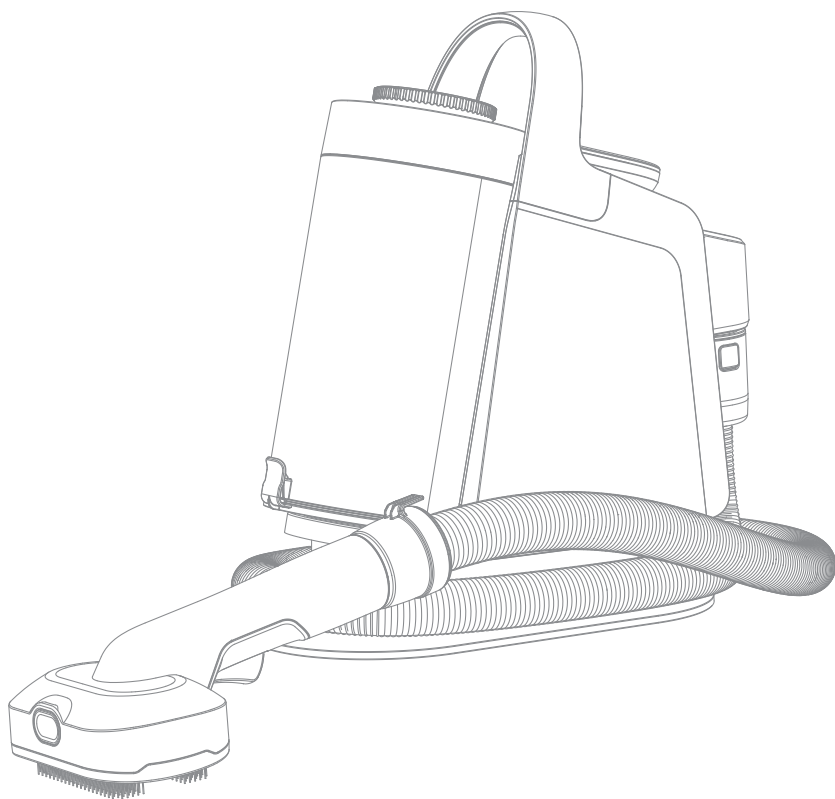

Pet Grooming Vacuum Kit USER MANUAL



Please read the user manual carefully before using this appliance

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SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- This product is intended for household use only and should not be used for commercial or industrial purposes. Avoid using it outdoors or in damp areas.
- Do not allow children or individuals with weak physical or mental abilities to use this product alone.
- When using the product, ensure a safe environment and supervise its use under the guidance of someone who understands its safe operation and potential risks. Children should not be allowed to use it without proper supervision.
- Exercise full caution when using the product around children and pets. Ensure that children and pets do not play with the product.
- Avoid touching the power plug and the product with wet hands. Do not attempt to suck up damp hair or liquids.
- Do not use this product if the power cord or power plug is damaged.
- In the event of product malfunction, damage, or immersion in liquid, please contact the company immediately.
- Avoid disassembling this product, as incorrect assembly may cause electric shock or fire. If repairs are needed, please contact the company.
- Refrain from vacuuming highly flammable substances (e.g., cigarette butts) and avoid using it in environments or near flammable gases.
- While using the product, do not pull the power cord, place heavy objects on top of the machine, or close doors with the wire in between.
- Do not suck up smoke, matches, hot ashes, or any other flammable, smoky, or hot items.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- **Before use, ensure that the opening is unblocked. Always unplug the plug from the socket before maintenance.**
- **Avoid using or storing this product outdoors or in humid places, such as the bathroom.**
- **Do not use air fresheners or scented products as filters, as these chemicals may cause fires.**
- **Use the product only under the specified voltage, which can be found on the bottom of the machine.**
- **Please do not operate or unplug the power cord with wet hands.**

To avoid malfunctions and electric shock, it is strictly prohibited.

- **Do not vacuum highly flammable materials (such as cigarette butts).**
To prevent fires or explosions, do not use the product in places with flammable liquids or combustible materials.
- **During the initial use, there may be an odor, but it will not cause any adverse effects on the body.**

While using the product for the first time, you may notice an odor, but it will dissipate over time. Please understand. However, if a burnt smell persists, please stop using it immediately!

- **Please regularly clean the dust cup and filter.**
Using the product when the dust cup and filter are dirty may cause product malfunctions.
- **During maintenance, always ensure that the power cord is disconnected.**
Performing maintenance while the power is on may pose a risk of electric shock or injury.

- **If the temperature of the product rises unusually, please stop using it immediately.**

If the motor overheats or if there is a blockage in the suction, please stop the operation, remove the cup, and ensure that the intake and filter are clean. Wait for 60 minutes before restarting.

- **Before use, please make sure all filters are installed.**
Using the product without filters may damage the motor.
- **If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service department or a specialist from a similar department in order to avoid danger.**

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

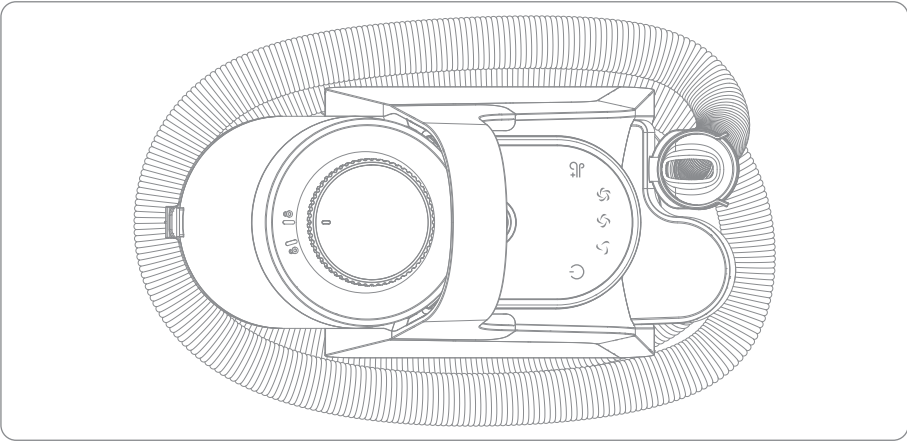


Assemble the parts gently by following the direction indicated by the arrow, and remove them in the opposite direction as indicated.

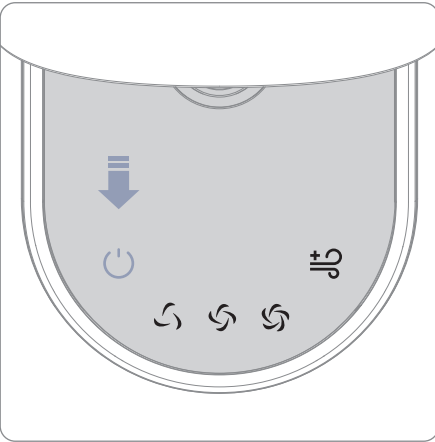


Connect the accessories to the main unit using the hose.

Power Switch

Press the power switch button on the main unit to turn on the power. To turn off the power, press the button again.



Mode Switch Button

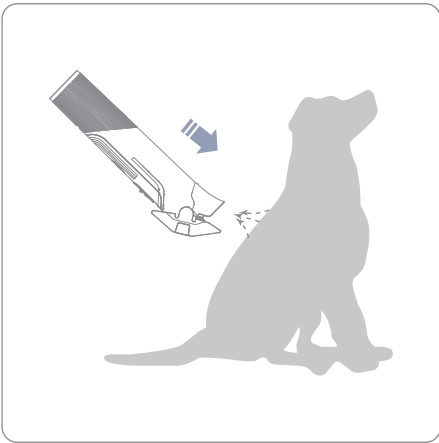
For stronger suction, press the mode switch button while in silent mode to switch to strong mode. To switch back to silent mode, press the button again.

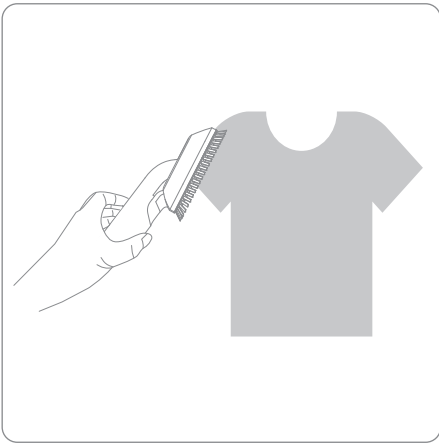
ACCESSORIES INSTRUCTIONS



Electric Clipper

Trim and vacuum pet hair without spreading it.

Note: When using, be aware of the blade and sharp edges to avoid excessive force that could cause cuts to the skin.



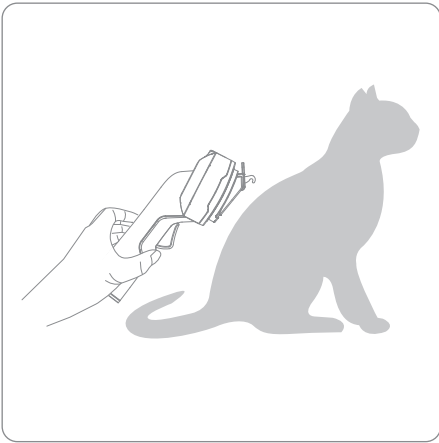
Fabric & Hair Cleaning Brush

Used to remove fallen hair from clothing and your pet's body.



Needle Comb

Effectively cleans loose and old hair and debris from your pet's body while fluffing up the coat.

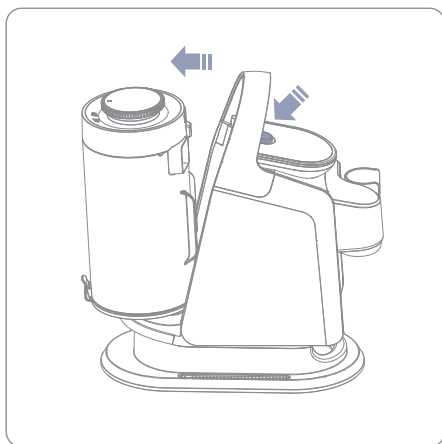


Knotted comb

Thins pet's coat for a grooming effect.

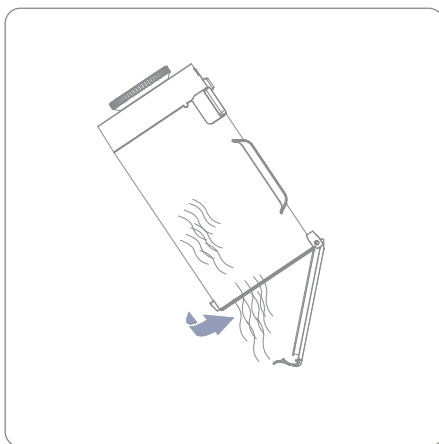
Note: Avoid applying excessive force to sensitive areas of your pet's skin to prevent cuts.

CLEANING THE DUST CUP



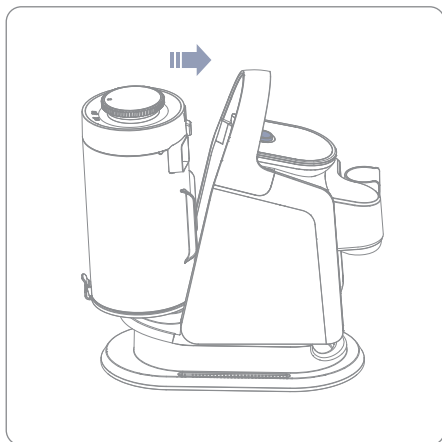
1. Remove the Dust Cup

Press the button in the direction of the arrow and pull it outwards.



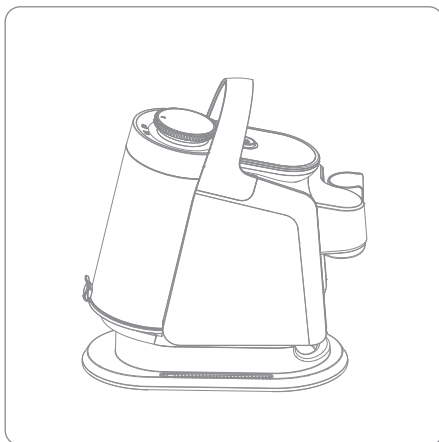
2. Open the Lid and Empty

Press the bottom lid release button of the dust cup to open it and empty the debris.



3. Reinstall the Dust Cup to the Main Unit

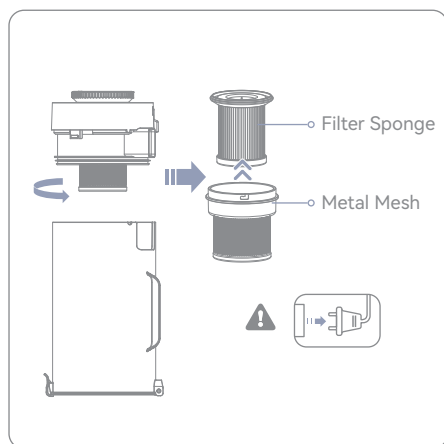
Place the bottom of the dust cup on the main unit's bracket rotate it in the direction of the arrow to align it with the main unit, and secure it in place.



4. Cleaning is Complete

Note: Handle the dust cup with care when removing or inserting it. If the removed dust cup is cleaned after emptying the debris, make sure to let it dry completely before reinstalling it to prevent the motor from getting wet and causing electric shock or damage to the machine.

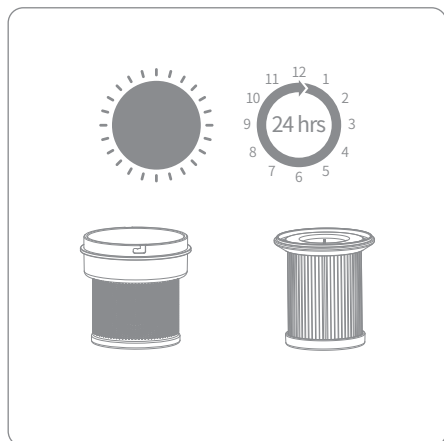
CLEANING THE FILTER COMPONENTS



1. Remove the dust cup and take out the hypha and metal mesh.

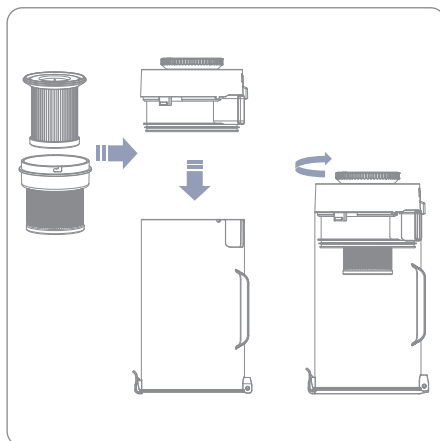


2. Rinse them with tap water and let them air dry.



3. Drying

Place them in a well-ventilated area for at least 24 hours to ensure thorough drying.



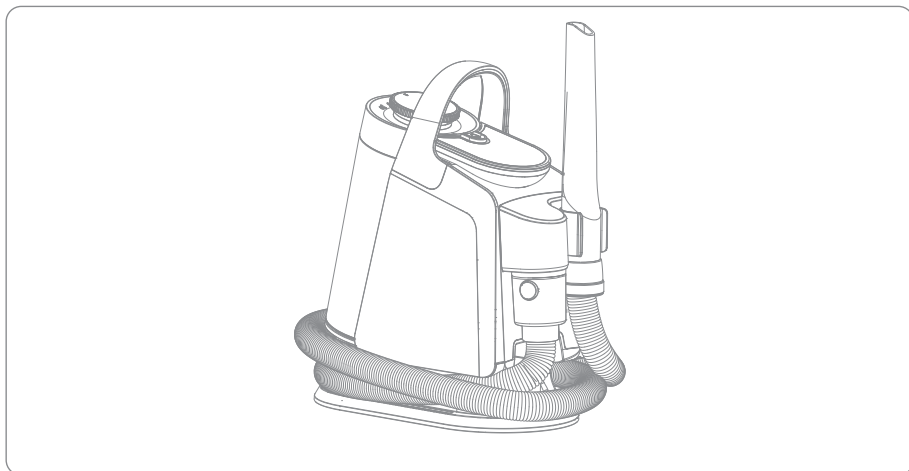
4. Installation

After they are completely dry, reinstall the hypha and metal mesh and put them back in their original positions.

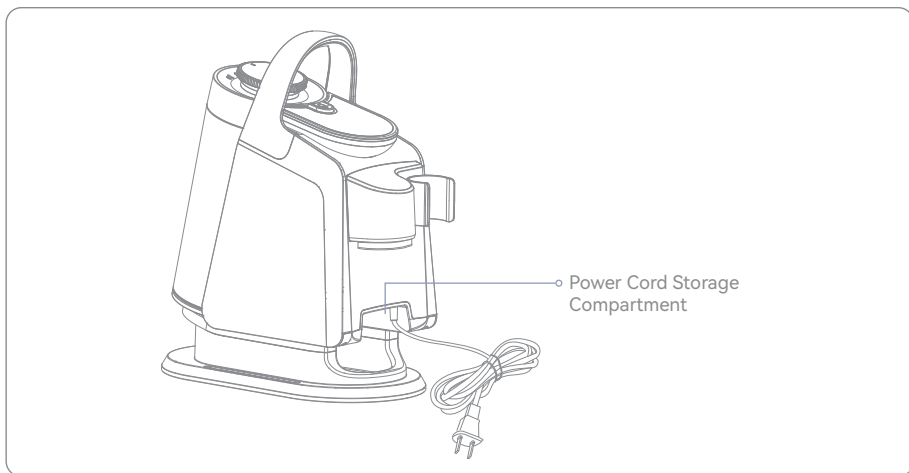
Note:

- Clean the hypha and metal mesh with cold water at least once a month. The maintenance frequency may vary depending on usage and condition. Remember to disconnect the power and unplug the device from the socket before replacing or cleaning the filter components.
- Make sure to install the hypha and metal mesh after they are fully dried.
- Using them without proper drying may result in electric shock or malfunction.
