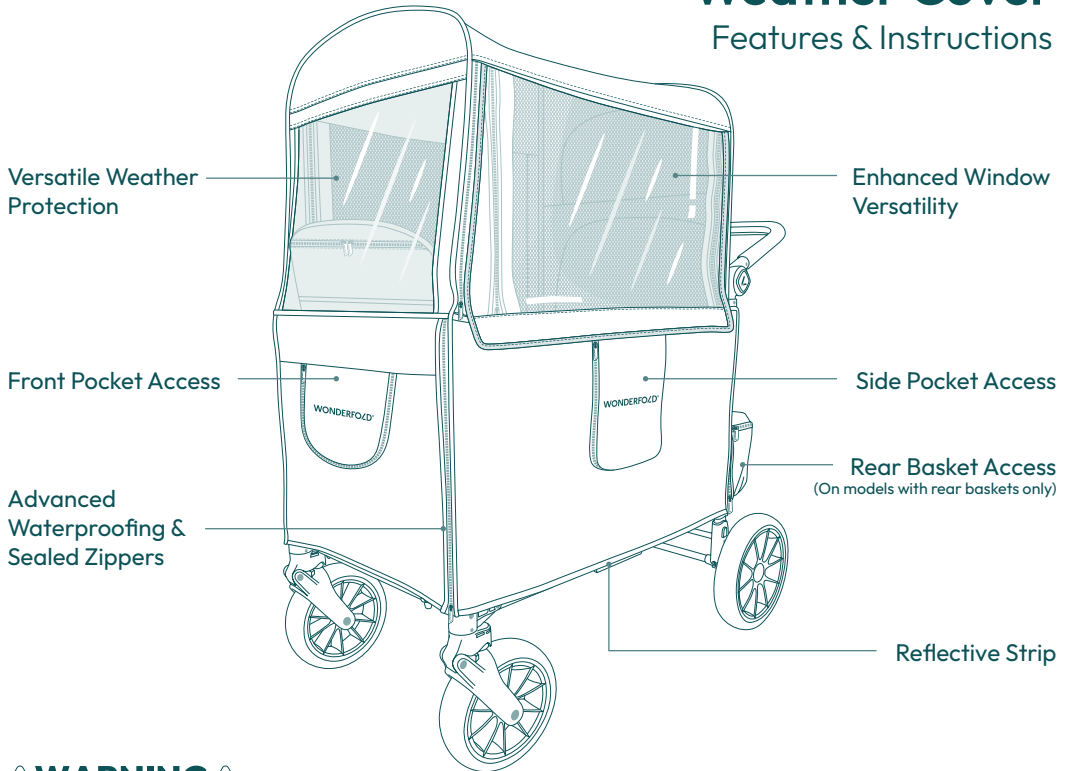


W-Series Weather Cover Features & Instructions



⚠️ WARNING ⚠️

Air Circulation: The Weather Cover is designed to provide shade and protection. Although we use breathable fabric, it can still restrict air circulation in certain conditions. Be mindful of the temperature inside the stroller wagon and monitor your child's comfort. If the weather is hot or humid, consider partially or fully converting the Weather Cover from full coverage to mesh windows.



Note: Repeated washing may reduce the effectiveness of the waterproof coating.

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Installing the Weather Cover

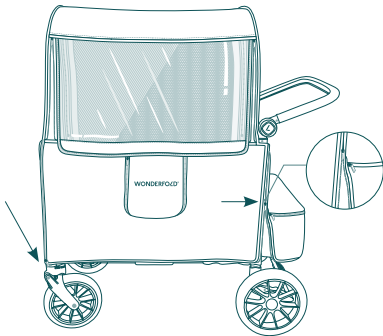
Note: Be sure to leave the canopy poles installed on the stroller wagon before installing the weather cover.

1. Engage the brake pedal to lock the stroller wagon in place.
2. Unzip the front and rear flaps of the cover.
3. Place the cover over the stroller wagon.

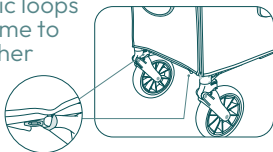


Note: The back panel should go through the handlebar.

4. Pull the cover all the way down.
5. Zip the front and rear flaps closed.

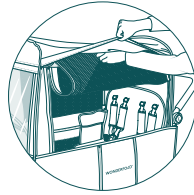
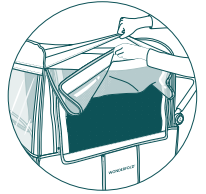


6. Hook the elastic loops around the frame to lock your weather cover in place.



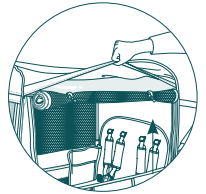
Stowing the Side Panels

1. Unzip the outer cover and tuck it underneath the top edge of the weather cover.



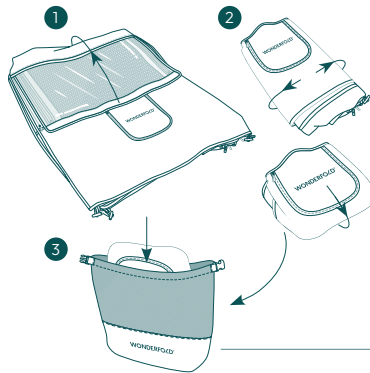
2. Unzip the mesh cover and tuck it underneath the top edge of the weather cover.

3. The mesh cover may also be rolled and stowed using the straps.



Folding & Storing the Weather Cover

1. Lay the cover on its side, tucking in the front and back panels.
2. Fold in half so the top of the cover meets the bottom. Then fold in thirds.



3. Fold the cover and place it in the mesh bag.
4. Roll the top down, buckle it, and hang to store.
