IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING YOUR VACUUM.

When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should be observed, including the following:



WARNING

TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE, ELECTRIC SHOCK, OR INJURY:

- » Use indoors only.
- » For dry pick up only.
- » Do not leave machine when it is plugged in.
- » Do not service machine when it is plugged in.
- » Do not use with damaged cable or plug.
- » If appliance is not working as it should, has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water, have it repaired at an authorized service center.
- » Do not handle unit with wet hands.
- » Do not pull or carry by cable, use cable as a handle, close door on cable, pull cable around sharp corners or edges, run appliance over cable, or expose cable to heated surfaces.
- » Do not unplug by pulling on cable. Unplug by grasping plug.
- » Do not run appliance over cable.
- » Do not handle plug or appliance with wet hands.
- » Do not expose hair, loose clothing, fingers or body parts to openings or moving parts.
- » Do not pick up hot or burning objects such as cigarettes, matches, or hot ashes.
- » Do not pick up flammable or combustible materials (lighter fluid, petrol, kerosene, etc.) or use in the presence of explosive liquids or vapours.
- » Do not use appliance in an enclosed space filled with vapours given off by oil base paint, paint thinner, some moth proofing substances, flammable dust, or other explosive or toxic vapours.
- » This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory and mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- » Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- » Remove plug from electrical socket before cleaning or maintaining the appliance.
- » If the supply cable is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- » Do not pick up toxic material (chlorine bleach, ammonia, drain cleaner, petrol, etc.).
- » Do not use for any purpose other than described in this User's Guide.
- » Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- » Do not use with any opening blocked; keep free of dust, lint, hair, and anything that may reduce air flow.
- » Keep appliance on a level surface
- » Turn off all controls before unplugging.
- » Be extra careful when cleaning stairs.
- » Use only identical replacement parts.
- » Pay close attention when working around children.
- » Unplug from outlet when not in use.
- » Do not use outdoors or on wet surfaces.
- » Do not put any object into openings.
- » The hose contains electrical wires. Do not use when damaged, cut, or punctured. Avoid picking up sharp objects.
- » Always turn off this appliance before connecting or disconnecting either hose or motorized nozzle.
- » Hold plug when rewinding onto cord reel. Do not allow plug to whip when rewinding.
- » Unplug before connecting powered accessories.
- » Do not use without dust bag and/or filters in place.
- » To reduce the risk of electric shock, this appliance has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician to install the proper outlet. Do not change the plug in any way.
- » Any service details not laid out in this user guide should only be performed by an authorized service center.

Operations Thermal Motor protection

An internal thermal protect or has been designed into your cleaner to protect it from overheating. When the thermal protect or activates , the main vacuum motor will stop operating. If this happens, proceed as follows :

1. Turn the cleaner OFF and unplug from electrical outlet.
2. Check the cleaner for the source of overheating problem (ie. Full dirt cup, dirty filters or clog).
3. Fix the problem by following the steps in the maintenance section of the user guide.
4. When the motor cools for approximately 60 minutes, the thermal protector will reset and cleaning may continue. If the cleaner will not turn on or the thermal protector continues to activate, your cleaner may need servicing. Call BISSELL Consumer Care or visit the website.

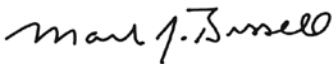

NOTE: The unit remains off as long as the handle is plugged in, but the power is still on until the power button is depressed on the canister as shown in step 7.

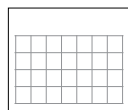


Top slot for power foot
Bottom slot for combination or hard floor tool

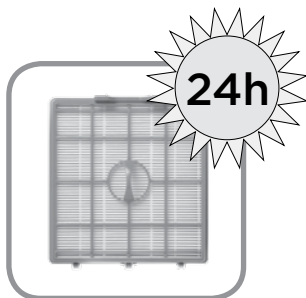
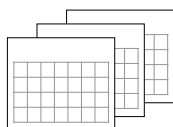




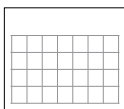
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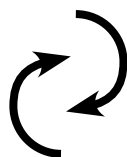
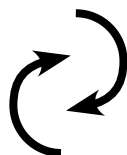


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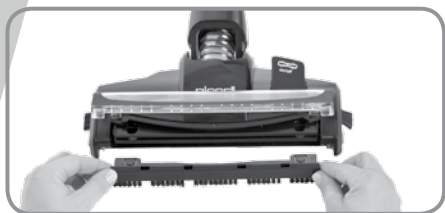
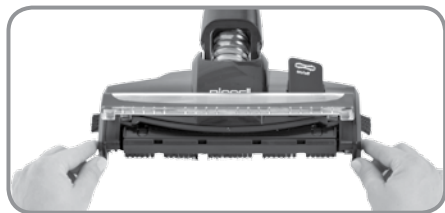
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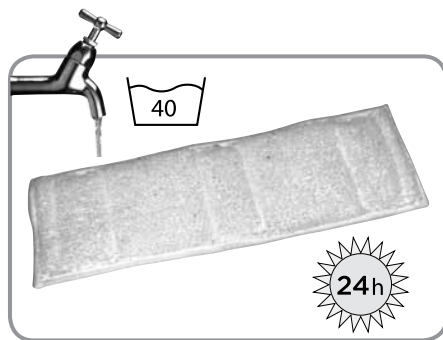
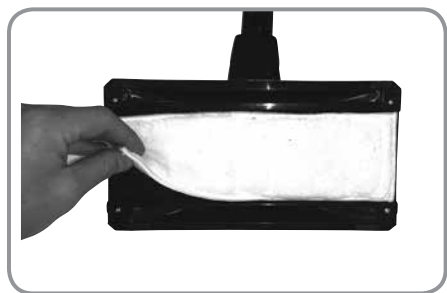

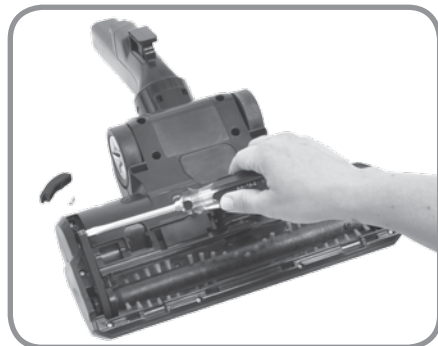
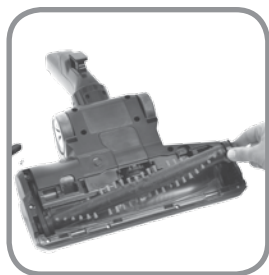


Brush Bar Access for Cleaning
