Warnings

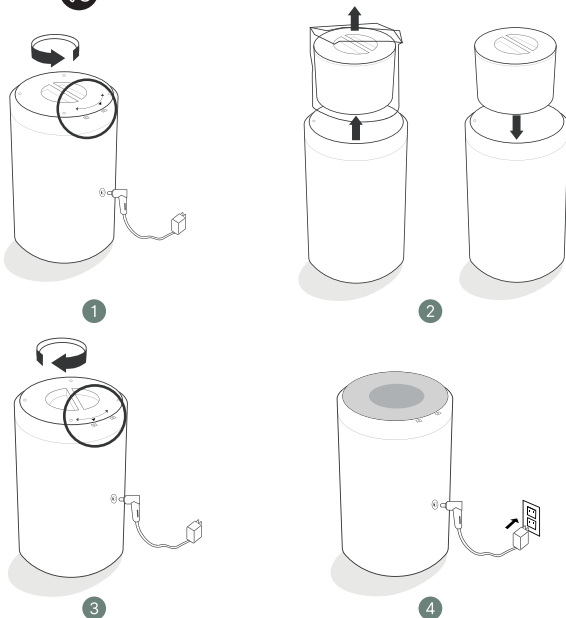
1. To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or other injuries, **READ AND SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS.**
2. Keep the air purifier away from water and damp areas. Never place it in or near liquids.
3. Do not use the air purifier in areas with flammable gases, vapors, metal dust, aerosol (spray) products, or industrial oil fumes.
4. Always remove the plastic packaging from the filter before use. Otherwise, the air purifier will not filter air properly and may overheat.
5. Do not sit on the air purifier or place heavy objects on it. Avoid inserting any items into the openings of the air purifier.
6. Unplug or disconnect the appliance from the power supply before servicing.
7. Do not use the air purifier if it is damaged, malfunctioning, or if the power cord or plug is damaged.
8. Never place the power cord near heat sources. Do not cover the cord with rugs, mats, or other materials. Avoid running the cord under furniture or appliances. Keep the cord in a location where it will not cause tripping.
9. Maintain a distance of at least 5 feet (1.5m) from areas where oxygen is being administered.
10. Children should not clean or maintain the air purifier without supervision.
11. To Reduce The Risk Of Fire Or Electric Shock, Do Not Use This Fan With

Any Solid-State Speed Control Device.”

12.To Reduce The Risk Of Fire, Electric Shock Or Injury To Persons, Do Not Use Replacement Parts That Have Not Been Recommended By The Manufacturer (e.g. Parts Made At Home Using A 3D Printer)."

Instructions for Use

- Turn the air purifier upside down. Rotate and remove the bottom filter cover.
- Take the filter out of its plastic packaging. Then reinsert the filter into the air purifier and rotate and lock the filter cover back in place.
- Place the air purifier on a flat, stable surface. Keep it away from any objects that may obstruct airflow.
- Plug in the power adapter to an outlet. Press  to turn on the air purifier, and press  to switch fan speeds.



Explanation of Settings

Button	Icon	Button Function
Power Button		Short press to turn on/off.
Wind Speed		Repeatedly press the button to cycle through: Speed 1 → Speed 2 → Speed 3 → Auto Mode.
Timer		Repeatedly press the button to cycle through: 2h → 4h → 8h → Cancel timer setting.
Sleep Mode Screen Display Adjustment		Short press to enter sleep mode. Press and hold the sleep button for 3s to turn off the panel light. Press any button to wake up the panel and keep the light on.
Night Light		Short press to turn the light on/ off. / Press and hold for 1.5s to adjust night light brightness.
Filter Reset Button		Press and hold both buttons simultaneously for 3s in the power-on state to reset the filter life.
