Three AA (LR6) **alkaline** batteries are required (not included).

Alkaline batteries make this toy work longer before you need to change them. When sound or lights become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.



Adult supervision required.

Never use near steps.

Choose areas for riding that are free of obstacles.

Learn to stop safely.

Use with caution as this product requires skill to operate safely to avoid falls, collisions, and injuries to yourself (the rider) and others.

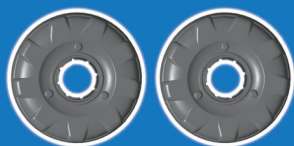
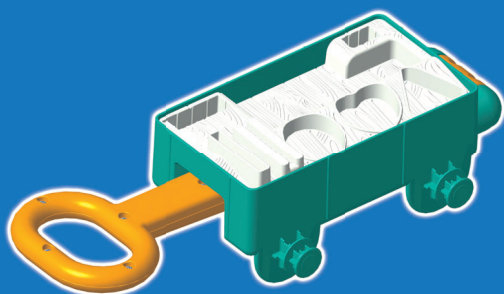
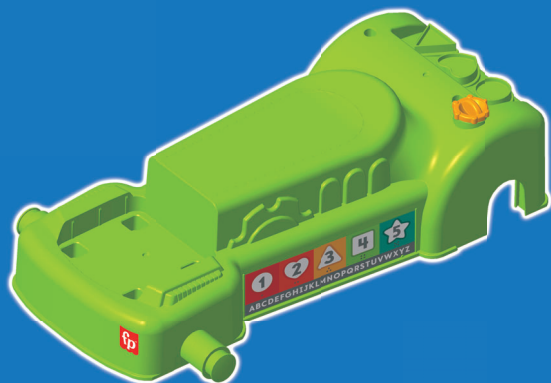

Wheels

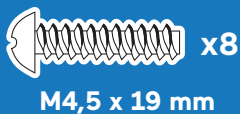


Small Front Tractor

Install Batteries



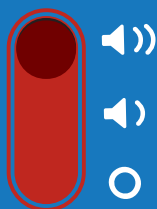
Locate the battery door on the side of the tractor steering column. Loosen the screw in the battery door and remove the door. Insert three, new AA (LR6) **alkaline** batteries. Make sure you insert the batteries correctly! Replace the battery door and tighten the screw.

Power-Volume and Mode Switches



Slide to turn power ON with low volume , ON with high volume , or OFF .

You may need to reset the electronics if this toy begins to operate erratically. Slide the power-volume switch off and back on.

- 3 Pretend** – Listen to engaging songs and phrases that inspire imaginative play!

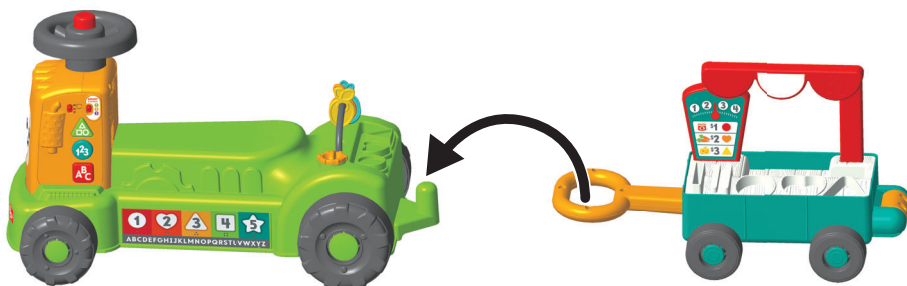

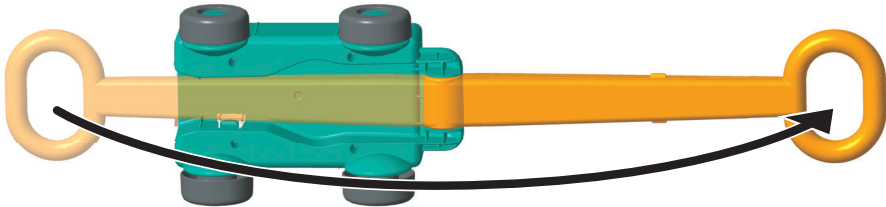
