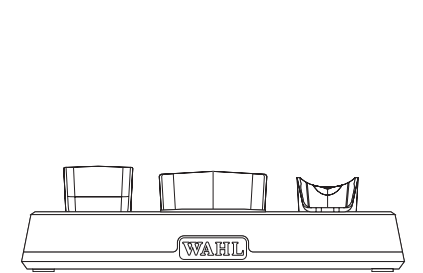

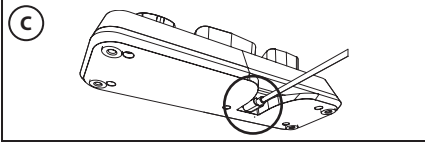

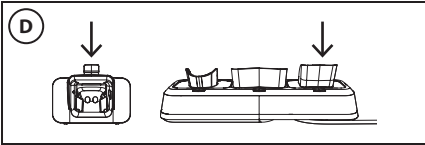


MODE D'EMPLOI

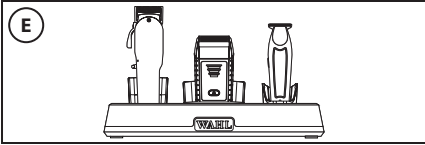
- Fixez la fiche à l'alimentation électrique. *(Figure A)*
- Fixez le cordon d'alimentation à l'alimentation électrique. *(Figure B)*



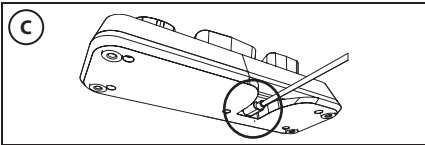
- Conecte el cable de alimentación al receptáculo situado en la parte inferior de la estación de carga. *(Figura C)*
- Después conecte la fuente de poder al tomacorriente.



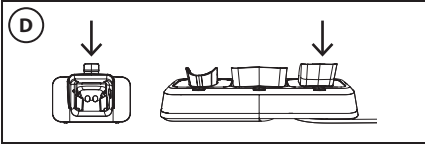
- Conecte cualquier combinación de tres aditamentos de la cortadora, recortadora y afeitadora en los tres receptáculos de la estación de carga. Coloque el aditamento sobre la clavija de carga y oprima hacia abajo hasta insertarlo en su sitio. Para sacar el aditamento, mueva la lengüeta trasera del aditamento y levántelo. *(Figura D)*



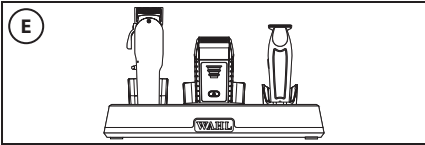
- Coloque la cortadora, recortadora o afeitadora en el aditamento correcto de la estación de carga, de modo que la placa con el nombre voltee hacia adelante. *(Figura E)*
 - El logotipo de Wahl en la estación de carga se iluminará en azul cuando la estación de carga esté conectada y lista para cargar.
 - El logotipo de Wahl en la estación de carga se encenderá en rojo de manera intermitente cuando la base esté conectada a una fuente de poder o a un cable que sean incompatibles (consulte la sección "Solución de problemas" para ver más información).



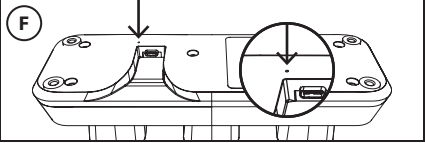
- Fixez le cordon d'alimentation dans le réceptacle situé au bas de la station d'alimentation. *(Figure C)*
- Ensuite, fixez l'alimentation électrique à la prise.



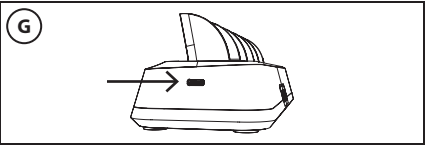
- Branchez trois des inserts de la tondeuse, de la tondeuse et du rasoir dans l'une des trois prises de la station d'alimentation. Placez l'insert de l'outil sur les broches de chargement et appuyez pour le mettre en place. Pour retirer l'insert de l'outil, relâchez la languette arrière de l'insert de l'outil et tirez vers le haut. *(Figure D)*



- Placez la tondeuse, la tondeuse ou le rasoir dans l'emplacement approprié de l'outil sur la station d'alimentation de sorte que la plaque signalétique soit orientée vers l'avant. *(Figure E)*
 - Le logo Wahl de la centrale s'allume en bleu lorsque le support est alimenté et prêt à délivrer une charge.
 - Le logo Wahl de la station d'alimentation clignote en rouge lorsque le socle est connecté à une alimentation ou un cordon incompatible (voir la section Dépannage pour plus d'informations).



- Modo ecológico: Para ayudar a reducir el consumo de energía, la estación de carga puede ponerse en modo ecológico, que deshabilita las funciones accesorias de la base. Para activar el modo ecológico, use una herramienta apropiada (es decir, un clip de papel, una herramienta para tarjetas SIM, etc.) para oprimir el botón de modo ecológico a través del orificio en la parte inferior de la base *(Figura F)* mientras la estación está conectada. Mientras está en modo ecológico, el logotipo de Wahl no se iluminará. Para salir del modo ecológico, desconecte la estación de carga durante **30 segundos** y vuelva a conectarla.



- La estación de carga puede cargar tres unidades Wahl a la vez, además de suministrar energía a un dispositivo USB desde el puerto USB-C en el lado de la base. *(Figura G)*

ANTES DE USAR POR PRIMERA VEZ

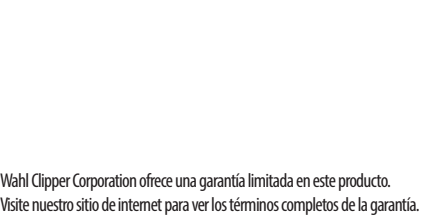
Antes de usar la unidad por primera vez en la estación de carga; debe cargar la cortadora, recortadora o instrumento de acabado durante **2 horas**. **Recomendación: La cortadora, recortadora o instrumento de acabado solo deben recargarse cuando el desempeño de la unidad se deteriore considerablemente.**

SOLUCIÓN DE PROBLEMAS

Si su estación de carga no parece funcionar o cargar correctamente (el logotipo de Wahl se ilumina en rojo de forma intermitente), revise lo siguiente:

- Revise la electricidad del tomacorriente conectando otro aparato (que sepa que funciona bien).
- Asegúrese de que la estación de carga no esté conectada a una fuente de energía que corta la cuando se apagan las luces.
- Asegúrese de que los contactos de cada unidad y de la estación de carga estén limpios y no tengan cabellos u otros contaminantes.

Si aún tiene problemas con su estación de carga, envíe la estación de carga, la fuente de poder y el cable de alimentación a Wahl Clipper Corporation con una nota en la que explique el problema.

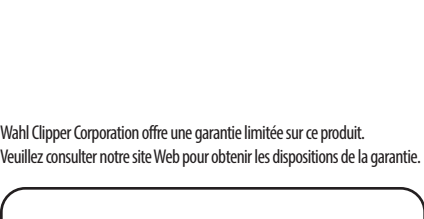
