Batteries included are for demonstration purposes only.

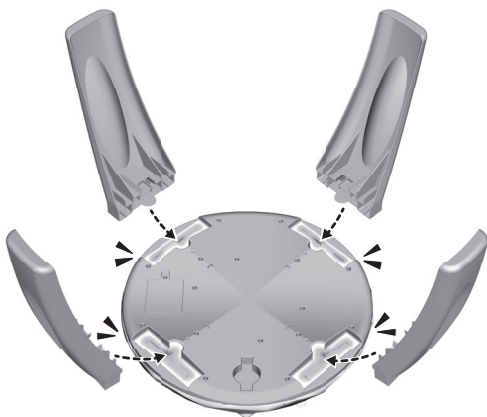
Battery replacement is required. Only adults should replace batteries. Tool required:

For longer life, use **alkaline** batteries.

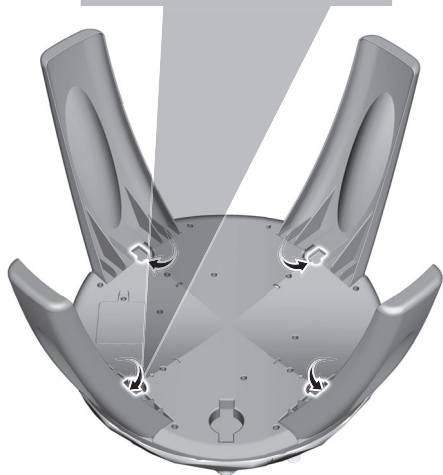
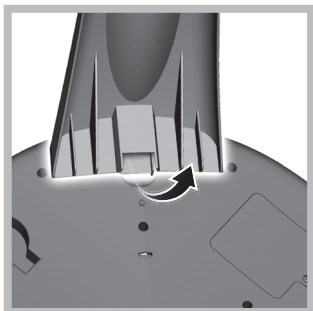
To clean, wipe all toys with a damp cloth.
Do not immerse.

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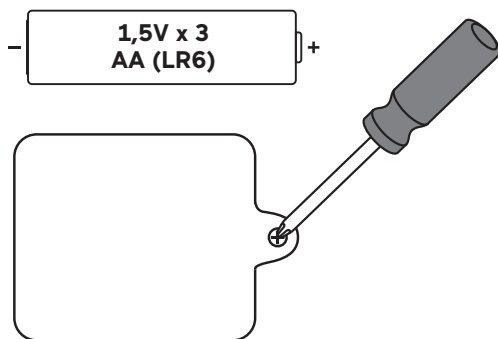

Battery Replacement



- For longer life, use **alkaline** batteries.
- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door and remove the door.
- Remove the exhausted batteries and properly dispose.
- Insert three, new AA (LR6) **alkaline** batteries.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw.
- If this toy begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power-volume switch off and then back on.
- When sounds or lights become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.

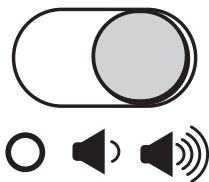

Lights, Sounds and Musical Fun!



Slide the power-volume switch to ON with low volume , ON with high volume  or  OFF.



Press the music note button for music, sounds and lights. Watch the center wheel spin!



Put a figure or a block in the peg opening or center of the table for more music, sounds and lights.



Press a piano key to play a music note with lights.

Hint: Wait a few seconds, then press a key to hear a musical ditty!
