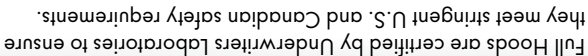

Always unplug all devices before reaching into the aquarium water!

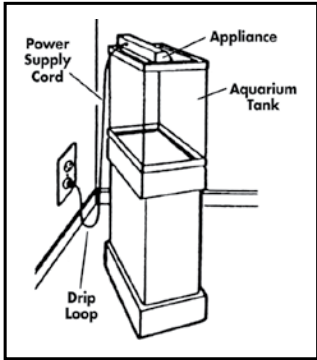

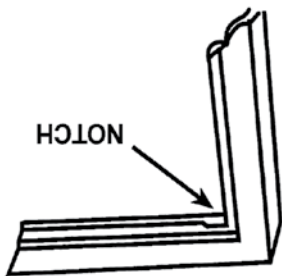
Special care should be taken since water is employed in the use of aquarium equipment. For each of the following situations, DO NOT ATTEMPT REPAIRS YOURSELF. Return the appliance to an authorized service facility for service, or discard the product.

1. A. If the appliance falls into water, DON'T reach for it! First, unplug it and then retrieve it. If electrical components of the appliance get wet, unplug the appliance immediately.
- B. Carefully examine the appliance after installation. It should not be plugged in if there is water on parts not intended to be wet.
- C. Unplug the appliance before installing, repositioning, cleaning or removing the appliance.
- D. Do not operate any appliance if it has a damaged cord or plug, or if it is malfunctioning, or if it is dropped or damaged in any manner.
- E. To avoid the possibility of the appliance plug or receptacle getting wet, position the aquarium stand and tank to one side of a wall mounted receptacle to prevent water from dripping onto the receptacle or plug. A "drip loop," shown in the Figure at right, should be arranged by the user for each cord connecting an aquarium appliance to the receptacle.



The “drip loop” is that part of the cord below the level of the receptacle or the connector if an extension cord is used, to prevent water from traveling along the cord from coming in contact with the receptacle. If the plug or receptacle does get wet, DON'T unplug the cord. Disconnect the fuse or circuit breaker that supplies power to the appliance. Then unplug and examine for presence of water in receptacle.

2. Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
3. To avoid injury, do not contact moving parts or hot parts such as heaters, reflectors, lamp bulbs, etc.
4. Always unplug an appliance from an outlet when not in use, before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning. Never yank cord to pull plug from outlet. Grasp the plug and pull to disconnect.
