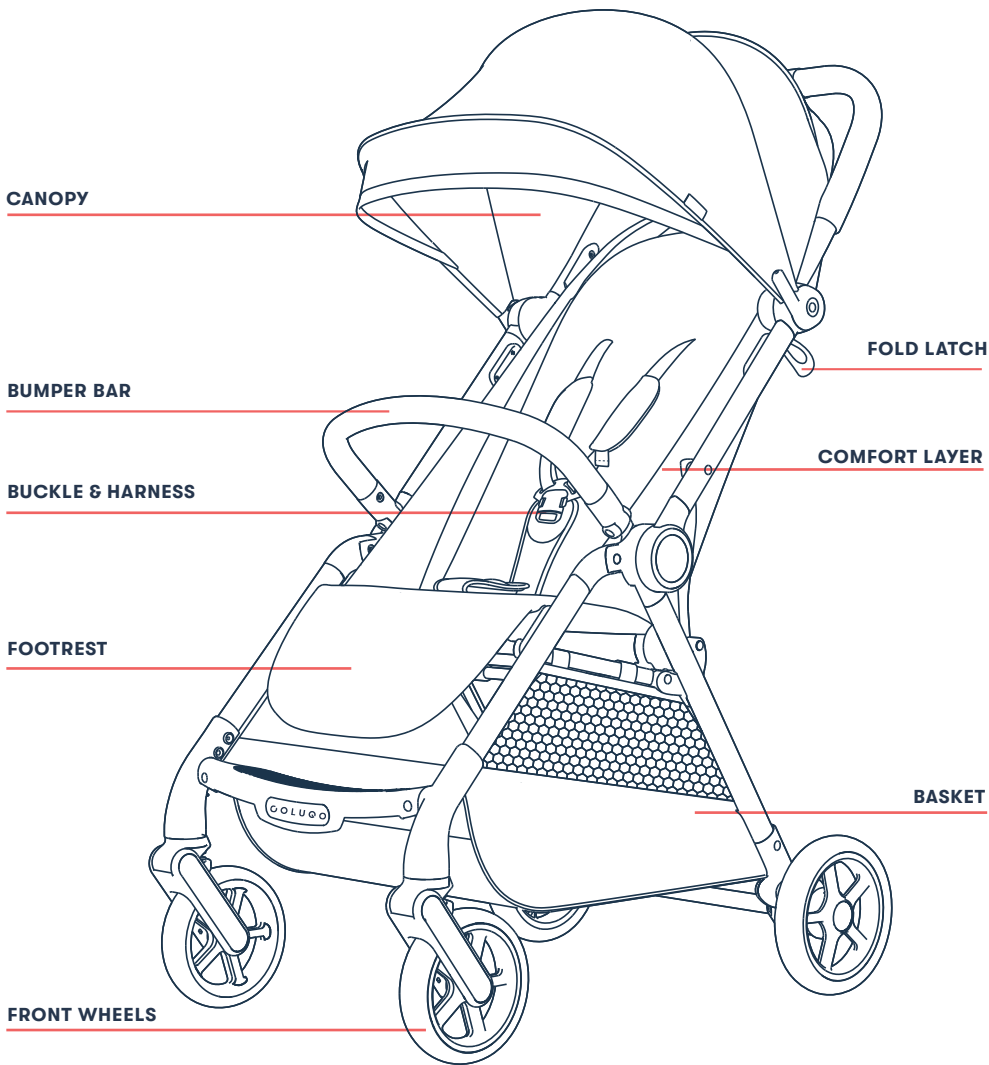
Failure to follow these warnings and the assembly instructions could result in serious injury or death.

WARNINGS

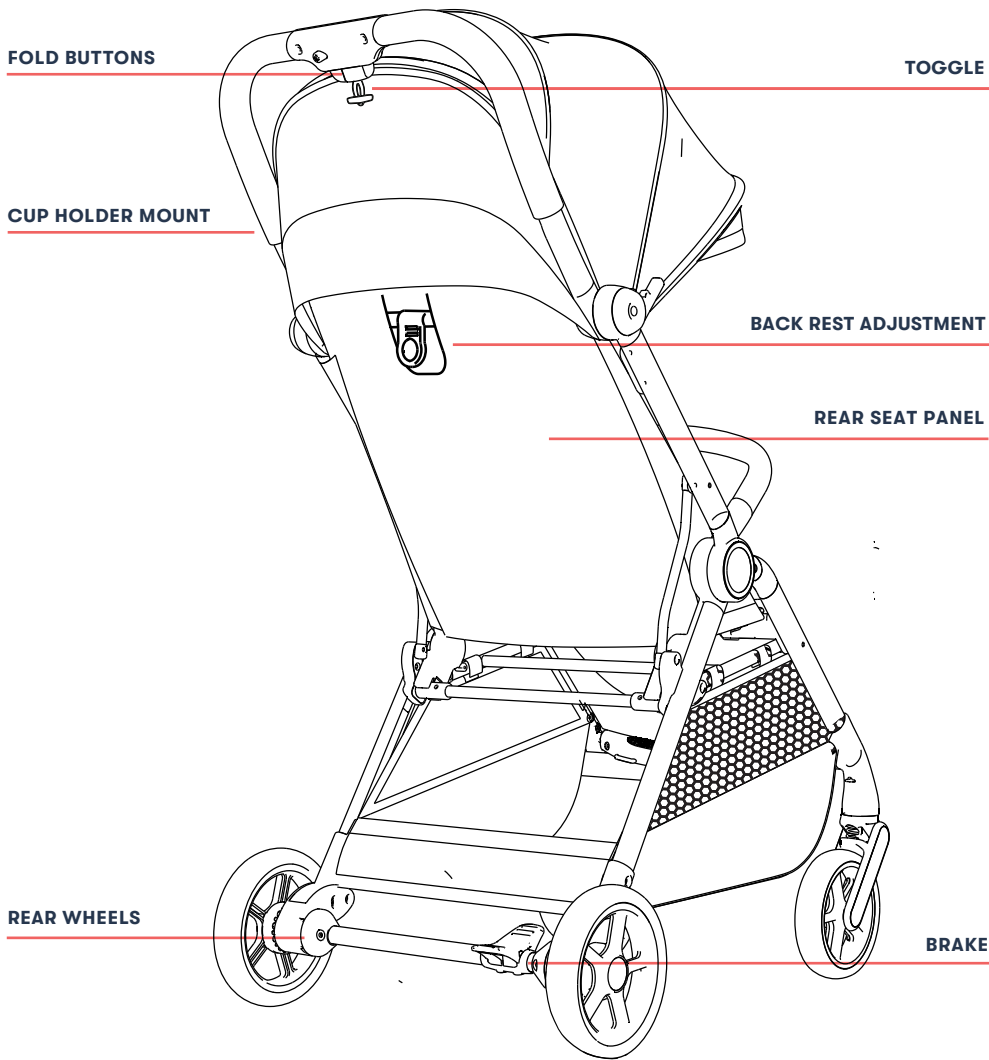
- **Never leave child unattended.** Always keep child in view while in the stroller.

Avoid serious injury from falling or sliding out. Child may slip into leg openings and strangle. Never use in reclined carriage position unless using infant system. Always use restraint system.
- **TO PREVENT HAZARDOUS, UNSTABLE CONDITION**
do not place more than 20 lbs in the storage basket.
- **TO AVOID INJURY TO YOUR CHILD DO NOT USE STORAGE BASKET AS A CHILD CARRIER.**
 - Never place purse, shopping bags, parcels or accessory items on the handle or canopy.
 - This stroller can be used with children up to 55 lbs.
 - **CUP HOLDER** - Do not use with hot liquids. Maximum weight .7 lb.
- **AVOID FINGER ENTRAPMENT:** Use care when folding and unfolding the stroller. Be certain the stroller is fully opened and latched before allowing child near the stroller.
- **ALWAYS ENSURE** that all parts of the child's body are clear of any moving parts. Do not carry additional children, parcels, goods or accessories in or on this product except as recommended in the manufacturers instructions.
- The brake must be locked while taking the child out of stroller and when parked.
- Keep stroller away from open fire and other sources of strong heat.
- Do not make any alterations or modifications to the stroller with products not supplied by the manufacturer as this may cause instability or structural damage.
- Do not use on stairs or escalators.
- When folded, make sure the stroller is stored in a place where it does not risk falling on a child.

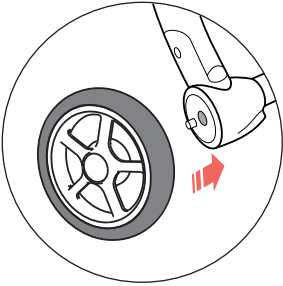

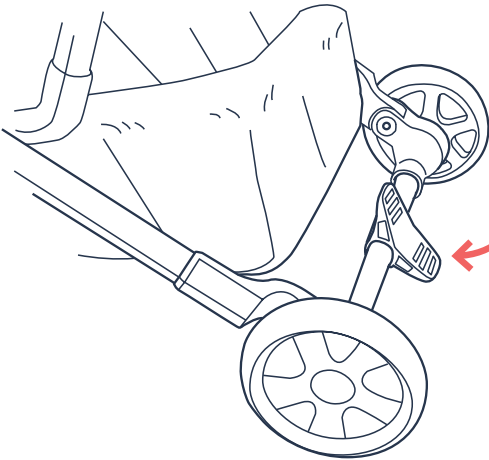


ATTACHING THE REAR WHEELS

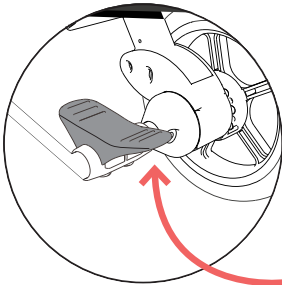
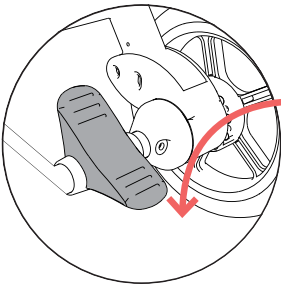


Guide the metal pin on the wheel into the hole in the rear wheel hub on the stroller base. Wheel locks with a "click".

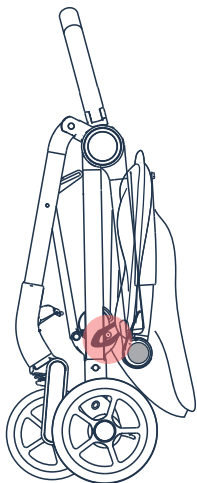
USING THE BRAKE



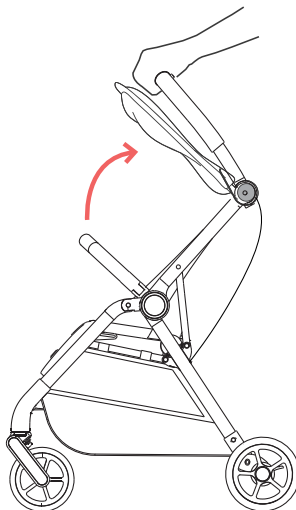
To lock the brake, push the pedal down. To unlock the brake, push the brake pedal up.



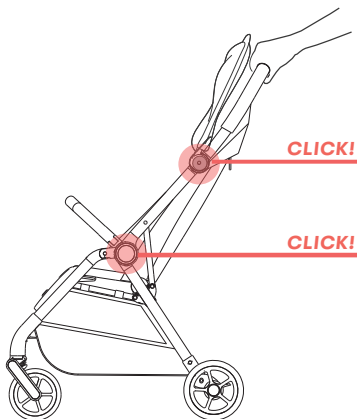
UNFOLDING THE STROLLER



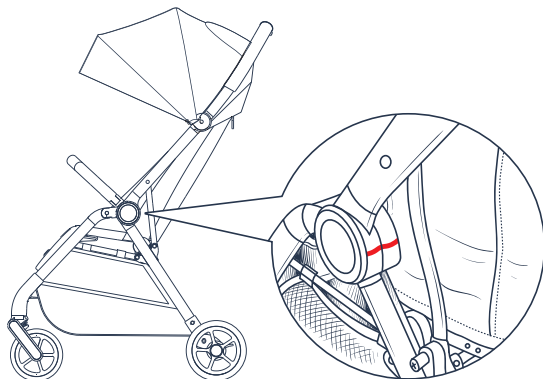
1. Release the fold latch.



2. Hold the handle and lift up.

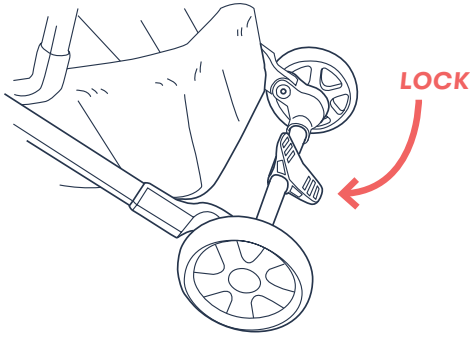


3. You will hear 2 clicks to indicate that the stroller is in its fully open position.

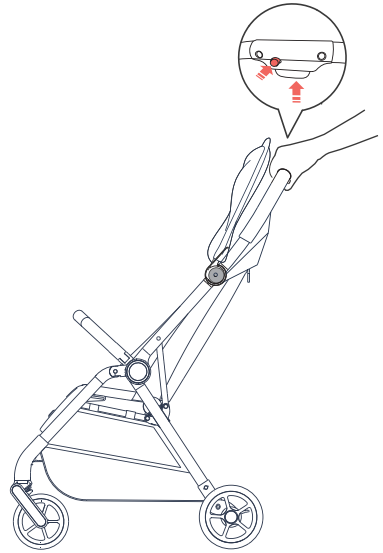


4. Ensure the markings on the side joint are aligned to confirm the stroller is in its fully open position.

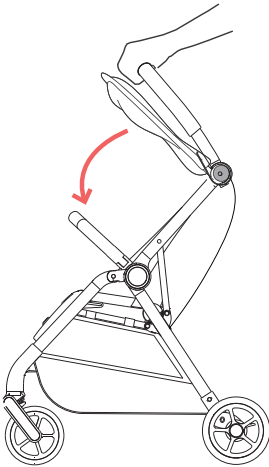
FOLDING THE STROLLER



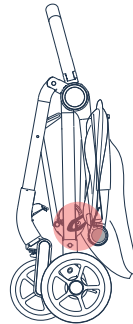
1. Lock the stroller using the brake.



2. Hold the handle, push the small button, then squeeze the large button.

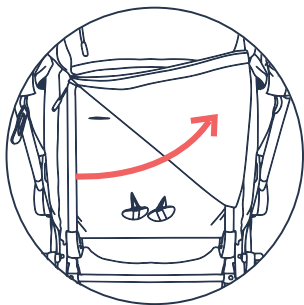


3. Push the handle down and forward, bringing the frame together. Fold Assist™ will help guide the frame together.



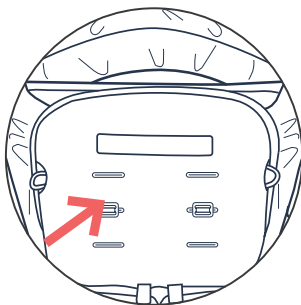
4. Ensure the fold latch is engaged.

ADJUSTING THE HARNESS



1. Unzip the rear seat panel.

Pro tip: you only need to unzip it about halfway.



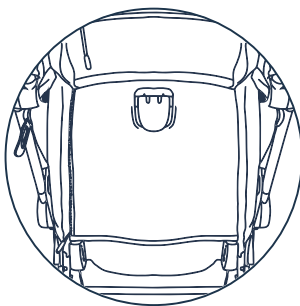
2. Push the plastic stopper on the end of the harness strap through the hole on the seatback to the front of the seat.



3. Push the plastic stopper through the seatback at the best height for your child.



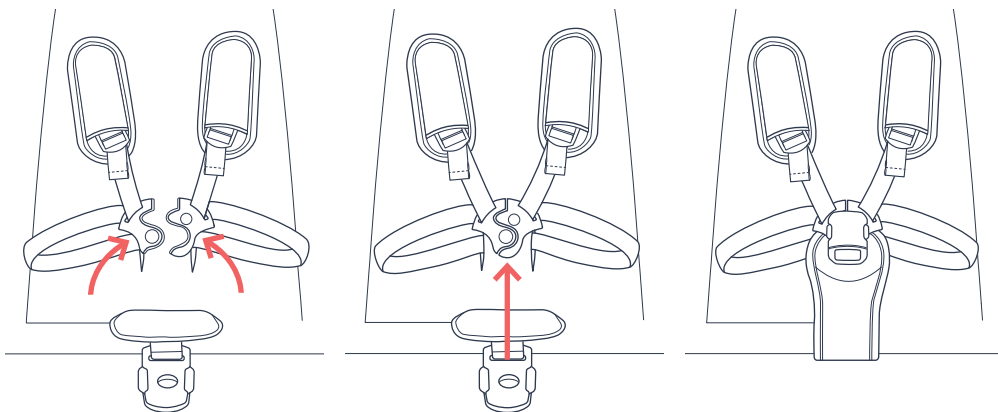
4. Tug the harness strap from the front to make sure it is secure.



5. Zip the rear seat panel closed.

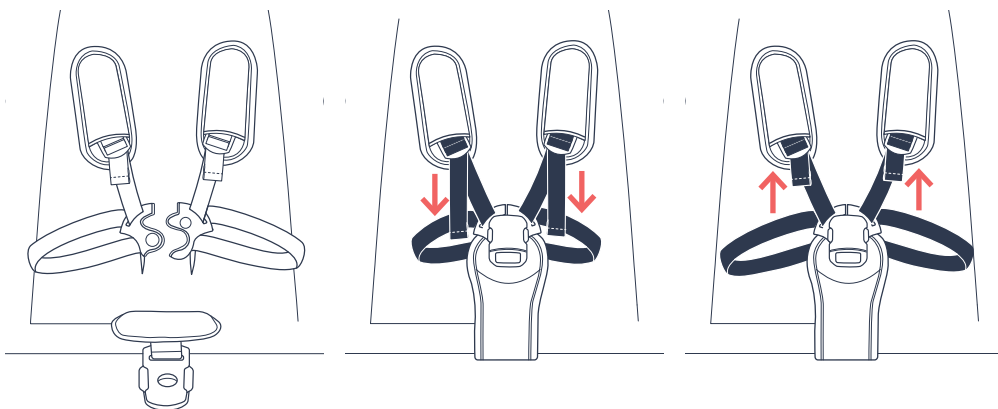
USING THE BUCKLE + ADJUSTING THE HARNESS

TIP: The sides of the buckle base are magnetically connected and a slight twisting motion separates them most easily.



BUCKLE THE HARNESS

1. Layer the three pieces of the buckle starting with the left side of the buckle base.
2. Place the right side of the buckle base on top of the left side. They will magnetically connect.
3. Place the buckle top on top of the buckle base. Buckle locks with a click.



UNBUCKLE THE HARNESS

Slide down sliders then squeeze side buttons on the top buckle at the same time and lift up. Pull apart the two sides of the buckle base.

TIGHTEN THE HARNESS

Pull the free end of the shoulder strap down through the slider and adjust the shoulder strap and waist belt as needed.

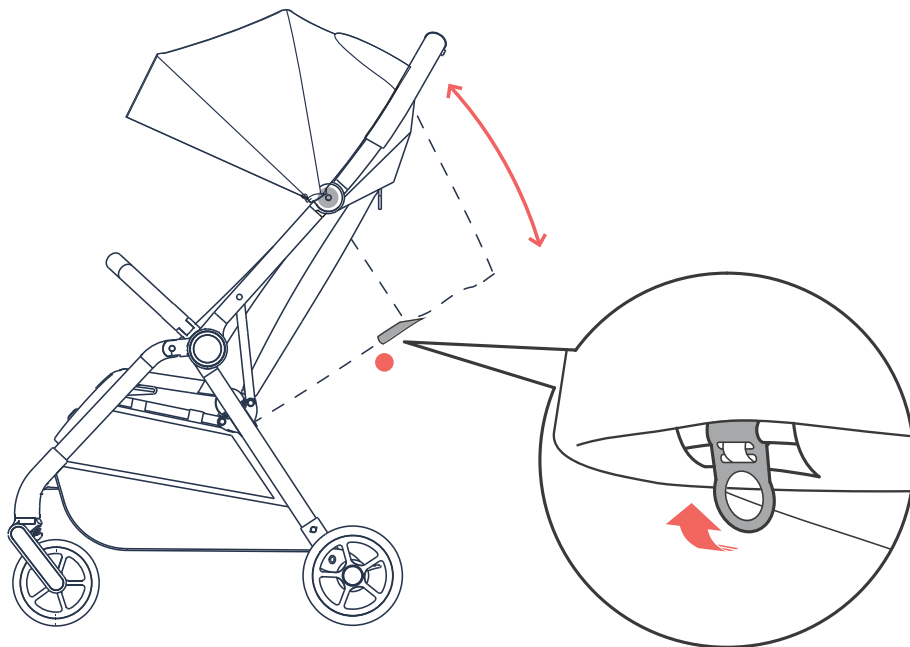
LOOSEN THE HARNESS

Push the free end of the shoulder strap back up through the slider and adjust the shoulder strap and waist belt as needed.

ADJUSTING THE SEAT

RECLINING THE SEAT

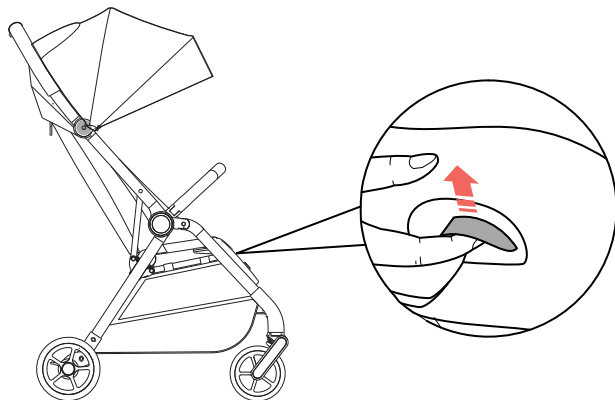
Pull backrest adjustment lever and allow the seat to recline into position.



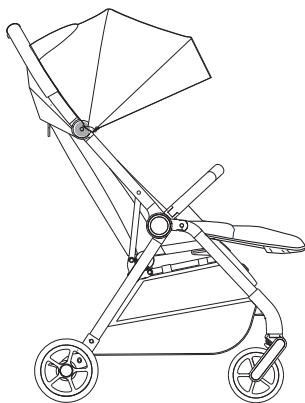
RAISING THE SEAT

Push the backrest up into position until you hear a click!

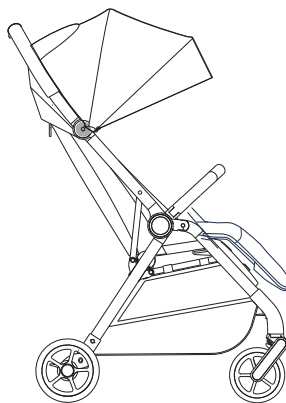
ADJUSTING THE FOOTREST



1. Slide the footrest adjustment lever toward the bottom of the footrest to unlock the footrest.



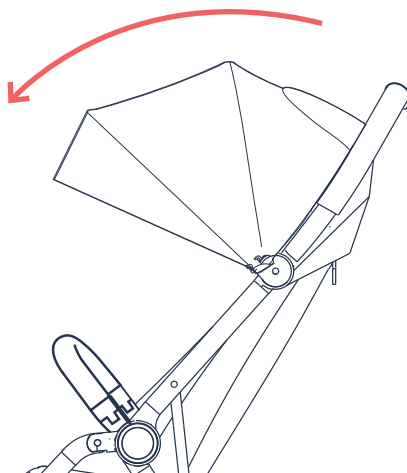
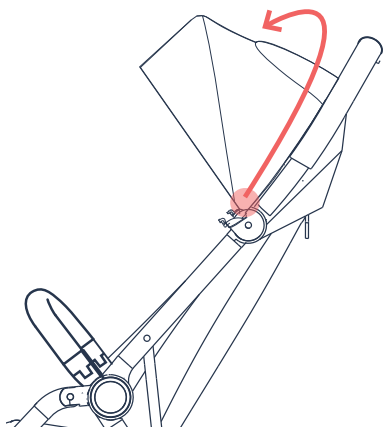
Footrest Up



Footrest Down

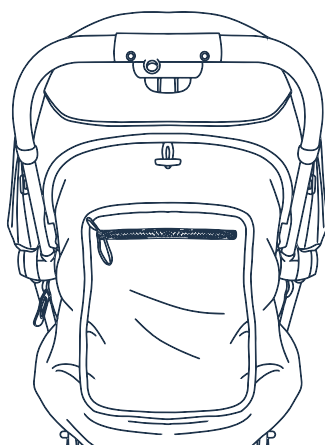
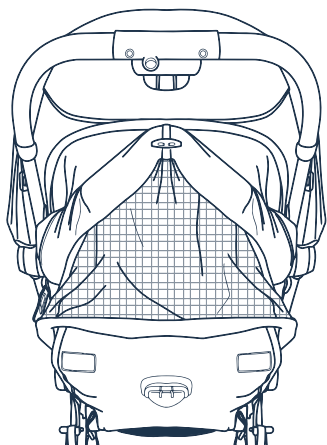
2. Adjust the footrest position upward or downward until it is in either the 'up' or 'down' position.

SUN PROTECTION



EXTENDING THE CANOPY

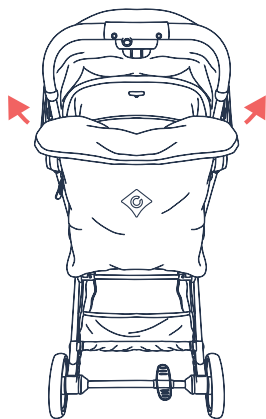
1. To fully extend the canopy, unzip the canopy extension.
2. Pull the canopy forward.



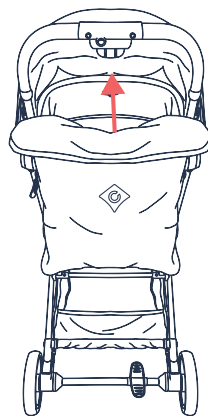
USING THE CANOPY

1. To use the back canopy, detach the toggle and elastic loop and roll down.
2. Attach the bottom of the back canopy to the velcro.
3. To hide the back canopy, detach the velcro, roll up and secure using the toggle and the elastic.

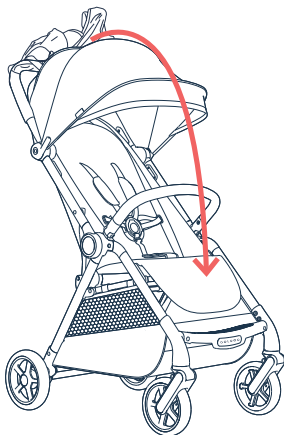
RAIN PROTECTION



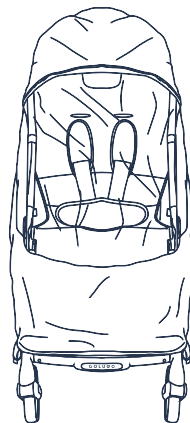
1. Attach the rain cover bag to the stroller frame (just under the handle) using the velcro straps on the outside of the bag. The Colugo logo should be facing out.



2. Pull the rain cover out from the bag *underneath the handle*.



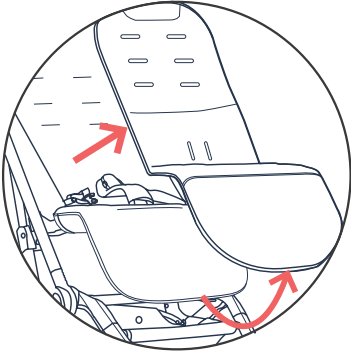
3. Drape the rain cover over the stroller.



4. Secure the back flap of the rain cover on both sides using the velcro.

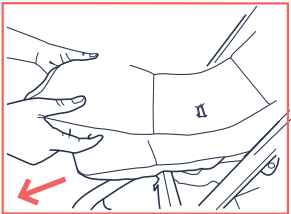
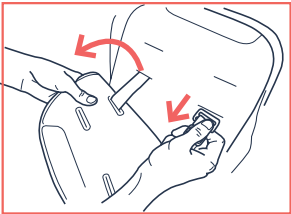
5. Attach the rain cover to the bottom of the stroller above the front wheels, using the velcro straps.

CARING FOR THE COMFORT LAYER

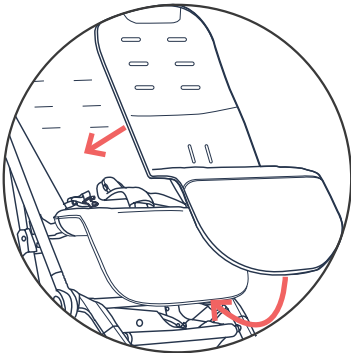


REMOVING THE COMFORT LAYER

1. Unbuckle the harness and detach the top of the comfort layer.
2. Push the plastic stopper through the hole to the front.

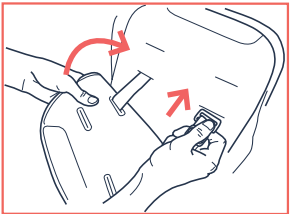
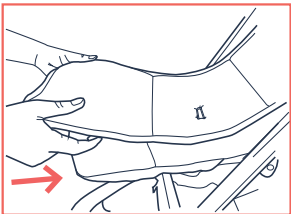


3. Pull harness strap plastic stoppers and buckle through Comfort Layer.
4. Slide Comfort Layer off the seat.



REPLACING THE COMFORT LAYER

1. To replace the Comfort Layer, pull harness straps and buckle through the Comfort Layer.

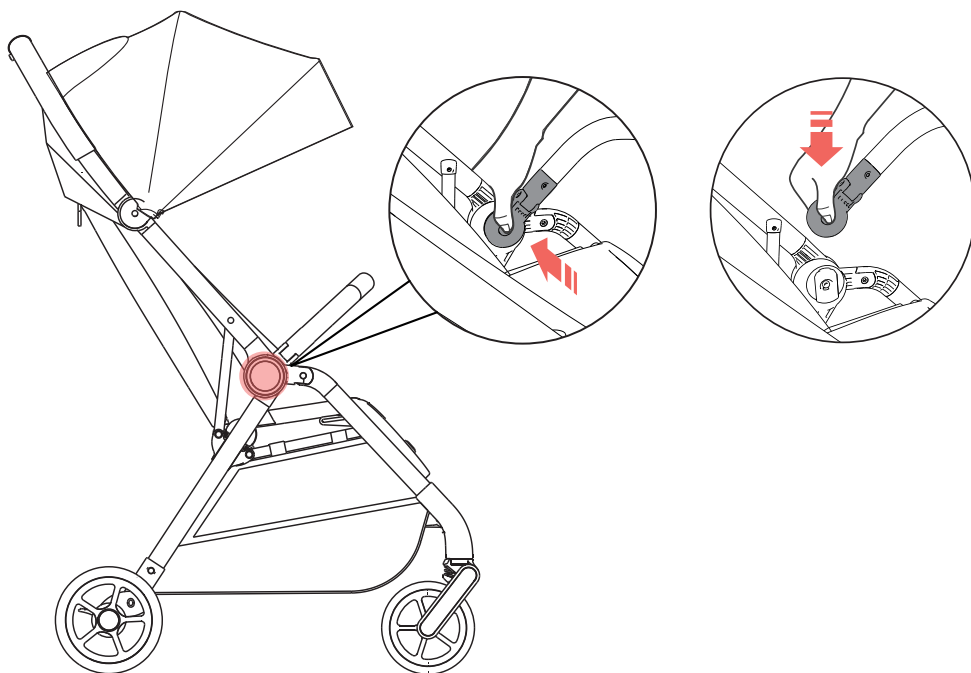


2. Reattach the harness straps at the appropriate heights and slide the comfort layer onto the seat.

BUMPER BAR

THE BUMPER BAR IS NOT A RESTRAINT DEVICE. ALWAYS SECURE YOUR CHILD WITH THE HARNESS.

1. Align bumper bar ends with bumper bar mounts and insert until they click into place.
2. To rotate the bumper bar, press the release button on one side and rotate the bumper bar from the other side.
3. To remove the bumper bar, press the release buttons and pull the bumper bar out.



CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

CLEANING

- **Frame:** Wipe with a damp cloth and let dry.
- **Basket:** Wipe with a damp cloth. Basket is fully removable.
- **Wheels:** Clean with a brush and a mild detergent.
- **Foot Rest:** Unzip to shake out crumbs or wipe clean.
- **Comfort Layer:** Machine washable, air dry.
- **Canopy:** Spot clean.
- All base layer fabrics are removable.

MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR:

- This product requires user inspection and maintenance regularly. Check all connecting hardware (rivets, screws, etc.) for tightness and security. Inspect all brakes, tires, seat harnesses and locks for correct operation. Seek prompt repairs or replacements as needed and never continue using the product if it is structurally not safe.
- Only Colugo replacement parts should be used. It may be unsafe to use parts supplied by another manufacturer.
