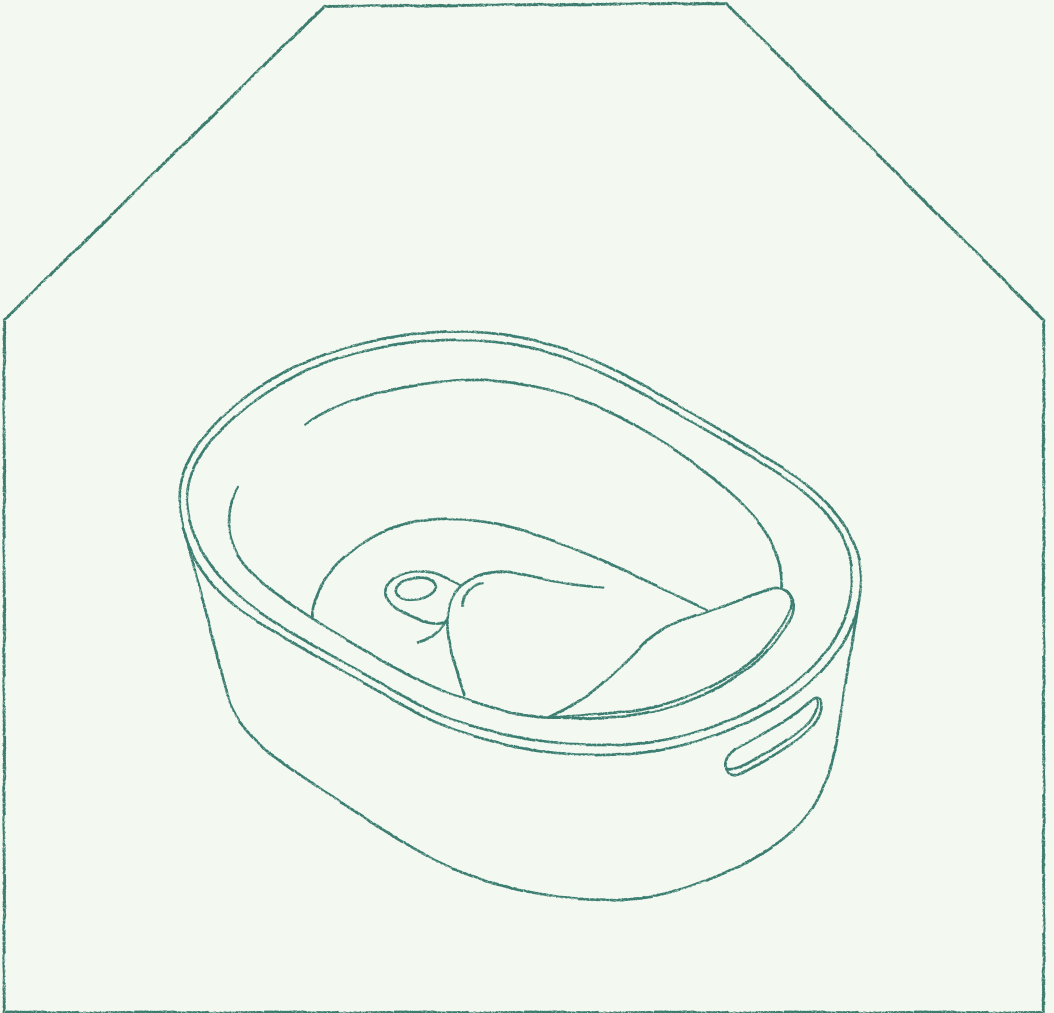

The Bath Tub



What's included

- A. Bath Tub Basin
- B. Infant Insert

⚠ WARNING:

Drowning Hazard: Babies have **drowned** while using infant bath tubs and inserts. **To prevent drowning:**

- Stay in arm's reach of your baby
- Use in empty adult tub, sink, or shower
- Keep drain open in adult tub, sink, or shower
- Never rely on a toddler or preschooler to help your baby or alert you to trouble. Babies have drowned even with other children in or near bath tub.
- Babies can drown in as little as 1 inch of water. Use as little water as possible to bathe your baby.

Fall Hazard: Babies have suffered **head injuries** falling from infant bath tubs and inserts. **To prevent falls:**

- Place tub **only** in adult tub, sink, or shower
- Never lift or carry baby in tub or insert

Only use the insert when properly installed in the tub. Never use the insert without the tub.

Suitable for 0-18 mo.

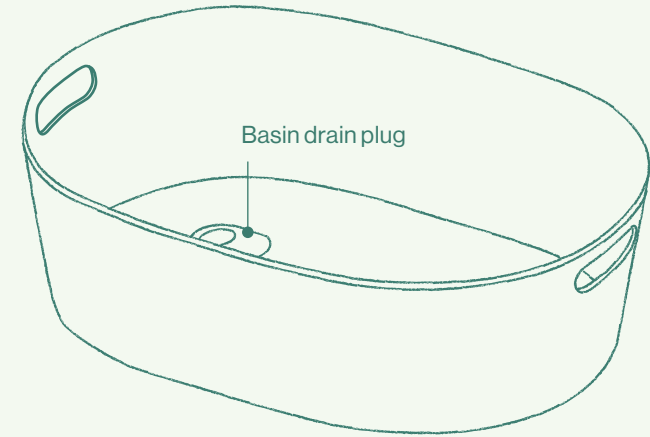
Test the temperature of the water in, or being put into, the bath tub/insert prior to placing the baby in. Typical water temperatures for bathing a baby should be between 90°F and 100 °F (32.2 °C and 37.8 °C).

Do not use The Bath Tub if any part is damaged, loose, broken, missing or incorrectly assembled

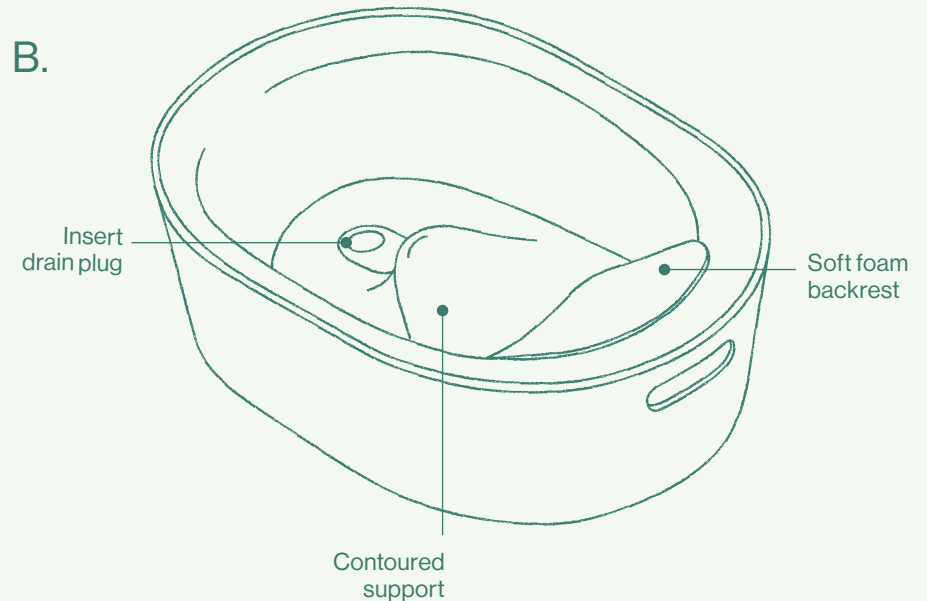
Cleaning & Care

- To Clean: Hand wash tub and components with warm, soapy water. Then, let it air dry.

Bathtub stages

Stage 1: Newborn, 0-3 mo

Recommended for babies that cannot sit up on their own. To get ready for your first bathtime, twist open the drain on the bottom basin and then drop the infant insert into the basin. Next, secure the insert drain closed to keep water in the bath. Rest your little one against the foam backrest and scrub a dub dub. Bottom tub drain **MUST** be open when infant insert is in use.

Stage 2: Infant, 3-6 mo

Recommended for babies that are learning to sit up. Just as in stage 1, twist open drain on the bottom basin before dropping in the infant insert. Then sit your little one up on the side opposite the foam backrest. The contoured support bar will help keep them in place. Bottom tub drain **MUST** be open when infant insert is in use.

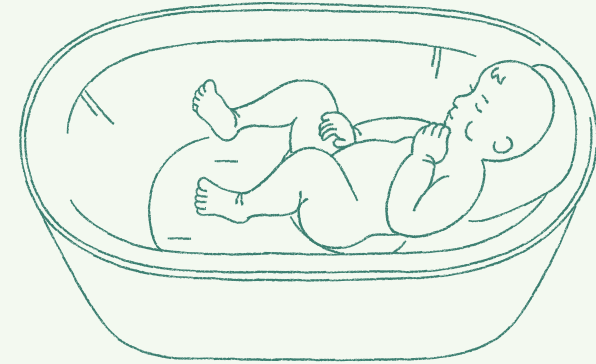
Stage 3: Baby, 6 mo-18 mo

Recommended for older babies who can sit up on their own. When they're ready for stage 3, remove infant insert so your little one has more freedom to splash around in the basin. Secure drain by rotating closed and pressing down.

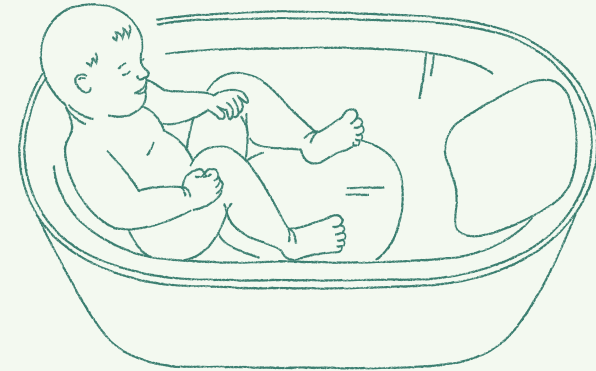


Pro Tip: Every child develops at their own pace. If you have questions about when to safely move your child from one step to the next we encourage you to ask your pediatrician.

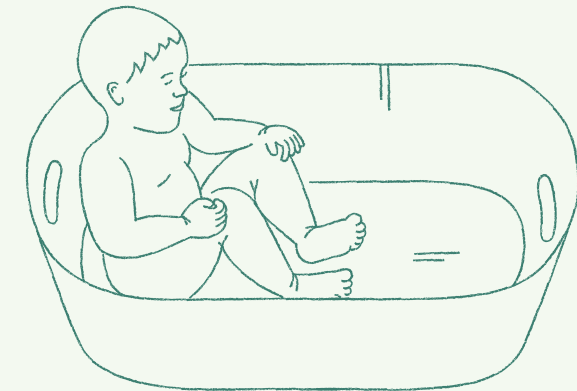
Stage 1



Stage 2

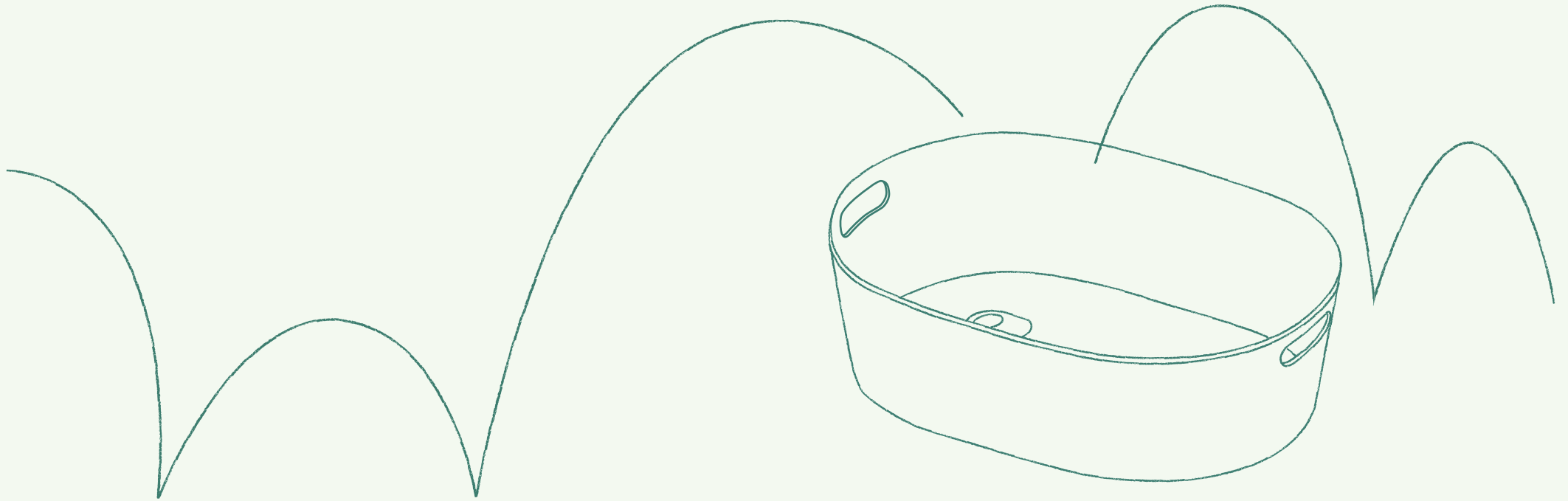


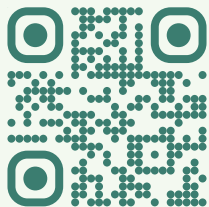
