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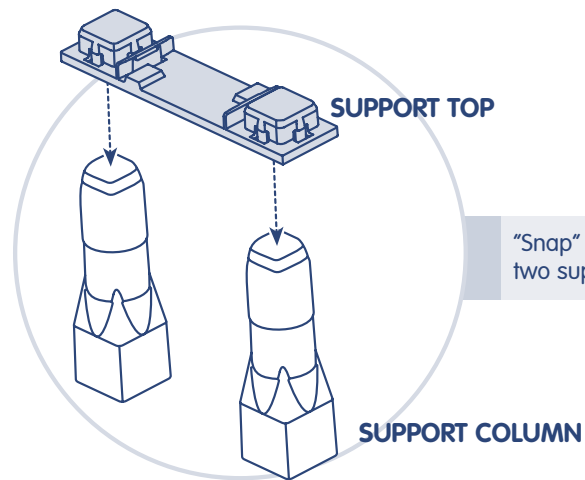
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Assembly

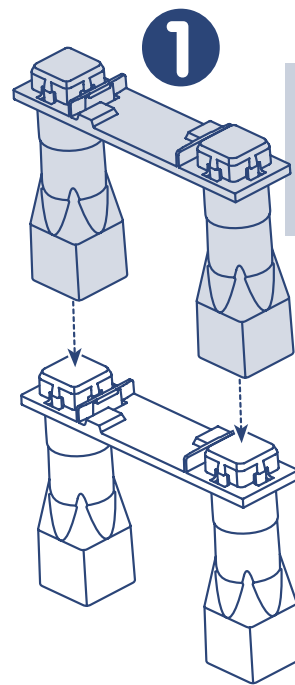


- Fit the tabs on an upper ramp into the slots in a lower ramp.
- Insert two screws into the upper ramp. Tighten the screws with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.
- Repeat this procedure to build the other upper/lower ramp assembly.

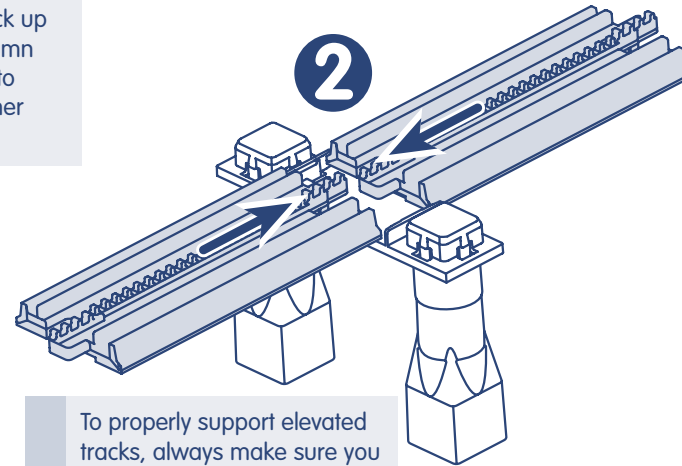


"Snap" a support top onto two support columns.

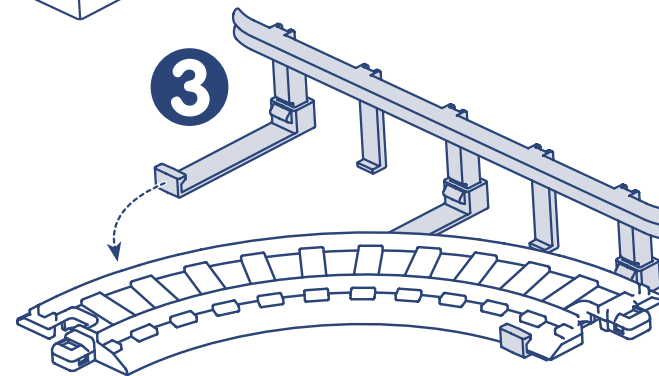
Elevation Track Tips



You can stack up support column assemblies to make a higher track layout.



To properly support elevated tracks, always make sure you have support columns under track connections.



- When using a curved track at the bottom of a ramp assembly, be sure to use a guardrail on the curve. This keeps the fast moving train on the track!
- To attach the guardrail, fit a tab on one end of the guardrail under the curved track, as shown.
- Bend the guardrail slightly to fit the other two tabs to the curved track.

The more you collect, the more fun it gets!
