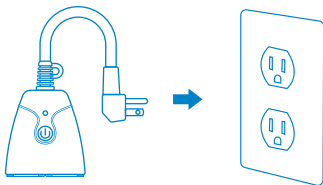
- Do not install the plug with wet hands or when standing on wet or damp surfaces.
- Do not plug electrical appliances with a current of more than 15A to this plug.
- Do not soak the plug in water or spray water on it. Otherwise, it will be damaged.
- The outlets should remain capped with the included waterproof covers while not in use. Otherwise, the plug might be damaged by rain or dew.

■ Installation Guide

1. Download the Meross app.



2. Plug MSS620 into an outlet near your Wi-Fi router*.



* This is required during setup process only.

* MSS620 supports 2.4GHz Wi-Fi only.

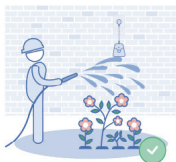
3. Set up the device.

- (1) Connect your smartphone or tablet to a 2.4 GHz Wi-Fi network.
- (2) Make sure your smart device is covered by strong Wi-Fi signal.
- (3) The smart device supports iOS 13/ iPadOS 13 and later. It is recommended that you upgrade your iOS or iPadOS to the latest version before pairing with the smart device.
- (4) Launch the Meross app and log in to your account, or if you are a new user, tap Sign up to create a new account.
- (5) Tap the “+” icon to select the type of smart device you want to add, then you can just follow the setup wizard to finish configuration.
- (6) Relocation of the smart device does not require additional operations provided that it remains on the same network with strong Wi-Fi signal.

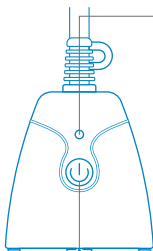
NOTE:

1. According to Apple HomeKit, the only way to set up HomeKit accessory with iOS is Home app. If you don't want to set up with Home app, you will have to use an Android device.
2. If you can't set up the device with Home app. It might be that the iOS is having cache issue with Homekit device. Please try to
 - a. Reset the device and kill the Home app and retry.
 - b. Restart your iOS and retry. (This is important.)
 - c. Ensure that your iOS is connecting to 2.4G of your home Wi-Fi.
 - d. Have your iOS to forget **all** other Wi-Fi in your home.
3. As long as you finish configuration, you'll be able to manage the device in Apple Home app.
4. If the QR code does not work, please try to add the smart device in Apple Home app.

Status LED

Flashing rapidly (twice/sec):

Wi-Fi connecting.

Flashing slowly (once/sec):

Configuration mode.

Solid red or amber: No internet connection.

Solid green: At least one socket is ON.

Off: Successfully connected.

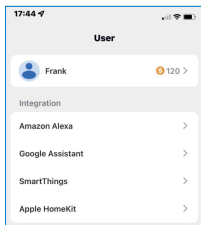
Power Button

Press to turn both sockets ON or OFF.

Press and hold (for 5 seconds) until Status LED flashes red rapidly to initiate factory reset process.

■ Link Meross to Google Assistant or Amazon Alexa

Set up the device in the Meross app and link to the voice assistants.

Go to **User-> Amazon Alexa** and allow Meross to link with Alexa.

1. What devices can I control with the Smart Wi-Fi Outdoor Plug?

You can control lights, fans, humidifiers, portable heaters, and outdoor electric appliances in accordance with the MSS620's specifications (up to 15A).

2. What should I do when my Meross app is unable to control the added Smart Wi-Fi Outdoor Plug?

You can troubleshoot the following:

- Check whether your home Wi-Fi is connected to the internet or not.
- Make sure the password of your home Wi-Fi hasn't been changed.
- Make sure your MSS620 is covered by your home Wi-Fi. Moving it closer to Wi-Fi router or install a Wi-Fi range extender would help.
- If all else fails, please factory reset your MSS620 and try to add it again.
