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AIR PURIFIER SAFETY

This manual provides important safety messages regarding your electrical home appliance. Always read, follow, and, save all safety directions.

Location Requirements

- Use a level surface with at least 6" (15.2cm) from heat sources such as ranges, dryers, or heaters.
- Do not block air vent openings.
- Never insert fingers or foreign objects into air vents.
- Do not place air purifier on a soft or unstable surface such as a bed or sofa.
- Do not use in a window.
- Do not use near any source of water such as a sink, bath, shower, or swimming pool.
- Operate indoors only.

Electrical and Safety Requirements – Reduce the risk of fire or electrical shock.

Failure to follow these instructions can result in property damage, injury, or death.

- Do not connect the air purifier to any electrical socket that is damaged.
- Do not plug the air purifier into an outlet controlled by a dimmer switch.
- Do not insert or pull-out plug with wet hands, it may cause electric shock.
- Plug the DC Power Adapter provided with your air purifier directly into the outlet. Do not use an outlet adapter or extension cord.
- Use only the power adapter provided with your air purifier. Other third party power adapters have not been tested with the air purifier and could damage/destroy the air purifier.
- Do not exceed the rating of the power outlet or connection device. May cause electric shock or fire due to excess heat generation.
- Never try to take apart or repair the air purifier.
- Disconnect power immediately if you notice strange sounds, smells, or smoke.
- Change your filter at the recommended interval to avoid particle and dust buildup.
- Ensure filter is secured with the filter lock before turning on air purifier. Do not run the air purifier without a filter.
- Do not cover or impede the airflow.
- Do not drop the air purifier, as this can result in damage.
- Do not place heavy objects on the DC Adaptor cord, and ensure that it is not a tripping hazard.
- Do not spray insecticides or any other flammable sprays near the air purifier. It may cause explosion or fire.

USING YOUR AIR PURIFIER

PLEASE NOTE:

The BreatheSmart 35i has a capacitive touch panel. The buttons only operate with a quick, light touch. Holding the buttons down will not activate the controls properly. A chime will indicate that the control has registered your touch.

Operating Your Unit:

1. Plug your air purifier into a grounded outlet.
2. Touch  Power Button in the center to start the air purifier. When your unit is on, the lights will light up. To turn off the lights on your unit, touch the  Power Button. To turn off the air purifier, touch the  Power Button again after the lights have turned off within 5 seconds.
3. The Color Ring around the  Power Button indicates air quality.

COLOR	MEANING
Blue	Excellent - Very low level of airborne particles detected
Green	Good - Low level of airborne particles detected
Orange	Fair - Medium level of airborne particles detected
Red	Poor - Significant level of airborne particles detected
Purple	Very Poor - Very significant level of airborne particles detected

4. FILTER life Indicator — There are three lights above the FILTER button: Green, Orange and Red. The Green light will be illuminated for most of the life of the filter. The Orange light will come on shortly before your filter should be replaced. This is the ideal time to order a new filter. The Red light will be illuminated when it is time to replace the filter.
 - The filter light will reset to green automatically when the old filter is replaced by a new one.

NOTE: A filter is required for normal operation of the purifier. The purifier will not function without a filter installed.

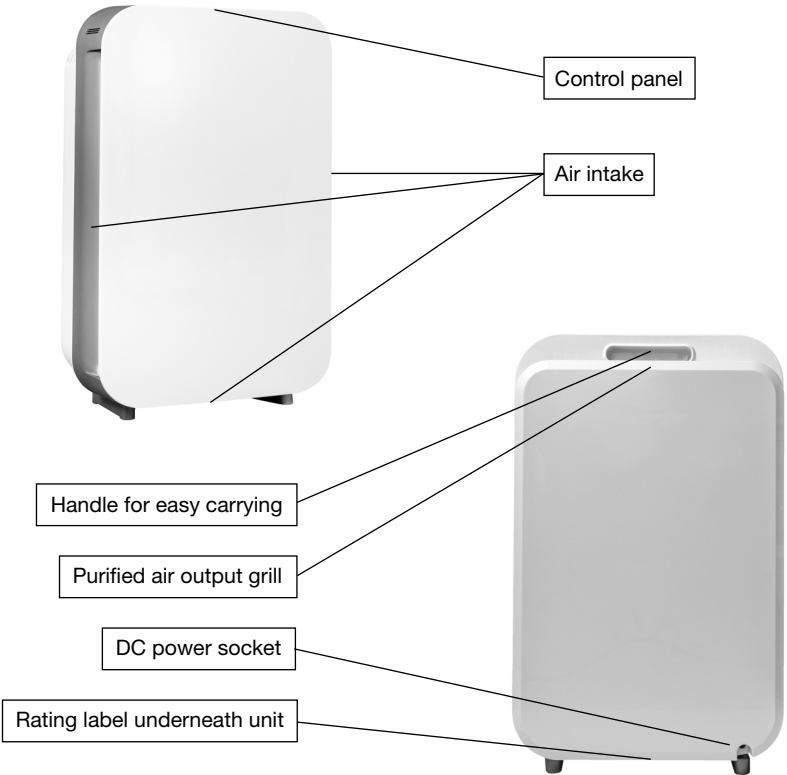
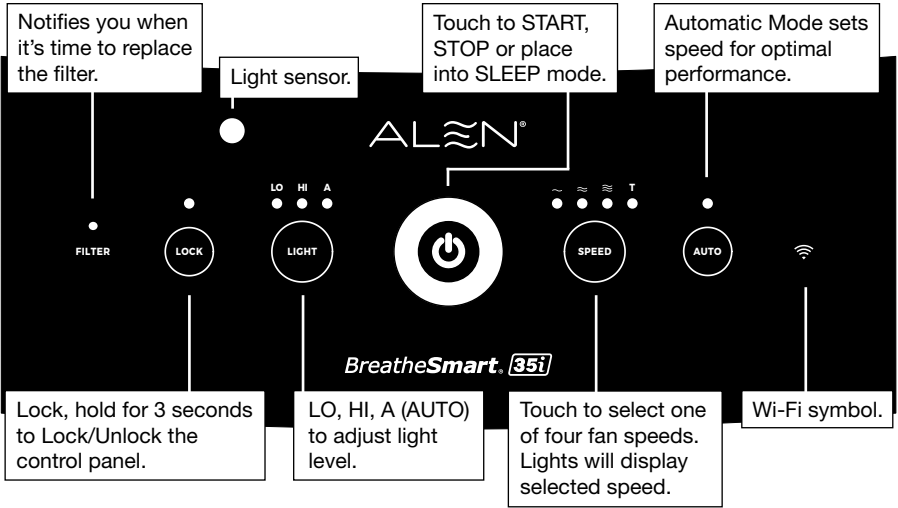
5. Press LIGHT to change from LO, HI and A (AUTO). A adjusts lights based on the ambient light level, turning off the lights when the room is dark.

NOTE: If you cover the light sensor located between the LOCK and the LIGHT button, the lights will always be off if in the AUTO mode.

6. Sleep Mode - Press the Power button once to place the unit into Sleep. It will continue to work, but the lights will turn off. To wake the unit from Sleep, press any button.

NOTE: If you press the Power button again within 5 seconds, the unit will power off.

KNOW YOUR AIR PURIFIER

When using the air purifier for the first time in a room, we recommend that you use a higher fan speed like speed three (3) or Turbo (T), for at least two hours in order to clean the room's air initially. Then, we recommend you run the purifier continuously at the highest fan speed where the sound is acceptable, or set the unit on Auto mode.

35i Features

- HEPA filtration captures dust, allergens, and airborne particles.
- 4 fan speeds to control air circulation.
- Filter change indicator light keeps replacements on schedule.
- Simple and intuitive touch button controls.
- Auto-off safety feature when front cover is removed.
- LIGHT button with A (AUTO) setting, senses light levels and dims or turns off lights in a darkened room.
- Alen Air app connects the air purifier to Wi-Fi via Bluetooth. Using your Android or iOS phone, the mobile app provides the ability to control your unit remotely and monitor PM 2.5, CO2, TVOC, TEMP and HUMIDITY in your space. (Download the Alen Air app on the Apple App Store or Google Play Store.) Follow the instructions in the app for adding your purifier.
- Wi-Fi connection: Alen uses a dual band Wi-Fi module to connect the purifier via Bluetooth to the Alen Air app.
 - To start Wi-Fi connection via Bluetooth: Press the Auto button for 5 seconds. You will see the Wi-Fi symbol start blinking.
 - To override Wi-Fi connection: Long press the Auto button until it starts blinking. This will reset the purifier to its original factory settings.
 - To stop Wi-Fi connection: Long press the Auto button until it starts blinking, then pull the front panel off the purifier. Wait 5-10 seconds and put the panel back on the purifier.
 - At any time, you can remove your provisioned purifier from the Alen Air app and request your account be removed from the system.

Turn The Lights Off/On

To turn the lights off on your unit, touch the  Power Button. The lights will go out, but the unit will not turn off. Touch any button to turn the lights back on or touch the  Power Button a second time within 5 seconds of the first button touch to turn the unit off completely. You can control your lights by touching the LIGHT button and choosing between LO, HI, A (AUTO). A adjusts control panel lights based on the ambient light level, dimming or turning off the lights.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

Cleaning Instruction: Control Panel

To avoid scratching the control panel, do not use abrasive/caustic cleaning solutions or scrubbing pads. With the unit unplugged, dampen a clean towel with soap and water to clean the control panel, then dry gently with a soft cloth or paper towel. Glass cleaner (e.g. Windex) is also OK. To avoid damaging electronic components **DO NOT allow liquid to seep into the unit.

Replacing The Filter

The Filter Indicator has 3 lights: Green, Orange, and Red. The Green light will be illuminated for most of the life of the filter. The Orange light will come on shortly before your filter should be replaced. This is the ideal time to order a new filter. You may order a new filter at www.alen.com/filters or by calling 1-800-630-2396. The Red light will be illuminated when it is time to replace the filter.

The filters used in Alen Air Purifiers are not designed to be washed, cleaned, or otherwise reused. Over time, the filters become overloaded with particles, decreasing their filtration performance. We recommend regular filter replacements to extend the life of your air purifier and maximize performance.

To capture larger debris such as dust and hair, every filter comes with an attached screen layer, known as the pre-filter. This layer can be vacuumed periodically to maintain efficient operation of the unit.

How To Replace The Filter

1. Always unplug the unit when installing a filter.
2. Distinguish the front side from the back side of the filter. The front side has a screen pre-filter and the label on top will indicate the insertion direction.
3. Place the used filter in a plastic bag to prevent dust from re-entering the air.



1. With the unit standing upright, pull firmly on the cover near the intake vents with one or both hands to release the magnets.

2. After pulling the cover out, lift it away from the unit.



3. Remove used filter by turning the filter lock to release and then pull out the filter using the finger nooks. Place the used filter in a plastic bag to prevent dust from re-entering the air.

4. Take new filter out of the plastic bag, insert the bottom. Push the top of the filter into the unit and turn the filter lock to secure the filter in place.

To lock, turn clockwise



To unlock, turn counterclockwise



5. Insert the bottom hooks on the front cover first and then the upper part of the cover will snap into place.



WARNING! RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK - To reduce risk of electric shock, do not perform any servicing other than that contained in the operating instructions.

TROUBLESHOOTING TIPS

Unit will not power on.

Check that the DC plug is properly inserted into the DC socket on the back of the purifier. Ensure that the filter lock is securing the filter in place. Last, check that the front panel is on properly (fit snugly to the purifier).

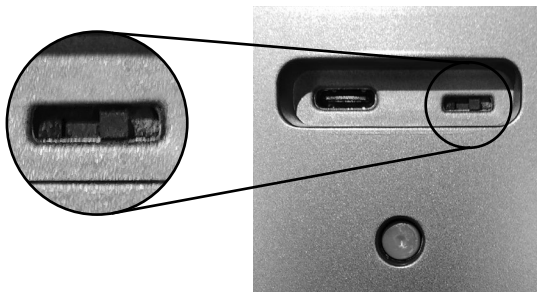
The light above my FILTER button is blinking red – Your filter type is not identified. If your filter is genuine Alen, the RFID identifier tag may have become compromised, contact customer service. This can also be caused by use of a non-Alen branded filter which may not deliver advertised unit performance and voids your Forever Guarantee.

Can I clean the filter?

The screen layer of the filter, known as the pre-filter, captures large dust and hair. This layer can be vacuumed to maintain efficient operation of the unit. No other layers or parts of the filter can be washed, cleaned, or otherwise reused. Please replace the filter regularly to maintain optimal performance.

My Wi-Fi symbol is blinking red.

Use a pen or toothpick and toggle the tiny switch to the right side. Toggling this switch to the left position cuts off the Wi-Fi signal.
