1.Setting up your unit

In order to use Mainstage script for KeyLab mk3, you have to download the script from Arturia website and install it.

- Go to <https://www.arturia.com/keylab-mk3/resources>
- Download the scripts corresponding to your DAW
- Extract the folder and execute the .dmg
- Double click on the application to install the scripts (a pop-up should notify you)
 - If you cannot install it via .dmg, place the file named “KeyLab XX mk3.device” at the end of this path

MacOS: `/<username>/Music/Audio Music Apps/**MIDI Device Profiles/Arturia**

If the MIDI Device Profile or Arturia Folder does not exist, you have to create it first.

Your controller is now ready to use with MainStage.

Note: MainStage and Logic Pro scripts cannot be used simultaneously. Please install only the script you intend to use.

2. Script features

Transport control and DAW commands :

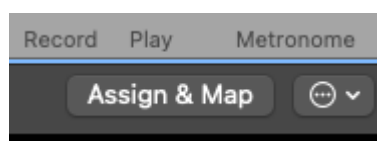


- Stop / Play / Record / Tap Tempo
- Metronome

Knobs 1 → 8 and Faders 1 → 8:

Control some parameters of the current focused device

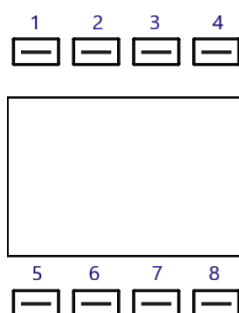
User can learn different parameters using the learn function of Mainstage



Fader 9:

Control the Output 1-2 of the Mainstage mixer.

3. Controlling Arturia software

When you select a preset that includes an Arturia instrument, pressing the main encoder on your controller will activate the deep editing mode for that Arturia software.

This action displays the instrument's icon and the preset's name.

To exit this deep editing mode, you must either press the 'back' button on this screen or manually select the DAW mode on your controller.
