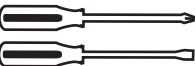

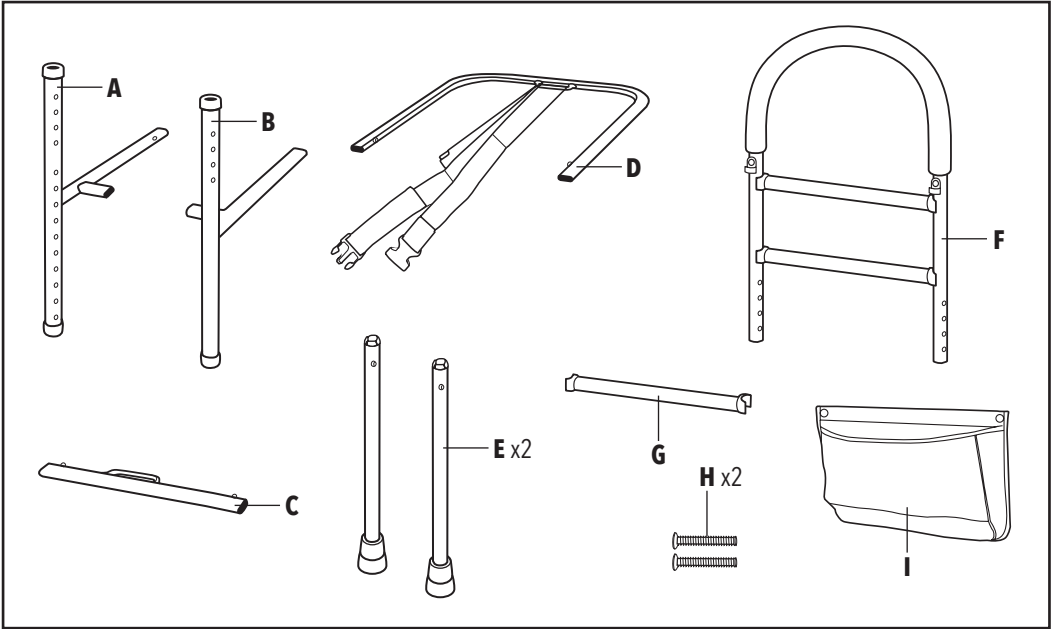
Product Assembly

1 Check all parts

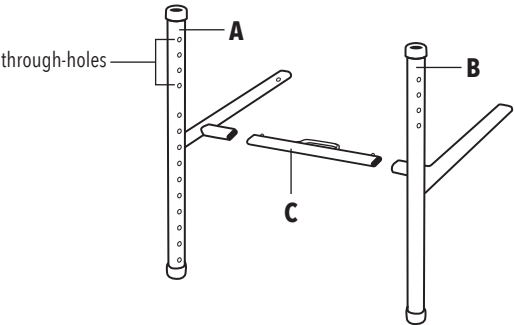

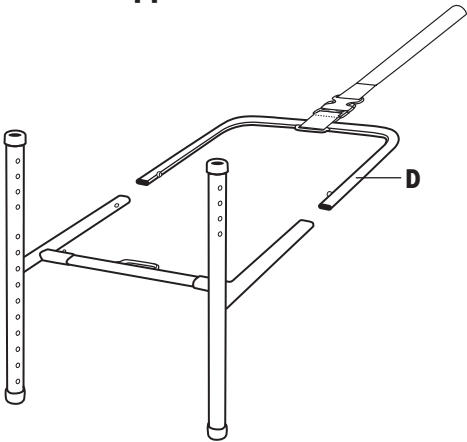


2 Connect cross bar to post

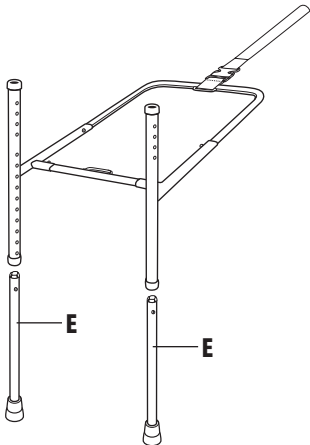
☐ **NOTE:** Post through-holes should be UP when assembled.



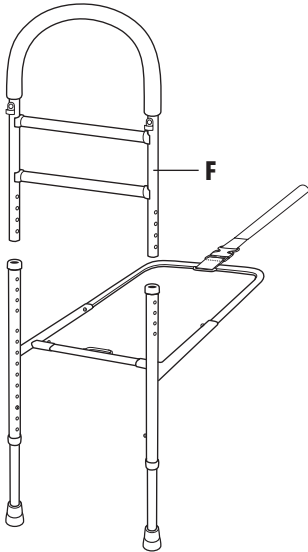
3 Add under-bed support frame



4 Insert the legs into the under-bed support frame

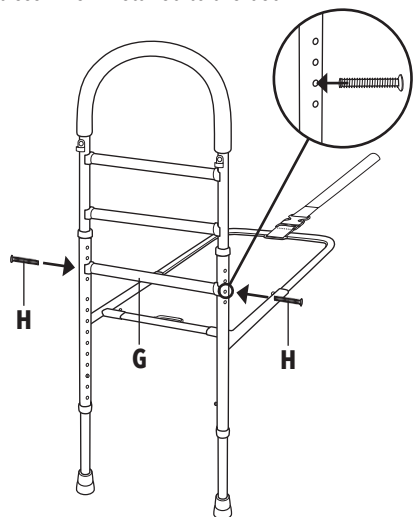


5 Insert foam handle

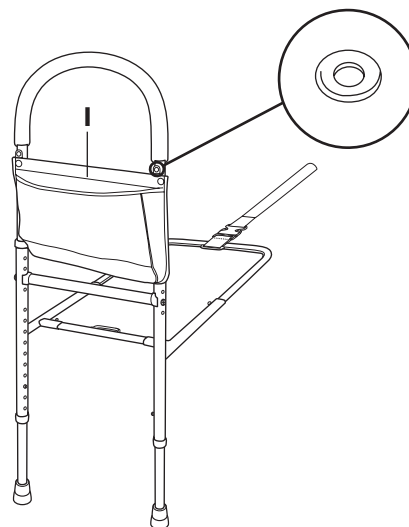


6 Use the screws to secure foam handle AND bottom rung

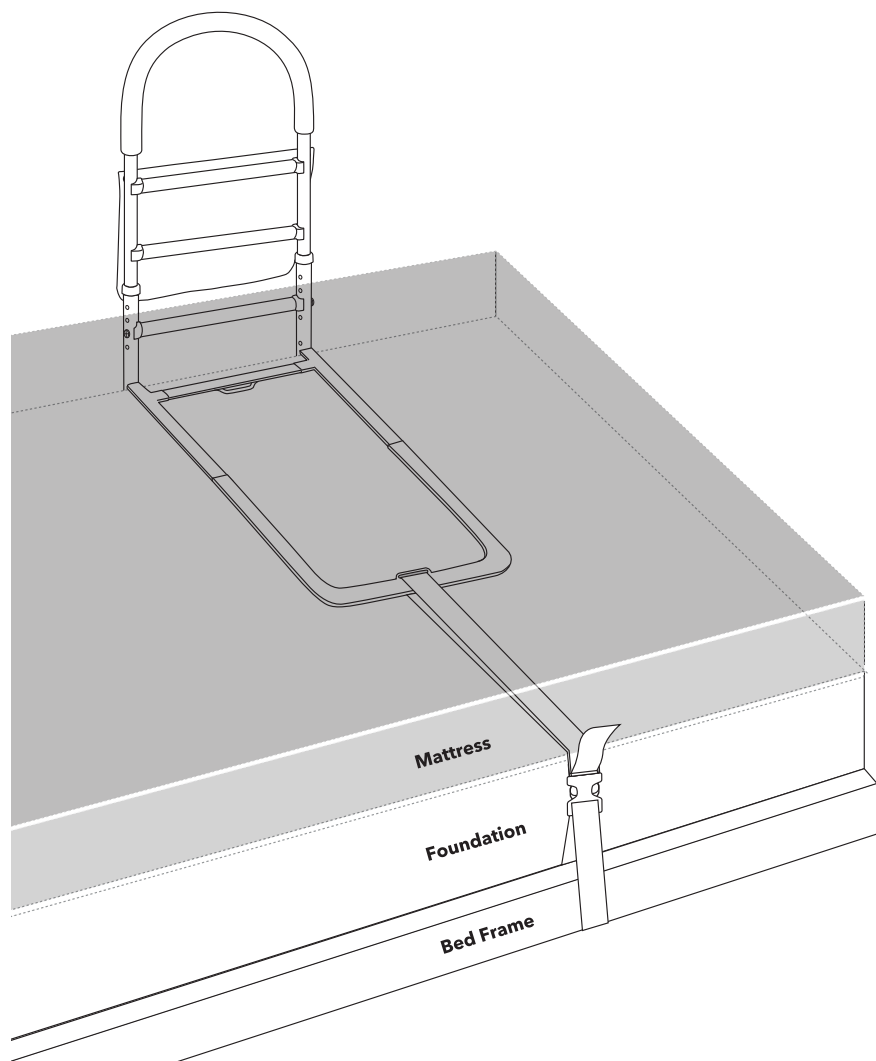
- **NOTE:** Bottom rung should be below the top surface of the mattress when installed to the bed.



7 Remove shipping washers from foam handle and add pouch



8 Installation to the bed: Secure strap to bed frame and tighten



WARNING

SUFFOCATION/ STRANGULATION/ ENTRAPMENT HAZARD

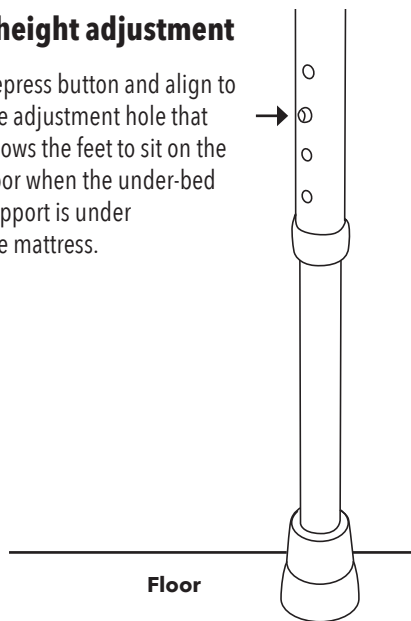
If product is installed incorrectly or moves from its initial position, gaps can occur which can entrap and kill. - **NEVER** use with a mattress height taller than 19 in. or shorter than 6 in.
- **NOT** to be used with articulating beds.

Product Installation and Adjustment

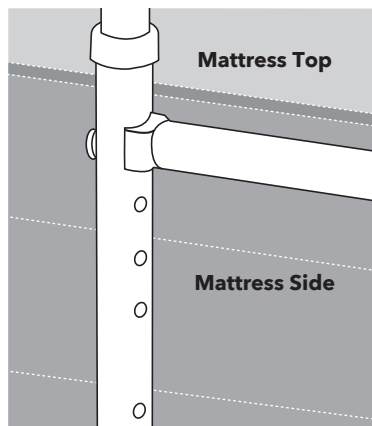
1 Leg height adjustment

- Depress button and align to the adjustment hole that allows the feet to sit on the floor when the under-bed support is under the mattress.



2 Handle height adjustment

- Using a screw driver, unscrew the screws and align the foam handle hole and the lower rung to a frame hole below the top surface of the mattress.

When adjusting the foam handle height, the top of the handle must be a minimum of 4" above the top of the mattress.

If the strap provided is not properly secured, the product may move into an unsafe position which increases the danger of entrapment. See instructions for proper use of the straps.

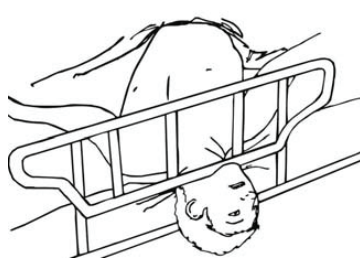
ENTRAPMENT/STRANGULATION/SUFFOCATION AND FALL HAZARDS

Gaps in and around this product can entrap and kill. People with Alzheimer's disease or dementia, or those who are sedated, confused, or frail, and are at increased risk of entrapment and strangulation. People attempting to climb over this product are at increased risk of injury or death from falls. Always make sure this product is properly secured to bed. If product can move away from bed or mattress, it can lead to entrapment and death.

- Bedside rail and straps work with most twin, queen and king size beds.
- Stop using immediately if damaged or broken, or if parts are missing.
- Stop using immediately if product shifts out of its original position until it is readjusted into the correct position.

Cleaning and Maintenance Instructions

- ☐ Use warm damp cloth to clean Bed Rail. **ALWAYS** ensure product is completely dry before using.
- ☐ **ALWAYS INSPECT BED RAIL PRIOR TO USE.** Properly inspecting and maintaining your Bed Rail can reduce risk of injury. Make sure all parts are secure and are in good working order.
