frame will be displayed on the camera image.
- When the following is displayed:
 - Green **MOD** icon ②; the system is active.
 - Gray **MOD** icon ②; the system is not active.
 - No **MOD** icon; the system is off. The indicator will also be off if all of the warning systems are deactivated using the Settings menu.
- The **MOD** system will not operate if the liftgate is open.
