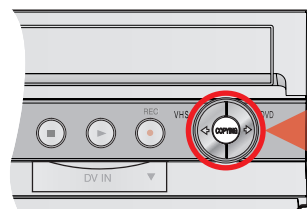

Copy (One Touch Transfer)



Main unit

While both DVD and VHS are stopped, press **COPYING** button and hold for about 3 seconds or more.



Discs you can record on

* You can record onto the second layer of dual- or double-layer discs after closing the first layer.

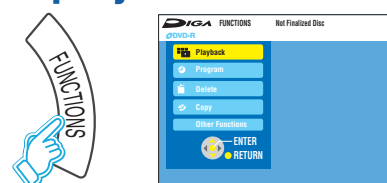
To play **DVD-R** **DVD-R DL** **DVD-RW** **+R** **+R DL** on other equipment,

Use the Finalize feature!

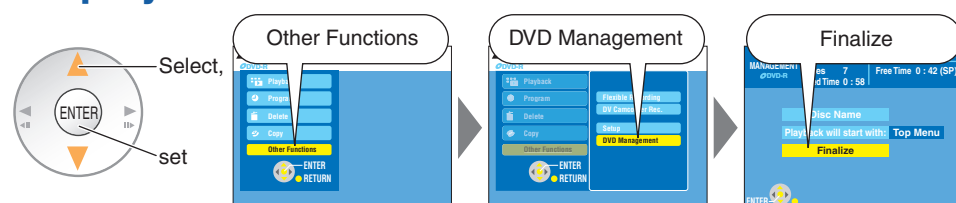
DVD-R, etc. recorded on this unit cannot be played on other players immediately after recording. Using the Finalize feature allows you to play these discs on other players. (However, once the disc is finalized you will no longer be able to record to the disc.)

Preparation: Select DVD side by pressing [DRIVE SELECT].
Insert the disc you want to finalize and stop play.

1 Display the Functions screen.



2 Display the Finalize screen.



3 Follow the on-screen instructions to start finalizing.

- Finalizing takes up to 15 minutes.
(Do not disconnect the AC power-supply cord while finalizing!)

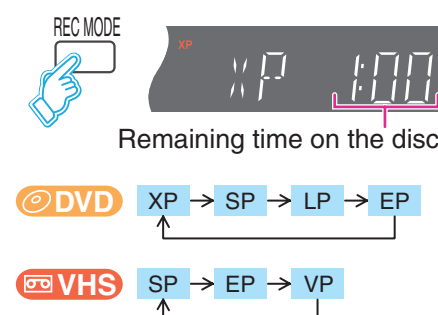

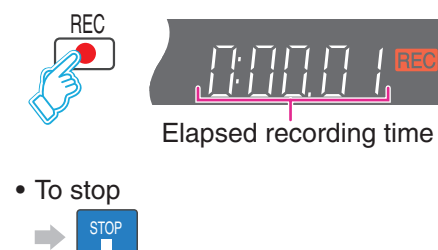
1 Select the channel.

The DVD indicator lights up on the unit.

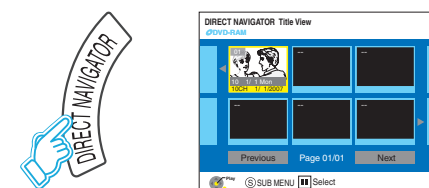
VHS

The VHS indicator lights up on the unit.

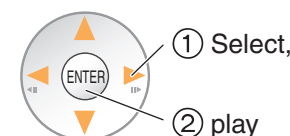
