Musical Activity Mirror

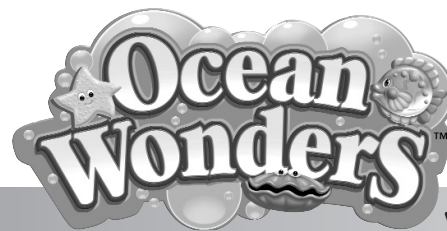


Please keep this instruction sheet for future reference,
as it contains important information.

Requires three "AA" batteries (included).

Adult assembly is required.

Tool required for battery replacement: Phillips screwdriver (not included).

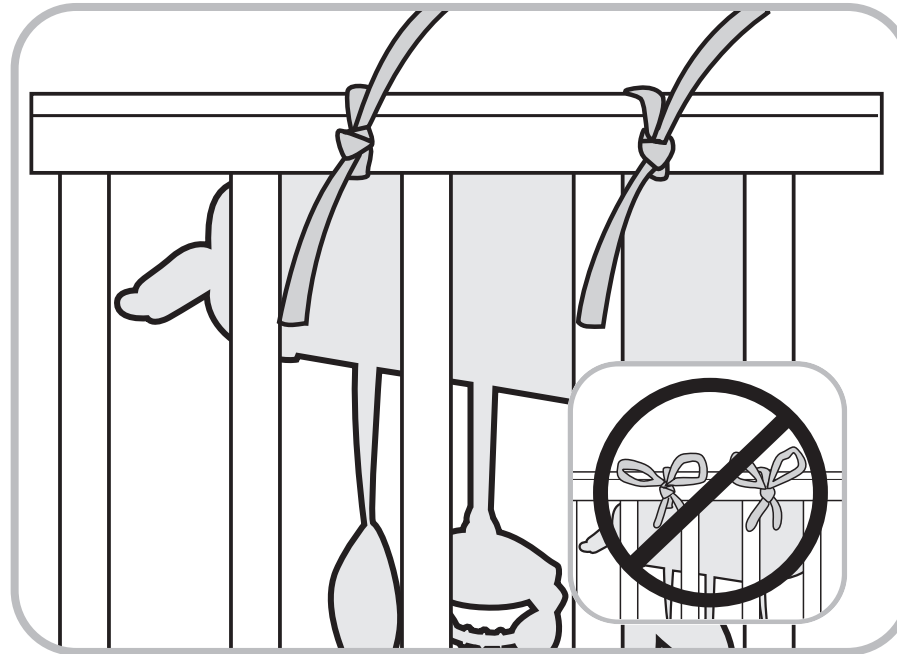


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⚠ CAUTION

- Always attach all provided fasteners (strings) tightly to a crib or playpen according to the instructions. Check frequently.
- Do not add additional strings or straps to attach to a crib or playpen.

Crib Attachment



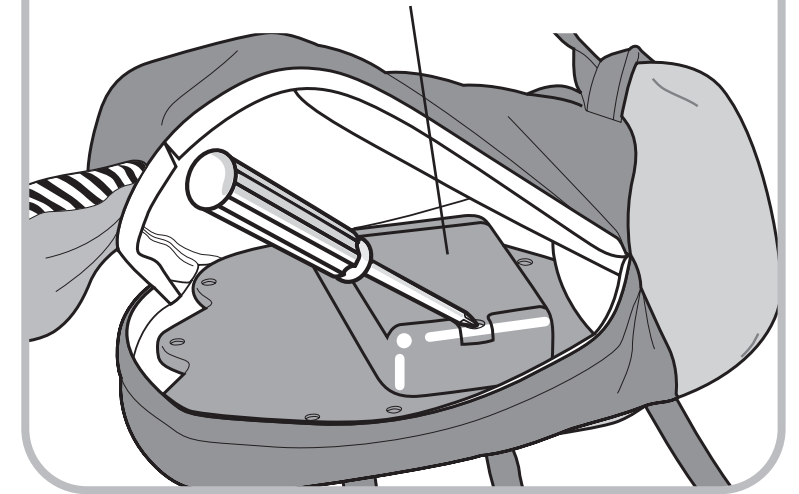
- Tie the toy's strings to the crib top rail.

Note: It is better to tie the strings in a knot than a bow, since a bow may be easily untied.

Battery Replacement

For best performance, we recommend replacing the batteries that came with this toy with three, new alkaline "AA" (LR6) batteries.

Battery Compartment Door

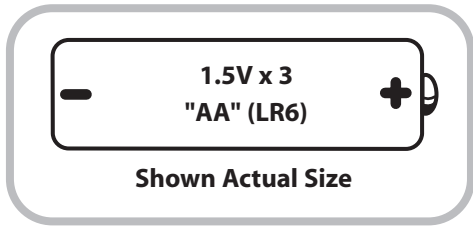


- Open the fasteners on the bottom of the toy.
- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver.
- Remove the battery compartment door.
- Insert three, "AA" (LR6) **alkaline** batteries.

Hint: We recommend using **alkaline** batteries for longer life.

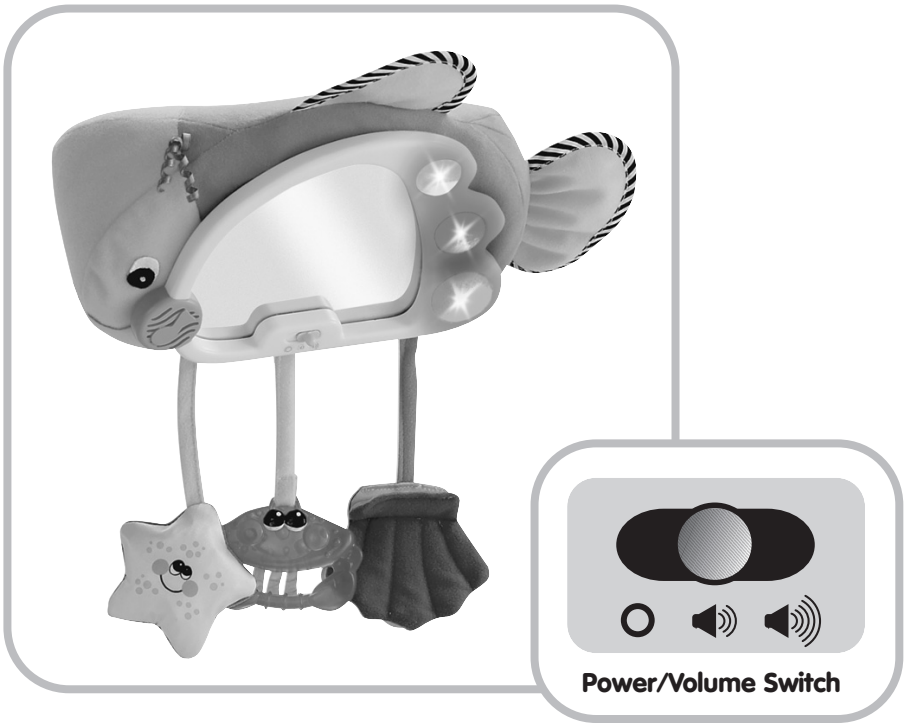
- Close the battery compartment door and tighten the screw with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.
- When sounds from this toy become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries!

Battery Safety Information



- Batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your toy. To avoid battery leakage:
- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
 - Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
 - Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the toy. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in a fire. The batteries may explode or leak.
 - Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
 - Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
 - Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
 - Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging.
 - If removable, rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Fun Music and Sound Effects



- Slide the power/volume switch to any of three positions: off ○; on with low volume 🔊 and on with high volume 🔊.
- Hint:** If your child is not actively playing with this toy, it turns off automatically (sleep mode).
- Slide the power/volume switch to the off position ○ when not in use.
 - When baby bats or tugs at the toys, lights activate and music and fun sound effects play.
 - Baby can also play with the mirror on the floor.

Care

- Surface wash only. Wipe with a clean cloth dampened with a mild soap and water solution.
- Do not immerse the toy.
