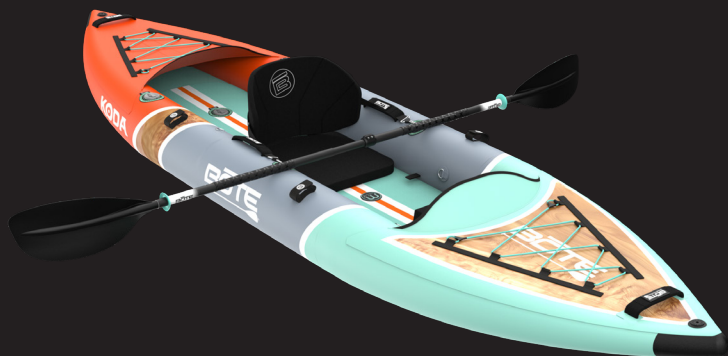

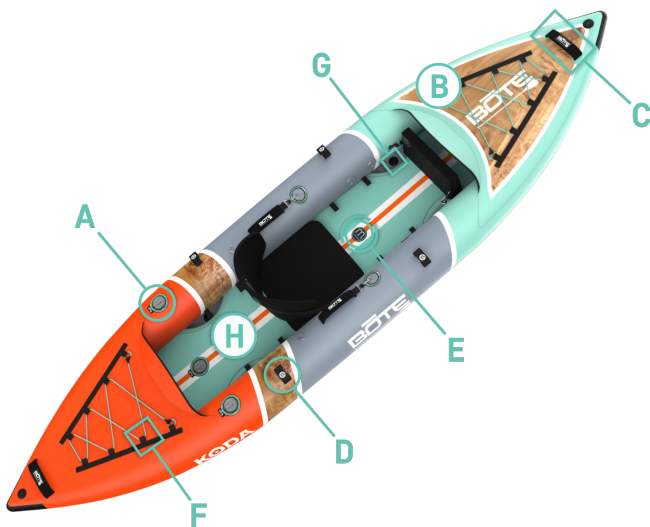
GETTING STARTED GUIDE

KODA OVERVIEW

Sleek, stable, and ready in minutes, the Koda Aero is built for paddlers who want to hit the water without hauling half their garage. Cruise a cove, explore the back bay, or simply kick back on the lake, solo or tandem. This inflatable sit-in kayak ditches the bulk but keeps the performance — no roof racks, no second pair of hands, no drama. Just grab it and go. It's the everyday kayak for paddlers who want legit gear that won't overcomplicate the fun.

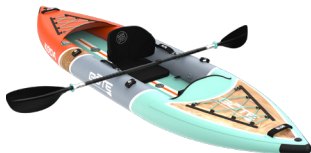
KODA AERO KAYAK 12' SHOWN

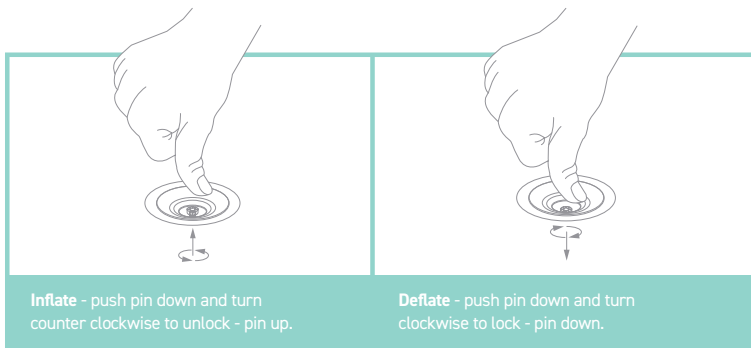

HOW TO

Inflating and deflating the Koda Aero Kayak is simple. First remove the folded kayak from the travel bag, unroll, insert the drop-stitch floor, attach the pump hose to the inflation valves and fill 'er up. When you are ready to pack it up, do everything in reverse.



CARE & STORAGE

Always store your Koda Aero Kayak in a cool, dry place or shady area out of reach of direct sunlight to avoid bursting or fading of colors. The sun both weakens the material and increases the inflated air pressure beyond its designed limits. If you must leave your Koda Aero Kayak out of the water and in direct sunlight, reduce the inflated air pressure until the kayak is compressible by hand.

Optimal inflation for floor chamber: 6 PSI
Optimal inflation for side chambers: 2-3 PSI

HOW TO FOLD



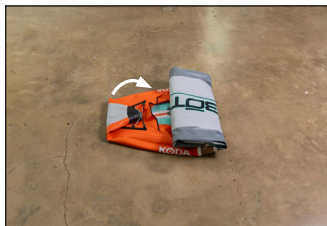
1. When you are finished with your Koda Aero Kayak, make sure to clean off any dirt, sand or salt water with fresh water and allow the kayak to dry. Remove accessories such as the center fin, softy seat(s) and footrest(s).

Begin deflating by removing the inflate/deflate port cap and pressing the push pin down until you can turn it clockwise to lock it open. Remove excess air with a hand pump or electric pump in deflate mode.



2. For easier setup and storage, keep your deck inside the pontoon hull.

Tuck in the nose cone and begin folding the front of the kayak in toward the center.



3. Then, tuck in the rear cone and begin folding the rear of the kayak in toward the center.



4. Continue folding the rear, bringing the folded rear section over the folded front section.

Your kayak should be in burrito form.

HOW TO FOLD



- 5.** Place your rolled kayak into the travel bag.

Gather your accessories such as the center fin, kayak paddle(s), softy seat(s) and footrest(s).



- 6.** Pack your accessories into the travel bag.



- 7.** Zip up your rolling travel bag and you're ready to go.
