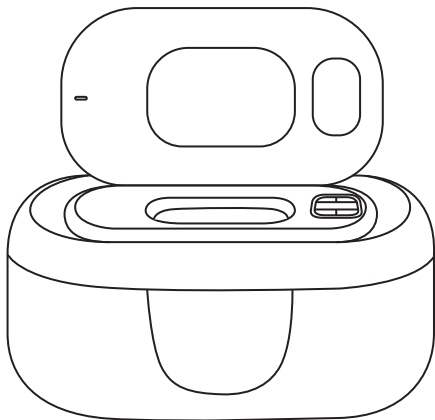

Wet Wipe Warmer

User Manual

Before using the Wet Wipe Warmer, please read this user manual carefully and keep it in a safe place for future reference.

WARNING:

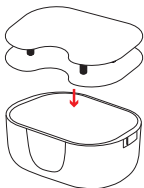
This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision

If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard

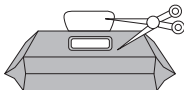
- 1、 If the device displays “- -” upon startup and continues to flash, it indicates that the machine is damaged and cannot function.
- 2、 If the device displays “H” upon startup, it indicates that the machine has entered the over-temperature protection mode and cannot function normally. In this case, the power supply should be unplugged, and the machine should be allowed to cool down before reconnecting the power for it to function normally.

Instructions:

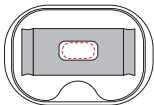
1. Place the spring structure into the wet wipe compartment;



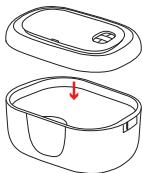
2. Cut off the lid of the wet wipes;



3. Place the wet wipes inside the wet wipe heating compartment, aligning the opening with the sealing ring opening of the compartment;



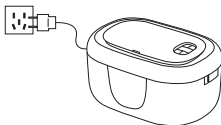
4. Close the top cover;



5. Secure the safety locks on both sides;



6. Plug in the power supply;



7. Press the "Power Button" to turn it on;



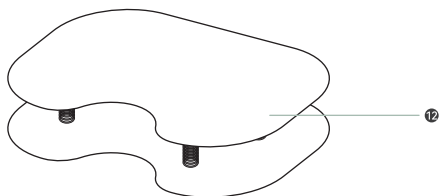
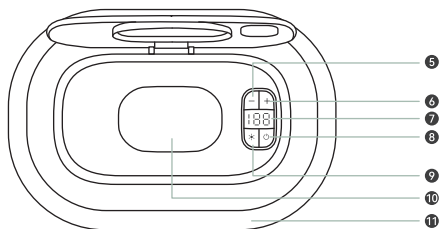
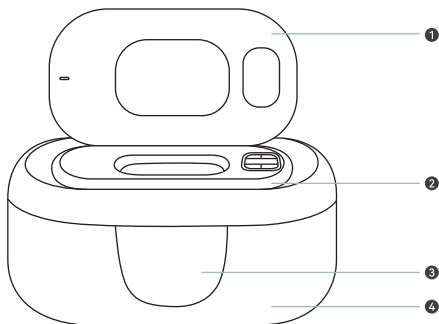
8. Adjust the temperature;



9. After 10 minutes, the wet wipes can be used.

Care & Cleaning:

1. Care: When not using the Wet Wipe Warmer, please turn off the power to prevent the wet wipes from drying out;
2. Cleaning: Remove the wet wipes and wipe the surface of the Wet Wipe Warmer with a wet wipe.

WARNING:

1. This product is designed for baby use only, do not use it to heat anything else.
2. After placing wet wipes, ensure to engage the child safety lock to prevent children from accessing the product;
3. Avoid heating for too long, as it may cause the wet wipes to dry out;
4. Avoid touching the product with wet hands or wet cloths;
5. If the product overheats or emits a burning smell, immediately disconnect the power supply and stop using it.
