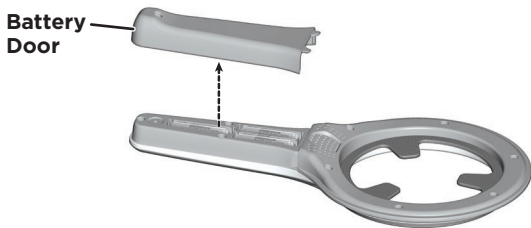


Wipe toy with a clean, damp cloth. Do not immerse. This toy has no consumer serviceable parts. Do not take apart.

Tips and Hints

- Center Smart Scanner no more than 15,24 cm (6 inches) above a Smart Disk.
- Smart Scanner will not recognize a disk if the disks are stacked, or placed too close to each other, or used on a metal surface. For best results, spread the Smart Disks out on the floor.
- If you lose a Smart Disk, press and hold the scan button to switch to a different activity.

Battery Installation



- For longer life, use **alkaline** batteries.
- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door and remove the door.
- Insert three, new AAA (LR03) **alkaline** batteries.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw. Do not over-tighten.
- If this toy begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power switch off and back on.
- When sounds/lights become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.

Battery Safety Information

In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the product. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of this product in a fire. The batteries inside may explode or leak.
- Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the product before charging.
- If removable, rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.

3 Ways to Play!



LETTERS & WORDS

- **Explore:** Scan a disk to learn about it.
- **Letter Detector:** Listen for the prompt and find the disk with the letter on it.
- **Treasure Hunt:** Listen to the prompt and find an object on a disk.



STORIES & MUSIC

- **Create Music:** Scan up to three disks to build a song. After about a minute, it's time for the next activity in this mode.
- **Write a Poem:** Scan a disk. Then listen to the prompts to add to your poem.
- **Create a Story:** Create a silly story by scanning disks just like you did to "write" a poem.



GAMES

Scatter the Smart Disks around the room for this mode!

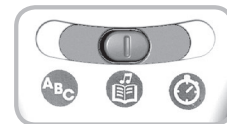
- **Red Light-Green Light:** Scan as many disks as you can before time runs out. **You do not need to press the scan button in this activity.** How many disks did you scan?
- **Beat-the-Clock:** Listen for the disk you need to find. Find it and scan it before time runs out.
- **Follow-the-Leader:** Listen for each disk you need to find. How many did you find?



Press this button to start activities or scan Smart Disks.

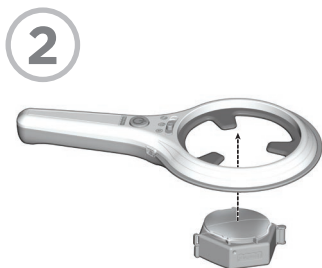
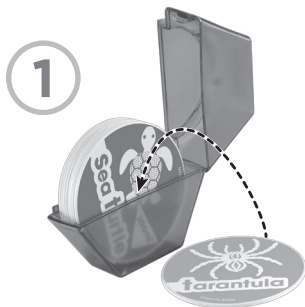


Slide the power switch ON ●. When finished playing, slide the switch OFF ○.

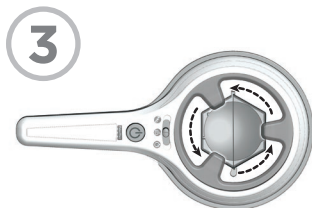


Slide the mode switch to: Letters & Words ●, Stories & Music ●, or Games ●.

Using the Disk Case



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- Fit the Smart Disks into the case and close the case.
 - Turn the case over so the raised side is up. Match the indented areas on the case with the tabs on the Smart Scanner.



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- Turn the case counter-clockwise.
 - Smart Disks are stored and ready for play!
